However, since it was attacked from Venice, the support it gives to the Italian move "A Rom-Ven" is still valid under the rules of Diplomacy. The Russian army in Moscow retreats to Sevastopol. The deadline for "Fall 1909" moves is NOON, SATURDAY 27 APRIL 1968.

He informed local inhabitants that a voice had spoken to him out of an empty calvados bottle and ordered him to gather 50,000 dodos, hitch them to his airship, and fly away with his refuge s to found a New France.

There was general laughter as Noah went into the woods looking for dodos, but it consed a few minutes later when he ran out again - with a furious dodo after him, pecking his buttocks and squawking. The Frenchman barely escaped by leaping into his airship and sailing off.

SEVANTOPOL (September 4, 1902, League for Information Emission): Today the Supreme Council of the Party of Farmers and Unemployed Intellectuals (PFUI) amounced an agreement with the Heroic Union of Machinists, Boilerstokers, and Unclassified Garmentworkers (HUMBUG) in the formation of a coalition government, with a majority consisting of 27 of the 40 seats of the Porkers', Peasants', and Soldiers' Soviet. As head of the government, holding both Premiership and Foreign Ministry, is the leader of PFUI, Gyorgi Abneravich Greison. Leader of HUMBUG, V. I. Lenten, heads the Ministry of Information, and second man in HUMBUG, J. Stolen, heads the Secret Police.

The Soviet proclaimed Sevestopol capital of the Russian People's Republic. The naval garrison immediately announced its support for the new government. Commisars have been despatched to the beleaguered fleet in Sweden, and the army in Galicia, but communication with the army in Munich is not yet established. All other army and navy units are considered politically unreliable, and any actions by any other units are not officially authorized until they are led by Commisars appointed by the Soviet. From time to time a list of such units, with their appointed Commisars, will be published by the Soviet.

The Foreign Ministry expresses its gratitude to all t ose great and small powers whose assistance in the overthrow of Tsar Thomas was invaluable. All foreign expeditionary forces are invited to assist the forces of the People's Republic in subduing those misguided forces still trying to re-establish the Tsar's rule - but they are re-

PERRISATLES: In news of the Government this sees on the Council of Greater Perisites remained deadlocked in the middle of a debate concerning the passage of the joint Beshara-Walker-Prosnitz Bill which was passed last month by the Lesser Council after months of debate. Passage in the Lesser Council was uncertain until the last moment when two of the former opponents of the Bill changed sides and advocated its The final vote was 7-4. The Bill is expected to have an equally difficult time in the Greater Council, where it has strong advocates (Beshara, von Metzke, and Blake) and equally vocal opponents (Walker, Long, and Latimer). The crucial votes will be cast by Zelazny and Leitch who have refused to take a firm position on the bill. However, threats of a Peeribuster by Walker, Cochran and Turner may prove ineffective since the Council Chamber has been Pecriproofed. In other measures the Councils agreed to the Government's demand for a six percent tax increase to finance the construction of a 167-foot statue of St. Peeri cutside St. Peerigrad atop Mt. Pearilympus. The statue is desired to help celebrate the 200th amiversary of the city which comes next year. However, the Councils rejected a proposal to construct a speed-ramp between Pecris and Pecrisailles after it was discovered such a ramp would have to pass through the Peerian National Game Preserve and would have possible harmful effects on the living habits of the rare collection of rabbits in the Preserve.

In comments on the Market, Director Schwartezenburger-Rothchild noted: "It would spear that the Russian and Frencian currencies dominate the market, although the Italian monies have improved considerably. In general there appears to be a shifting of capital out of the Market and into tax-free bonds; particularly those of Bolivia, the Maldive Islands, and Israel."

HELIOTIDAR' (Allen and Rossi PA): In his first public interview His IMPERIOUSNESS Riterwong IX, ruler of Hellotidar today announced that Hellotidar had declared wer on Pollutidar in response to pleas for help from slaves and other lowly creatures in Pollutidar. Particularly well represented in His Inferial Majesty's ancestry are the tribes of cave men inhabiting the sub-continent between the Koarsar Az and the Lural Az.

"His appellation, 'Houj the Horny', is the consequence of a political marriage by his great-grandfuther to a Ganak princess. Aside from two short curved horns, the Empercar's only other inheritance is a long, pointed tail."

