MAIDIVE ISIANDS: A load of empty calvados bottles today crashed through the roof of the Maldive Islands Playboy Club, severely injuring the visiting Maharajah of Hydunderabad. The culprit was found to be the French exile Noah of Arc, who ever since the defeat of France has been wandering around the world in a strange aircraft of his own design and construction. This ship, whose passengers are French refugees seeking to found a New France in some place less hostile than Europe, was last seen wobbling off over the Indian Ocean in the general direction of Mauritius. Noah of Arc, whose real name is believed to be Pierre Dansleteie, apparently intends to speed up his airship by hitching 50,000 dodos to it. # A BRIEF HISTORY OF THE GRAND DUCHY OF BEAUCOUILION - XXII

The period of 26 years from the French Revolution to the end of the Mapoleonic Wars were the most profitable that the tiny Grand Duchy had ever enjoyed. This was, of course, in terms of gross income; expenditures, as usual, exceeded even this vast amount of money.

In 1804, at a ball celebrating the approaching French conquest of England, the Grand Ballroom of the palace of Fortunato XVIII was the scene of a most remarkable competition between Princess Pauline Borghese, sister of Napoleon I, and Princess Libertina, sister of the Grand Duke. Contemporary accounts are most reticent about the character of this competition, but the curious can be enlightened by the mural which David painted on one wall of the ballroom while it was in progress. (In 1949 the art expert Dr. A. Ohne Umlaut detected six places in the mural where the painter had ceased work briefly, presumably to play some minor role in the festivities.) The result of the duel was disputed. Princess Libertina claimed to have won by a score of 207-206; however, Princess Pauline claimed that Count Oblowoff should have counted for three rather than one, which would make herself the winner. The dispute caused a brief rupture of diplomatic relations between Beaucouillon and France, but before this could lead to war a reconciliation was affected by Count Benvenuto d'Avino, who invited Napoleon to a two-week state visit. This visit completely mollified the Emperor's wrath, though several of the ladies of the Grand Ducal court complained about his short stature.

## 1968G - PRESS RELEASES

PEERISAILIES: Meeting in its first general conclave since the Fall elections the Periclaque today heard its annual New Year's Message on the State of Frenciana read by Her Majesty's Prime Peerisite, Keith Polan: the annual Message on the State of Frenciana's Affairs read by Her Majesty's Perisite of Foreign Affairs, Comrad von Metzke; and a special message (of very short duration) by Her Majesty's Perisite of Personal Affairs, Gail Irene Schow. Following these messages the Periclaque proceeded to go into special executive session to elect the Peerimouth, following Her Majesty's request that the Periclaque elect the nation's highest office-holder rather than for Her to appoint him as is Her legal right. While many candidates were suggested for this high office serious consideration was given to only three candidates: Wade Hampton Johnston, Eric Blake, and Bangs Leslie Tapscott. Following hours of delicate negotiations, intermingled with private conference sessions within the Peerisailles Palace's many upstairs chambers, a final session was held when it was believed a majority decision had been reached. The final poll showed:

Wade Hampton Johnston 31 votes Eric Blake 9 votes Bangs Leslie Tapscott 6 votes

Also one unknown Charles Alexander received 1 vote. One vote cast for Nelson Rockefeller

was ruled invalid since he wasn't a recognized candidate.

Following the election Her Majesty met with Johnston, the Great Peerisite Jack Greene, von Metzke, Schow, Polan, and Her Majesty's Defense Perisite, John Beshara. The sextet settled down to a merry evening of observing Miss Schow's interpretation of von Metzke's newest over-sextet for bassoon, obce, and four Jew's Harps.

Meanwhile in legislative activity the Council of Greater Perisites approved a declaration of war on England which had already been declared by Her Majesty and the Lesser Council; approved a mutual defense pact with Syria, the People's Republic of South Yemen, and Kuwait; and voted to recognize the new Bolivian Government of Elizabeth I. (see below).

The Lesser Council was still deadlocked in debate over a resolution introduced by

Gene Prosnitz to declare war on Germany.

