Only games and press will be carried, and the contents will be reprinted in the next issue of TBT.

I now have sufficient material for TBT #17 but am lacking the time at present. You should receive it within a couple of weeks after you receive this.

Only players will get this sub-zine, and it will be at no extra charge. I knew that game fee in addition to sub would come in handy some day.
