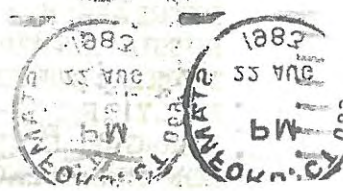

- IN EUROPE

The entire street population of Paris has gotten together and raised \$300 for MADEMOISELLE ROXY LaRUE's return to Africa. A spokesperson for the group told Roxy to return to Africa, without delay, "We are tired of hearing about how interesting the specimens are in Africa and how dull things are here. If you do not like it here, then leave."

- IN AFRICA

Dr. CORNELLIUS COX organizes a canoe expedition, using imported, fancy European racing shells. The doctor leaves Port Elizabeth and heads north up the East Coast of Africa toward Durban. Camping in the veldt outside Durban in hex 656, his hunters provide the expedition with 2 rations each.

Preparing to move up the Rufiji River, Prof. HUMBERT discovers a broken, crushed, high-heel sandel, with the name M. Roxy LaRue, on it. The Prof. decides to follow the river into hex 471, but before moving on, he dismisses 3 bearers and caches 15 gifts and 4 rations. He finds that hex 471 is a veldt hex, with the river turning in direction 5 into hex 470. His hunter fail to obtain any rations this turn. The Prof. sits by the river and dreams of finding beautiful nymphets...er rock strata, next turn.

DOCTOR HYPO GUY CEMIA decides that discretion may be the better part of valor and, besides, bon-bons do not keep very well in the desert. The good doctor moves from hex 92 in direction 2, into hex 93, which is more desert, without an oasis. The good doctor moves on into hex 94, which is more desert, but he manages to find an oasis in this hex. He believes that he has



been here before. He finds some bon-bon wrappers on the ground. Although he finds water, he does not obtain any rations this turn.

Rumors still persist that ORTE'GO DE DAGO is alive and wandering down the Ogove river. He reported to be in hex 213, but this has not been confirmed.

Headline - Daily News "McGuffin walks across Africa on dead bodies of helpless natives."

In search of the great white ape, ALFRED H. MCGUFFIN decides to move southwest in direction 4 into hex 431, which is more mountains with the highest peak of 14,000 ft. He discovers a river flowing out of the mountains in direction 2 into hex 432. Marching down the river, he is confronted by sixty warriors of the Soninke Tribe. Undaunted by this, McGuffin orders his men to open fire. A hail of musket balls scatter the Soninke warriors. McGuffin discovers the village and finds 6 rations and 4 gifts.