MALE, MAIDIVE ISIANDS: Her Majesty's Great Peerisite and Ambassador to the Islands arrived here this afternoon about the Frencian battleship Force de Frappe. His Excellency, Mohammed Didi CLI, current Sultan and Calif, greeted the Ambassador at the dockyards. Preceded by a 101-camel escort the pair departed for the Male Playboy Club, where Greene would take up residence during his stay. That evening was reserved for entertainment while serious discussions would begin at noon the next day.

ST. PEERICRAD: The International Court of Justice, meeting here, today voted 15-2 in favor of a decision condemning England for its practice of Peericide in Norway. In the majority report His Honor Dr. Bung Karno-sichi stated: "The overwhelming evidence is that England is guilty of Peericide; not only Peericide but the worst and most barbaric form of it, Peerimania; the brainwashing of innocent children with the dogma of Peeri infallibi-

lity.

Baron Edwin Montchauve, commander of the English fleet, and Marshal Bootliker, commander of the Hessians, are both directly involved in the charges. Montchauve was so gross as to interrupt the annual Grieg Celebration at Stavanger with the noise of his guns as he attacked the Norwegian fortress of Lipscomberian. Testimony of Frenciana's ambassador to Norway, Comte Tiffany-Schiller, noted: "Il est bruit." Bootliker was reported to have actually stolen the famous Sebelius Cello from the famous composer's summer retreat at Lindensee. Comments had it that he planned to play on it while Peeris burned, should Germany occupy the city. The Court demanded that England evacuate Norway immediately and that should it fail to do so the Court would authorize the League of Nations to take needed measures to throw the English out.

PEERIS: Speaking to the nation, Her Majesty's Perisite of Propaganda (Peritalk) Rodney Walker today called on the Germans to lay down their arms and cease fighting the
Frencian nation. "An attack such as you planned is doomed to futility. The famous Peeridefense can not be broken. Only England will benefit. You seal your own fate if you

attack us."

Many Her Majesty's Perisite of Public Works (Periditch), Douglas Beyerlein, via the Hubie-bird Satellite today called on all Germans to refuse to obey their government in its order to attack Frenciana. Said the Perisite: "An attack by Germans on us is an attack by Gain on Abel, by Scdom on Gomorrah, by McCarthy on Kennedy. It cannot be. Should it some we will both die. But you first."

IA BASTILLE: Deep in the Bastille the Lord Executioner, Frank Musbach, was cleaning his M-16, sharpening his bayonet, and reading his "Quotations of Pere Peeri" in prepara-

tion for when Her Majesty would call on him for his special skills.

PERIS: After weeks of intense trading the Peeris Gold Market opened again this morning. Which way the Market would go was unknown but the selling of Gold in order to purchase Peerimarks and Roubles was amazing. In last issued quotations the prices offered and taken were:

Director of the Market Baron-Comte Schwartzenburger-Rothchild amnounced that private re-

ports indicated the only truly sound currency was the Maldive Island plaster.

L'ECOLE MILIEA IRE: Professor Henri de Tassigny today announced that the famous Frencian military academy had finished plans for the total mobilization of Frenciana to resist all attackers.

BREST: Observers here reported that the English dreadnought <u>Invincible</u> carrying the Duchess of Westmoreland had passed here on its way to Pollutidar. Said the port commander: "Only our belief in the sacred nature of war and our practice of morality even in conflict kept us from blowing it out of the water. Also the fact that our powder was wet, our pea-shooters were rusty, and nobody was on the graveyard shift."

ST. PEERIGRAD: Said the von Metzke to the Angel on High:

"BEWARE OF VICIOUS GOPHERS.....NAMED WALKER...."

Care to try again, Rod?

HELLOTIDAR (Allen and Rossi Press Agency, via Poopie-Bird): Looking slightly ragged but in good shape nevertheless the Compte du Peri today transmitted from here the following special report:

"Indeed I was captured by the dreaded Pollutidarians, and even brought before His Inferial Majesty Honj the Herny, but I managed to escape by waving a sacred medallion blessed by Charles Turner and having on it the image of the beloved Lucretia Borgia. Such a reaction! Honj went down on the floor foaming at the mouth, even his mustache drooped. His belt slipped three notches and his false uppers clacqued something retched. Very undignified."

