vateer ship under the command of Richard Richards, and allowed at last to get off their feet. In fact, they were kept continuously off their feet for more than a week, which explains the delay in their arrival. Now, however, they are honored guests of the Court.

EDINBURGH: The Royal Liverpool Fusiliers, hearing of bloody doings on the Continent, are growing impatient. They are aware that they have been ordered to Brussels, but the troop transports are still awaited. "It's that ruler of the Queen's Navy we have...that Joseph Porter! He says all Britain proudly chants his praise: well, we don't! Why doesn't he get us transported to the action? What can you expect from a political appointee?"

OSLO: British fleets steamed into port today and raised King George's flag high over the rooftops. The Fjord Motor Works was immediately called upon to begin producing materiel for the British war effort, and the president, Henry Fjord, is reported to have said, "If you promise to put my picture on a postage stamp, we'll help you."

CONSTANTINOPLE (25 September 1901, SPP): Vice Sultan (known to his friends as - you guessed it - "In") Tolerable today voiced the first official view as to the origin of our beloved Sultan Yuk's family name. "Our Sultan, good-natured, kind, and benevolent as he is, certainly would not, I think, object to my telling you reporters of the Ancient Turkish Tale concerning the Yuk - a creature too low to kick and too wet to step on. Our honorable Sultan then departed for another relaxing evening with the harem, muttering: "Yuk Babes, you musn't let yourself be too distraught. After all, you are kind, generous, warm, witty, wise, and, above all - humble."

HYDUNDERABAD, INDIA: Maharajah Kamasutra IX, absolute monarch of this tiny Indian state, today offered political asylum to any refugees from the political crisis in Turkey. "This particularly includes the delicate lotus blossoms of Sultan Yuk's harem, who can find peace and tranquility in this land."

The Maharajah's statement was challenged from his secret camp in the hills by the rebel leader Pandit the Bandit, leader of the Peristaltic Movement. "Once the tyranny of the Maharajah is overthrown," he said, "Hydunderabad will be an oasis of liberty. Turkish refugees will be most welcome - particularly any harem girls who choose to join us."

LONDON (24 February 1908): The cold snaws of deepest winter hold the capital of Britain in a seemingly unbreakable icy grip. But the cold is only on the surface. In the great Throne Room of the Tower, things are quite warm. In fact, the Throne Globe is fairly seething, as King Huon XVIII, known as "Huon the Malignant" to His friends and close associates (they both agreed it was appropriate) is once again railing against His chief Minister, Colonel Sebastian Moran, Duke of Northumbria.

"You dare tell Me, you quivering mass of putrescent, This is pusillanimous, peeristic flesh, that there is a Russian fleet steaming off York?? In Home Waters?!?"

"Well, yesssss, Your Majesty..."

The Augustan Society can take heart at last. Although the institution of monarchy is in decline elsewhere in the world, the King of Nepal has asserted the ancient privileges of his crown.

The prestige of the Nepalese throne reached a low point in 1954, when King Tribhubana's plans to visit the United States were blocked. It seems that His Majesty planned to bring both his wives, and bigamists are not allowed entry under U. S. immigration laws. This upstart republic makes no exception even for kings.

Shortly afterwards King Tribhubana died, and was succeeded by his son King Mahendra. At first things looked no better for him. Mahendra was compelled to institute representative government, and by 1960 a Prime Minister was running the country. But, with the support of the United States government - presumably regretful over its treatment of his father - King Mahendra threw the Prime Minister and his cabinet into jail, and re-established a governmental structure under which the King ceased to be responsible to the people or to anything else.

These facts came out when Amnesty International tried to do something for the democratically elected politicians who are still in jail. Assistant Secretary of State William B. Macomber Jr. replied with this expression of support for King Mahendra:

"Nepal is moving forward at its own pace...The country's experiment with western parliamentary institutions led to problems of instability."

The hopes of some Augustans, of the establishment of a monarchy in this country, seem near realization. After all, people seem willing to make this same judgment about the United States of America.