"He is a Gilak of imposing stature, with a red skin, inherited from his mother, a Mezop princess who was an aunt of Nein, King of Anoroc. The center of his rule is in the city of Koarsar, but he makes frequent tours through Pollutidar. For example, he has but recently returned, via floating island, from a Progress through the Xexot city of Poeri-peeri.

"Under the Emperoar, the Pollutidarean government consists of the Representative Diet. a body in which all the races of Pollutidar are represented, and in which they function in the brotherly amity which has prevailed since the founding of the Empire. Here you may see ancient foes, Amiocapans and Coripies, Zoramians and Phelians, Luanars and Anorocans, cave men and Mahars, in peace and tranquility. So far has the Empire progressed along the road to brotherhood that casualties at an average sitting, which were 73% at the first meeting of the Diet, have sunk to 28% at the most recent."

A BRIEF HISTORY OF THE GRAND LUCHY OF BEAUCOUILLON - XXIII

The Napoleonic wars offered a solid confirmation of the economic principles on which the Crand Duchy had been founded in Roman times. Armies marched and countermarched, and as they passed by Beaucouillon soldiers of all degree from infantrymen to nobly born generals availed themselves of the pleasures offered there. True, Napoleon did attempt to keep the Grand Duchy's foreign policy in line with his own, but the Ambassader whom he chose for this task was Talleyrand's illegitimate daughter Nme. Salleyrand, and she was more guided by her father than by her severeign. She established an influence over the Grand Duke Fortunato XVIII, and Offen enlivened Grand Ducal balls by a highly individualistic and well-appreciated dance of which she was past mistress.

When it became evident, in 1814, that Napoleon could hold his sway no longer Mme. Salleyrand and the Grand Duke's Prime Minister, Count Pio d'Avino, arranged a deal which put her father's services at the disposal of the Bourbons. But, by adroit statesmanship, Count d'Avino also sold to Napoleon the boat in which he escaped from Elba.

Following Napoleon's final defeat at Waterloo (owing to the loss of a battle plan which General Grouchy had staked on roulette in Beaucouillon, and was later sold to Wellington for 350,000 ducats) the Grand Duchy took its seat at the Congress of Vienna. Beaucouillon received no new territory at Vienna, but a branch office set up by d'Avino in the salon of the Russian diplomat Baron Czerny took in a net profit of 700,000 ducats. Sales of titles of nobility to war millionaires accounted for another half-million ducats. Unfortunately, the rise in the price of green baize occassioned by the slave revolts on the baize plantations of the West Indian island of Santa Chocha absorbed most of the profits, since the Grand Duchy annually imports huge quantities of this material for re-surfacing its gaming tables.

THE MINISTRY OF MISCELLANY

Rod Walker has sent a reprint of an article he wrote for the Augustan Society on the Ptolemid dynasty which ruled Egypt from the college of Alexander's empire to the rise of Rome. This article deals with, among other things, the points raised between us in the last couple of GRAUSTARKS. The article is entitled "The Ptolemids of Egypt and Other Places", and appeared in the August-September 1967 issue of the society's journal, The Augustan.

The Augustan Society, a group of royalty buffs, takes an aggressively defensive posture in an editorial which came along with Rod's article. Redney E. Hartwell writes: "The Augustan is concerned with those subjects generally discarded by the average person ((i. e., kings and their descent and doings)) but which still have importance and give enjoyment to that few, that minority, who set a value and indeed a premium on tradition, culture and good taste," Hartwell disclaims any interest in establishing a king in the United States, since "the institution of Monarchy is unsuited to the climate of this democratic-republic". However, he feels that "the institution of monarchy is...the greatest bulwark against radical change for change's sake, and the threat to western culture which Communism is making, and has made in

central Europe and other parts of the world." Finally, he blusters: "Individuals attributing contrary opinions will be taken before a court of law for slander and defamation of character."