But as he related all was not peaceful in Pollutidar:

"However, I talked with some of Honj-Johni's courtiers and they told me there was growing opposition to Honj and his autocratic and despotic methods of enforcing his min-ority and unpopular views on his public. Why even in the matter of mini-skirts Honj is hehind the times. He say's women's skirts should be above the knee; everybody else says they should be above the naval. And his choosing of music is terrible. He keeps playing those same things over and over. Especially that: "Nearer my Peeri to Thee" and "Perilot". Its unbelievable what that man will do."

Also it definitely looks like war between Hellotidar and Pollutidar. However, unlikely as it is that Hellotidar will win they do have certain advantages, especially in their audic-weapons department. Including the recorded speeches of William Fulbright, the press releases of Charles DeGaulle, recordings of John Beshara reading Nasser's Victory statement, and one of Mao Tse-tung reading Gibbon's Decline and Falll.... "With all the noise we can come up with Pollutidar had better quit," said Hellotidar's Minister of Noise, Boom-boom le'Bomb.

SARI, FOLIUTIDAR: His Inferial Majesty Honj the Horny, Emperoar of Pollutidar, today admitted that the Frencian spy Compte du Peri had escaped from the Indons to which he had been fed upon his discovery. "It seems," he told reporters, "that the Compte had secreted a small metal disk in his clothes. The poison fang of the Trodon was partly

deflected by this disk. As a result, the Compte regained consciousness before the next Trodon egg could hatch.

"However, the Trodon venom did affect the Compte. This can be seen from his spelling, grammar, and syntax, which clearly show him to be under the influence of some narcotic."

In his other remarks to the press, the Emperoar dismissed the rumors of a revolt in "Hellotidar". "Of course our slaves are revolting," he said. Directing the attention of reporters at a group of Horib slaves who were scrubbing a nearby courtyard, he said, "Look at them! Did you ever see such revolting slaves in your life?"

BEIRUT (1 March 1901, Reuters via Peeris): Marshal the Count François de Peurigerx, Count of Peeriguary and Foix, and commander-in-chief of the Frencian Middle Eastern Command arrived here this morning in an AMX-77, to take charge of the Middle Eastern War. Accompanied by members of his staff (including three bunnies on loan from the Disraeli Hilton) the Count checked into the Beirut Onassis Waterhole before leaving for Command

PEERIPOLIS (4 March 1902): Acting in reaction to a Turkish Government order banning the Ottoman People's Party, the National People's Youth Groups and Armenian Citizenry Party, the Free Turkish Liberation Front was formed here under the general direction of Dr. Memal Attaturk, former professor emeritus of Peerology at the University of Free Biafra. Dr. Attaturk is expected to receive the swift recognition of many governments in his bid for Diplomatic recognition.

PEERIS (6 March 1902): Meeting in special session the Peericlaque today voted to recognize the Free Turkish Liberation Front and offered a secret alliance to any state that would join in aiding it to regain -control of the nation. The Claque dispatched Baron Gadsden (PERISTEP) to observe conditions there.

PEERIJAVO (6 March 1902): The Peeriocracy of Peerijavo today recognized the Free Turkish Liberation Front and His ImPERIousness Che Peeri announced Peerijaven "volunteers" would be sent to aid the new regime. Said Peeri: "This is not just another press warp. This is a war between MIT and Harvard, between civilizationand barberism. ((Sic.)) Between those who support a co-ed Radcliffe and those who oppose it. Between those who worship the sliderule and those who worship Peeri."

ST. PEERIGRAD (7 March 1902): Premier Levi Eskibble today announced that Periland was recognizing the Free Turkish Liberation Front and would also dispatch aid to the liberators.

MALE: (6.5 March 1902): Mohammed Didi today stuck his head out of his room at the Playboy Club and when asked if the Maldive Islands would recognize the new Turkish Lib. eration Government replied: "Of course, they're arabs aren't they? We must stick together. Pardon me I'm keeping a bunnie waiting, and a greene one at that."