But elsewhere in the world, monarchs still have their problems. Queen Elizabeth II had two red carpets rolled out for her in London on 28 December 1968. The first one had been put on the wrong side of the civic officials who were to see her off for a holiday. The officials walked over the carpet, leaving muddy footprints. No heads were rolled -

only another carpet.

Other members of a royal family also made their departure last month. Caudillo Franco shipped out of Spain all the members of the Bourbon-Parma, or Carlist, branch of the Capets. Franco has his own pet pretender, Don Juan, and is not looking for competition from the elderly Don Javier or his son Don Carlos Hugo. Owing to Don Javier's advanced age, Don Carlos Hugo is the chief Carlist activist.

Other Bourbon-Parmas given the bum's rush were Don Javier's wife and their two daughters.

Things aren't so good in the Juan branch of the family, either. Franco would like to pass over Don Juan, who has regrettably democratic inclinations, and give the throne to Juan's son Juan Carlos. Juan Carlos, 30, has let it be known that he will cheerfully shove his father out of the way if he gets a clear road to the throne.

If you're keeping count, Don Juan would be Juan III. Juan Carlos has his choice: he can be either Juan III or Carlos V. But the Carlists give this latter title to their founder, and regard his seed as Carlos VI and Carlos VII. Accordingly, Don Javier would be Javier I, while his son could be either Hugo I or Carlos VIII.

And things could get wilder. The Bourbon-Parmas are regarded by some French royalists as the true French heirs, and they also have a shirt-tail claim to the Jacobite inheritance.

Other Spanish grandees aren't doing so well. The Duchess of Medina-Sidonia - present title-holder of the honors once borne by the incompetent commander of the Armada - is about to be thrown into prison for backing the damage claims of the Palomares villagers, who were showered with radioactive materials when a U. S. bomber scattered parts of a hydrogen bomb over them in 1966. The Duchess, who has been in the forefront of liberal and democratic agitation in Spain, is regarded as a traitor to her class by most of the other 1737 Spanish nobles.

"It fell on a day, on a bonnie summer's day, when the sun
shone bright and clearly,

That there fell out a great dispute atween Argyll and Airlie."
These two Scottish noble houses, linked in a ballad dating from the Bishops' Wars, are back in the news. The British government is trying to retrench its military spending, and the Argyll and Sutherland Highlanders will be disbanded under this plan. Since the Duke of Argyll is Chief of Clan Campbell, every Campbell in the world is apparently backing a campaign to retain the Argylls. Recently a huge bundle of pro-Argyll petitions was submitted to Parliament - in 22 whiskey cartons!

The late 12th Earl of Airlie was also connected with a highland regiment. In 1949 he ordered a 600-man battalion of the Black Watch to remove their kilts. It seems that rumors had reached His Lordship that some Scots soldiers had so far deserted the traditions of the forebears as to wear undershorts beneath the kilts. Alas, he did find that several of the men were clad in "English unmentionables".

Anna Chaikovskaya Anderson, long-time veteran of the pretender business, was in the news on 27 December 1968 when she married one of the few men who still believes that she is a surviving daughter of the last Russian Tsar, Nikolai the Worthless. Her new husband is Prof. John E. Manahan, who is 18 years her junior.

For most people, the definitive word on Anna Anderson's claims was pronounced over 35 years ago in the memoirs of the Grand Duke Alexander Mikhailovich, who would have been her uncle had her claims been valid. The Grand Duke said he could understand how her privations might have

caused her to forget things that the real Anastasia should have known, but that he failed to see how these misfortunes might cause her to speak Russian with a Polish accent.

No word on this latest development has been heard from Col. Goleniewski, a Polish emigre who claims to have been an agent of the Polish spy agency. When Goleniewski's revelations received a sympathetic hearing before a congressional committee, he escalated his claims, and now pretends to be Anastasia's brother, the Tsarevich Alexei and rightful Tsar of Russia!