Come off it: Most of the Communist governments of eastern Rurope were immediately preceded by monarchies, which were worthless as "bulwarks against...Communism". This was the case in Rumania, Bulgaria, and Hungary, though Hungary was operated under the fiction of a "regency". It was also the case in Yugoslavia and Albania, though their pre-war dynasties had been replaced by sovereigns from the House of Savoia who were more amenable to Nazi dictation. And the USSR was founded on the ruins of a monarchy which was vowed to firm resistance to the least change of their traditional status. In Greece, monarchy has given birth to Fascism, and in Spain Fascism will soon give birth to monarchy.

This, of course, begs the whole question about an alleged "Communist threat to western culture". Mhether or not you believe in an "international Communist conspiration, it cannot be denied that Communism is, and has been from its crigins, of the West. Marx and Engels were the heirs of a western idealogical tradition; Lenin and the other founders of Soviet communism were thoroughly westernized, and the progress made by the USSR in the past 50 years has been away from the passive, mystical East towards the dynamic, industrial West. At one time the "boundary between East and West" was just outside the city limits of Vienna; today its is at a launching site in Baikonur, and still moving steadily eastward.

And the tame monarchies of western Europe? They pose no danger to popular liberty because they were all well disciplined in previous centuries. The Augustan Society speaks of tradition. Your editor, too, has a tradition. I am kinsman and namesake of the man who, 319 years ago, threw this gage to the Royalists of Europe:

"It is lawfull, and hath been held so through all ages, for any, who have the power, to call to account a tyrant, or wicked king, and after due conviction, to depose, and put him to death; if the ordinary magistrate have neglected, or deny'd to dee it." - John Milton, The Tenure of Kings and Magistrates

The ghost of Charles I has squeaked and gibbered at the elbow of every subsequent British king who thought of infringing the liberties of his subjects. If some countries can still afford the luxury of a royal family, it is because their inhabitants for chears once took the trouble to see that their kings didn't get the notion that they had anything to do with running the country.

"Unless you are an expert gamester at cards and dice, a rank whoremester, a stout drinker, a daring extravagant, and understand the art of borrowing and bubbling, and have got the French pox to boot, scarce anyone will believe you to be a knight." - Frasmus.

On 17 March 1968 died Walter Millis, a 69-year-old historian and member of the staff of the Center for the Study of Democratic Institutions. He was particularly interested in the causes of war, and in the field of arms control. His books The Read to War: 1914-1917 (1935) and Why Europe Fights (1945) dealt with the causes of the First and Second World Wars respectively. He also refuted the view that President Rocsevelt had, through an elaborate plot to retain power, instigated the Japanese attack on Pearl Harbor. This view, once widely held by conservative politicians attempting to discredit the late President's memory, set in motion a post-war congressional investigation. Mr. Millis' book This is Pearl! (1947) pinned the blame on the military and naval commanders at Pearl Harbor.

LEFTOVERS #4 has just been published by the editor of GRAUSTARK. This truncated issue of the family genzine deals with two highly current events: the assassination of Ir. Martin Luther King Jr. and the abdication of Fresident Johnson. LEFTOVERS is 5 issues for \$1.00, but, since #4 is so short, it is available for 10¢.

Do you, as an apponent of war, semetime feel discouraged about the pessibility that anything can be accomplished? Be reassured. Representative John M. Murphy (m., N. Y. 16), a West Point graduate, has complained that anti-war protests are just as effective as guerilla operations in the jungles of Vietnam".

One Paul S. Wandner has similar concerns, to judge from a letter published in the New York Post on 8 March 1968. He wrote: "I not only support the Johnson Administration's policy in Vietnam, but I also believe that we could learn some valuable lessons from the Saigen government. Why not jail Sanator Fulbright, Sanator McCarthy, Martin Luther King and other men hurting the war effort? Then we will have extended the cause of freedom and democracy not only across the seas, but right here at home."

Since then the friends of war have taken more direct measures to silence such critics. Dr. King has been murdered, and the search for his murderer has been turned ever to an agency whose head once branded Dr. King a liar, and whose ranks are filled with white supremacists. A Minuteman plot to assassinate Senator Fulbright was revealed ever a year ago. And, inspired by Dr. King's murder, a German conservative named Josef Bachmann made an attempt on the life of Rudi Dutschke, a German anti-war leader.

Slovenia is a part of Austria-Hungary, and is bounded by Venice, Tyrolia, Trieste, and the Adriatic Sea.