TIKI-CACA (7 March 1902): Astounding observers here Her Imperial Majesty Elizabeth I, Queen of Bolivia, Ruler of the Andes, Chief Coffee Bean of the South, today recognized the new Turkish Covernment and announced that Her nation stood behind the liberation front every step of the way, especially if that way lay through England.

PEERIPOLIS (8 March 1902): Speaking to a meeting of the Turkish National Parliament Dr. Attaturk today pronounced himself pleased with world response to his call for a new Turkish government. "Obviously the world supports our cause, which is only right because it is a just one. The insults of the Lebling Regime cannot be tolerated. Never has such a puny force challenged one of our magnificence and lived. He shall be stomped into dust (mainly through the finers of John Boardman). His slide-rule shall be broken, his computer defused, his swift-legs shall run backwards.

SARI, POLLUTIDAR: Skrtch the Lousy One, Minister of Foreign Affairs and Food Procurement, said that Pollutidar would not recognize the Attaturk government of Turkey. "From this angle, on the Enner Crust, we couldn't recognize anyone very well," he told a meeting of the Ancient Free and Accepted Cavemen. "Of course, in case of war the Empire of Pollutidar will gladly take part. The issue of civilization and barberism, however, does not interest us. 'Civilization' as it is understood on the Outer Crust is a most un-Pollutiderean concept, and since all cave men, according to St. John of Barsoom, are naturally beardless, we have no interest in barberism either."

Skrtch went on to say that the Emperoar had at one time been interested in supporting the Attaturk group, "but that was when he was under the impression that it was called 'the Turkish Free Libation Front'."

In a related development, Fleet Admiral Bobo Rygmus expressed interest in new developments in Outer Crust weaponry. "They seem to have a new weapon called the "finer" which has unknown capabilities," he said. "I am interested in finding out just what a 'finer' is supposed to be."

TARSUS (12 March 1902, Peeri Press): Riding at the head of his brave band of men from Iran, Frenciana, Esrael and Peerijavo, Lawrence of Frenciana today arrived in this major Turkish city to effect its liberation and proclaim the coming of a saviour of Turkey, one Periturk, who would liberate all of Turkey from the Lebling mob. Lawrence, known to be a violent and fierce fighter, has vowed to continue until all Turkey is liberated.

ST. PEERIGRAD (20 March 1902): In an interview with Margaret Burns, chief assistant for Diplomatic Affairs to William Lawrence, we learned today that Lawrence is determined to destroy his enemies. If not from victories in the Diplomacy world then by reducing them to brainwashed children of Peerithink.

LONDON (13 February 1902): The Duchess of Westmoreland has arrived in Pollutidar: Reports, received by a wildly enthusiastic and cheering crowd here at the capital, indicate that Her Highness has been royally welcomed by His Inferial Majesty, Emperoar Honj, and Her Highness, as the personal representative of the much-feared and eternally glorious King-Emperor Huon, is not negotiating with the Emperoar regarding His anticipated expedition to the Cuter Crust. His efforts to not only subvert but pervert opposition viewpoints ammounts ((sic)) to a de facte approval of those things he condemns.

Except for a biological accident John Boardman might have been cast as a Pontius Pilate, and Charles Turner as a Ho Chi Minh. Peery? Well, he might have been a Jack Greene, and would that ever be bad.

((Apparently, from the reference to "the intricacies of Bridge", Peery shares a view common in west-coast Diplomacy fandom, that Gene Prosnitz is a Boardman pseudonyme Gene's the bridge expert; address your remarks to him. I know only enough about bridge to be able to maneuver the bidding so that I'm dummy and thus don't have to worry about how to play the hand. For example, if my partner bids "One Club" I come back heavy in clubs whether I have them or not. This has the added advantage that after a while people stop asking me to play bridge with them.

((As for Mata Hari, alias Margaretha Geertruida Zelle (1876-1917), you will find

the facts of her case in Kurt Singer's Spies The Changed History (Ace). In the same book is an account of the activities of her daughter, Banda MacLeod, the engaged in espionage in Java during and after Torld War II. To some part this almost unknown toman deserves the reputation which history has fastened on her mother.))

