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POLITICAL GAME: Last time we looked at one decision: - POLITICAL DECISION:THE LEVEL OF INDIVIDUAL FREEDOM, and its general effects. This time let's look at another decision:

TAX POLICY, VALUE 0-99, THE NUMBER = THE GENERAL OVERALL PUBLIC SECTOR TAX RATE ON ALL INCOME(I.E THE TOTAL PERCENT OF THE ECONOMIC GOODS AND SERVICES TAKEN BY THE PUBLIC SECTOR).

GENERAL EFFECTS: The greater the tax rate;

the less vigorous your own economic development(domestic policy),

the less effective your own economic influence(foreign policy)

the higher the crime rate,

the higher the probability of civil riots and civil wars,

the more effective foreign political influence and economic influence is on you,

the more effective your own political influence(domestic policy),

the more effective foreign military influence is on you,

the more effective your own military influence(foreign policy).

CHANGE LIMIT: 10 factors once per year during the annual budget cycle, except during WAR, then 10/turn. Each year = 4 turns,

Players will only submit changes in policy by indicating an increase or decrease in the relative value of the policy vis a vis the previous level. More about this later,

Bic proved to be the fleetest of foot while Duke Van Rijn was the best in both horsemanship and marksmanship. The ball was enlivened by M. Lafayette who, with the fair Katherine went resplendantly dressed and M.
