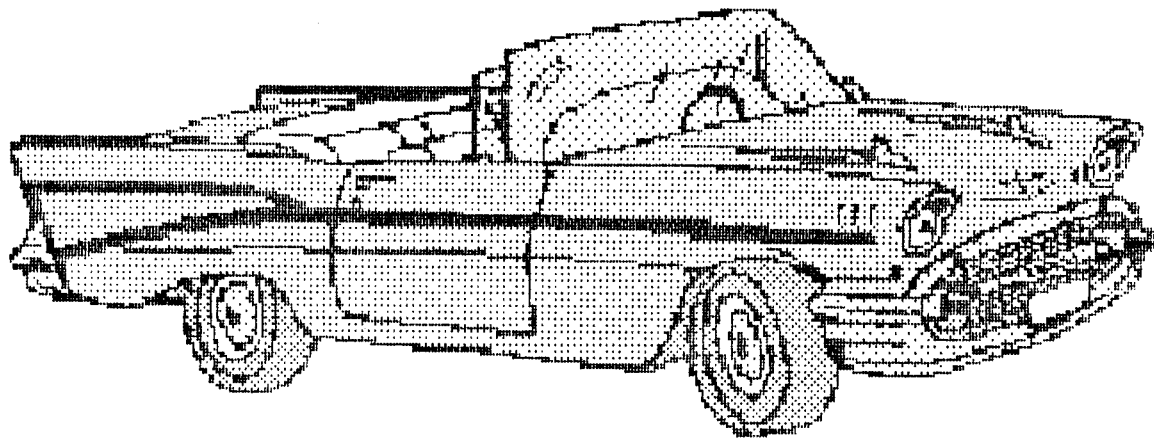

PDO ZINE DIRECTORY was founded by Michael Mills in 1980. Its purpose now, as it was back then, is to provide the hobbyist with a simple yet accurate and cost effective listing of as many zines in Dipdom as possible, without the flamboyant, sometimes biting reviews. Foreign zines are welcome to list in these pages too. This is the Yellow Pages on white paper. If there are any comments after the zines of the main listing, they are by the publisher of that particular zine.

The Zine Directory (ZD) will list every zine acknowledged to me, in alphabetical order. It will also list most of the possible game openings in alphabetical order, prior to the zine listings. This way any player, new or veteran, may look up the game they are interested in, see which zines have openings, and contact those zine publishers. Such a deal!

On the outside page of GR there will be a listing of some of Dipdom's services, in case you ever have the need to contact any of them. MASTERS OF DECEIT may be of importance to new players. CENSUS lists all of the known hobbyists. OMBUDSMAN may be of help if you have a game related problem. ORPHANS may be of help if your GM stops sending game reports.

At \$1 an issue for 20 compressed, readable pages of useful data, the ZD is well worth the money. You won't get 70+ pages of misinformation. What you will get is the bare facts on each zine listed. Each person has their own opinion about zines they receive, so we suggest to you to request a sample 1st, by either sending a couple of stamps or 1 issues cost. Of course, feel free to jump in any way you prefer. Here at the PDOZD HQs, we do not try to persuade, brow beat or humiliate hobbyists into doing things our way. Each person has their own way of doing things.

Publishers are not asked to trade with PDOZD. I am not looking to start another useless zine bank that circulates old zines for money. If you publish and wish to send me a sample of your last issue prior to the printing of the Summer 1993 PDOZD (which will come out Jul 1), be my guest. However, I am not soliciting trades.

Publishers will receive a PDOZD questionnaire about their zine(s). Please feel free to fill it out and return it to me by June 21, 1993. This info will be used to make the Summer 1993 PDOZD accurate and current.

I would like to congratulate Pete Gaughan as the "heir apparent" to the Zine Register throne. I'm sure Pete will do a great job.

DISCLAIMER: The editor of the People's Diplomacy Organization Zine Directory has put together all of the info in this publication on his own. Editorial reviews are by that zines publisher. Typos, I'll take the blame for. Information errors, see that zines publisher and please, let me know so I may spare others.

There are some zines out there that have either very good reading material or very lively letter columns. The following are just a few of these zines. However, many zines have interesting reading material. So please don't feel limited to these select few.

(Only 1 NMR in the last 4 issues, for example). Nice maps, double-underlining for dislodged units in game reports, and a very low GM error rate make following the progress of the games as pleasant and lucid as possible. The extensive players' press is mostly game-oriented rather than personality-oriented, with a policy of a minimum of GM intervention. We particularly welcome fans of Horatio Hornblower.