ROD WALKER, 1611 Lowry Dr., Rantoul, Ill. 61866: To answer your points with reference to my points on the Mao business. 1. It is easy to understand why Mao would eschew ethics. His government shows no particular concern with ethics of any sort. ((This has always been a blind spot with governments, and China cannot be picked out as the only, or even as an uncommonly flagrant, offender.)) 2. Your quibble (and it is only that) ((Would you believe an honest desire for information on a historical period of which I know little?)) regarding the use of the term "Duke" shows a lack of appreciation of Chinese history. There was at that time, and thenceforward, a hierarchy of Chinese feudal titles almost exactly corresponding to the titles Emperor, King, Prince, Duke, and Baron (or Lord); as these titles were normally understood in feudal Europe. 3. German and English journalists have consistently reported that the works of Kiung Fu-tze have been proscribed by the so-called "Cultural Revolution".

4. The work quoted was, I believe, the Spring and Summer Annals, which Confucius, I believe, authored. Please note that the correct Latinization begins with Kiung (pronounced kung) not Kung (pronounced gung).

((Transliteration from the Chinese is largely a matter of taste. The Wade-Giles system is most familiar but it is cumbersome and misleading, particularly with its apostrophes. Better, according to L. Sprague de Camp in The Ancient Engineers, is the Yale-Gardner system. By this system, the philosopher under discussion was Kung Fu-dz, and the two autocrats who hanned his works were Tsin Shi Hwang-di and Mau Dze-dung.))

A couple of other comments. It is doubtful that the educated inhabitants of Roman Africa spoke Latin. Certainly not in the time of Augustine. Even as early as the time of Nero (if not by the time of Julius Caesar), Latin had ceased to be a spoken tongue, even in Rome, where the spoken language was probably Umbrian (the real ancestor of Italian). Latin was a written language only. The inhabitants of Roman Africa may have spoken a Latin-based dialect, although many of them spoke Greek and Punic. The whole issue of race in this area is, however, irrelevant, since consideration which apply to the Maghreb hardly apply elsewhere in Africa.

The told you Cleopatra's mother was a Mibian princess? Her mother was Queen Berenike, sister and wife to Ptolemy XII. Otherwise she would not have been legitimate heir to the throne and it would have been unnecessary for Ptolemy XIII to marry her (and Ptolemy XIV in his turn). Her daughter by Marcus Antonius did marry a North African dynast. Big deal.

((I was in error on this point. The wife of Ptolemaios XII was indeed his kinswoman Berenike, but this does not necessarily mean, royal family arrangements being what they are, that Berenike was the mother of Kleopatra VII. The Encyclopedia Brittanica says, on what authority I know not, that Kleopatra was of Greek and Makedonian stock "with a very small admixture of Iranian blood". Perhaps the best verdict is that of the late Will Cuppy: "The Ptolemies had once been pure Macedonian Greek. By now they were Grade B, if that."

((By the time of Ptolemaios XII - who is numbered "XI" or "XIII" in other sources - legitimacy was a matter of little concern in Egypt. Ptolemaios XII himself was the illegitimate son of Ptolemaios XII. The murder of a cousin in 80 BC extinguished the legitimate line so he took the throne. I have been unable to find who was/were the mother/s of the four children of Ptolemaios XII, or even if their identity is known to history. As to why Kleopatra XII married her brothers successively - maybe it was just an old Egyptian custom. Other rulers of the Ptolemaic line had done so, to say nothing of the more ancient dynasties.))

The question of rate was of no importance in the ancient world, as you may know. The ruling class of Egypt were descendants of Nilotic Negroes, although even by the time of the Old Kingdom quite thoroughly mixed with the earlier inhabitants (whom we would now call Semit.s, Ithough that is a linguistic classification rather than one of physical type). Of course, as you know, the question of "rate" is largely a straw man. Skin shade is no indicator; "race" is determined by skull and jaw measurements, and a variety of other things known collectively as anthropometry. Even so, determinants of "race" are based on statistical averages only. The fact that all humans can interbreed

is proof that physical differences are of no consequence. ((Well, Bygert, the ball's in your court now.))
