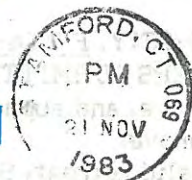

GM - Sadly, the attitude taken by Mr. Lewis is one of the reasons it has become necessary for me to segregate games into LOCAL and NATIONAL games. While refusing to correspond in a NATIONAL game may, indeed, be a valid diplomatic tactic under some circumstances, it has no place in this game here, where there are some LOCAL players and some NATIONAL players; players who are interested in playing a PLAY-BY-MAIL game, NOT a play-by-phone game. Consider also, that some LOCAL players may move away during the course of a game. Is it any wonder that they are disappointed at the tactics used?

TERRAULT KILLED IN ACTION. LEFLEUR BECOMES CHANCELLOR OF EXCHEQUER AND RECEIVES TITLE OF EARL. NEW YEAR'S EVE PARTIES A SMASH. BEZUKHOV LOSES AGAIN(GF)

Despite a smashing victory at the front by the Royal North Highland Border Regiment, the new is sad as M. Terrault, a well known, if somewhat bizarre member of Paris Society, was cut down in battle. It appears that while the rest of the regiment was engaged in a charge that scattered the enemy, M. Terrault shouted, "I'll guard the rear" and suited action to words.

Unfortunately, he didn't realize that some of the Italians whose pockets he was attempting to lighten (for the widows and orphans of France, no doubt) were not quite dead and did not take kindly to his activity. Meanwhile, Gen deLampalle, who led the charge of the regiment, was mentioned in dispatches and received the title of Marquis for his bravery.

The Frontier Regiment did not fare as well, but managed to hold their position despite a disastrous showing by the Royal Foot Guards, who needed to be rescued by a battalion of the Cardinal's Guard led by M. Frontenac. But Le Moyne of the Dragoon Guards was wounded while campaigning with the Frontier Regiment.

New Year's eve in Paris was a gala occasion this year as two major parties greeted 1616. The brightest was that of Duke Van Rijn which was graced by the presence of both the Crown Prince and the Queen! Also in attendance were Messrs. Belukhov, L'Oiseau, LeFleur, Field Marshal Lafayette and newcomer to Paris, M. LeMoyne. The Cardinal chose, however, to attend the party held by M. Frontenac, as did the Minister of Justice, The Commissioner of Public Safety and M. Diderot.

Duke Van Rijn was seen tossing 50cr to urchins in the street for Christmas this year. Unfortunately, the act of generosity was marred by the fact that the Duke's aim was poor and several of the urchins were badly injured by the carriage in front of which coins were thrown. The Duke could afford to be generous as he won heavily at the gaming tables this season. Far better indeed that the unfortunate LeFleur who lost heavily at those same tables and, to add insult to injury, was obliged to surrender in a duel with M. Frontenac over the affections of M. LeFleur's long time mistress, Natasha. Following the duel, however, the faithful Natasha ran to her lover, glared at M. Frontenac and said, "Leave off you Bully, I couldn't even consider the attentions of one who has covered his sword with the precious blood of so noble a one as my...beloved." M. LeFleur was, no doubt, mollified by becoming in quick succession Chancellor of Exchequer and an Earl.

M. Bezukhov, apparently determined to win the affections of Elise, again faced and again lost a duel to M. Diderot. The fickle Elise changed her mind three times during the season, finally ending up with M. Bezukhov when M. Diderot wooed and won Mlle. Olivia. Elise did help M. Bezukhov secure a position in the Royal Foot Guards.

Unconfirmed rumors indicate that M. Van Rijn's faction in the second estate are considering a dramatic declaration but, as yet, none has been forthcoming.

Unfortunately, M. Phillip L'Oiseau, who arrived in Paris last season, appears to have kept such a low profile that he went virtually unnoticed, despite winning the heart of Isabelle, joining the Frog & Peach and joining the Dragoon Guards. He even attended the Royal Ball and lost a drinking contest to M. Bezukhov. This season he managed to make a large splash raising himself 3 social levels and two ranks in his regiment. Another newcomer, M. Pierlot LeMoyne also joined the Dragoon Guards and won the heart of Quintina. Mardi Gras was again canceled this year for unknown reasons. A M. Forthos, a private in the King's Musketeers, was reprimanded for fighting with various members of the Cardinal's Guard. Mlle. Linette, having had no suitors recently

departed for a punnery, while Mlle Lucrece appears to offer an interesting new face in town.

This turn he may hire bearers for 3 gifts, Askaris for 4 gifts, and guides for 6 gifts. He may buy canoes for 5 gifts each. One gift buys one ration. His hunters obtain 3 rations each.

Prof. HUMBERT searches for geological specimens this turn with very little luck. Something very little is what he really wanted to find. His hunters also had very little luck, obtaining only one ration each. Therefore, he must allow 2 bearers to starve. One bearer does become sick.

DOCTOR HYPO GUY CEMIA, still wandering back toward civilization and sugar covered goodies, heads into hex 97, traveling in direction 2, which he discovers is a desert. The good Doctor decides to carry 7 water rations and 2 food rations. Upon seeing this his last remaining Askaris decides to leave and walks off. His other Askaris was killed by a charging Buffalo earlier in the turn. The Good Doctor is rumored to have said that he was not to share the large mound of chocolate he was going to devour on his return to Europe with the useless whim. The Good Doctor soon discovers that hex 97 is a vast desert with nothing but burning sand to cross. Will he make it back to civilization?

ALFRED H. MCGUFFIN follows his river in direction 5 into hex 445, which is a jungle-mountain hex with a peak of 12,400 ft. The river turns in direction one into hex 428. His hunters provide this expedition with 3 rations. He still has not decided how to deal with his strange Askaris who is still dragging a large coffin-shaped box. He must have more important things on his mind, like great white apes.

Prof. O'FORAN continues to attempt to move across Africa by moving in direction 6 into hex 141, which he discovers is jungle. He decides to retreat back to hex 167 and eats a camel, before deciding what to do.

GUIDO VITTORIO SCONZINESE stood in disbelief as 96 warriors of the Suk tribe ignored his sermon in the jungle. His preaching does gain 1 victory point for him and adds 1 to the tribe attitude. He may hire a bearer for 1 gift, an Askaris for 2 gifts, and guides hire on for 3 gifts this turn. One gift will acquire 4 rations, 5 gifts will buy a canoe.
