Villiers was assassinated in Portsmouth, not in London as was stated in #180.

CONSTANTINOPLE (30 Sec. 1902, SPP): The entire Turkish village of Hadben Thair was today executed for suggesting that if Sultan Yuk were to journey abroad without his bodyguards the entire Turkish army would probably follow him with a vengeance. Usually informed sources hinted that this was not precisely the type of suggestion the Sultan had envisioned.

CONSTANTINOPLE (15 Mar. 1903, SPP): Our beloved Sultan Yuk today issued his first set of official orders to the remains of the purge-decimated Turkish Forces. As I understand, revolution is a concerted movement which replaces one political-social system with another. Assassination is an isolated act of vengeance. Killing one man will not avail to change a system. (For this reason I would not condone the murder of Brezhnev or Mao.) Do you think the substitution of Vorster for Verwoerd is an improvement?

As I have repeatedly said, what is assassination if not war on an individual scale? There is something warped in a viewpoint which can justify one, but not the other.

((I quite agree that a viewpoint which justifies war, but not assassination, is warped.))

Anyhow, the "assassination" of Mussolini was certainly an act of (GASP! SHUDDER! ULTIMATE HORROR!) war, and I am surprised to see you defend it.

((Benito Mussolini was assassinated by his fellow-countrymen after the merest sham of a "trial". No initiative on the part of the allied military authorities or any soldiers acting under their command was involved. It can be regarded as virtually a typical case of a justifiable tyrannicide.))

Stay tuned for the next thrill-packed episode of "The Phantom of the Elysee". ((Wha-a-a?))

Not only that, but he sold it twice, to Charles VII of France and to Ferdinand the Catholic of Aragon. And the pretender of your choice is the heir of Ferdinand. ((And, allowing the Salic Law, the heir of Charles VII as well.))

Semirechinsk was one of the governments joining the All-Russian Provisional Government in 1918. This is presumably Rod's Central Asian Republic.

Verneudinsk was one of several Siberian "city republics" set up by the Bolsheviks under the auspices of Krasnoshchekhov, later founder of the Far Eastern

Republic.

Kilwa: Rod is right, as with Santa Cruz, Mahabad, Seiyun, Mirdita, Palmares, and Maryland. ((See GRAUSTARK #176 and #178.)) The "Republic of Palmares" was actually a monarchy.

The Centrocaspian (not Transcaspian) Dictatorship - or maybe Directorship - held Baku briefly in 1919. (Hell, who didn't?) I believe this was the government which invited the hapless Dunsterville expedition.

The South-Eastern Union was formed by various Cossack and White groups in the Don-Terek region in 1917 or 1918. It seems to have been aligned with the Central Powers.

Vorarlberg: With the Imperial collapse of 1918, the province unsuccessfully sought admission into the Swiss Confederation. (Austria as we know it did not exist then.)

The Lokot "Republic" in Byelorussia was proclaimed during the Second World

War. The Lokoters reportedly bribed the Germans to let them alone, and fought off a "rescuing" Red Army detachment.

Dadra is a city in Western India. Town, rather. It is a centrally administered territory which may be found in the Statesman's Yearbook. Until 1954 Dadra and Nagar Haveli formed an enclave of Damao, itself an enclave of Portuguese India, entirely surrounded by India. In July the enclave was seized by Indian "nationalist volunteers" ((I think the words you want are "outside agitators")) but India did not formally take over the administration until 1960, so I suppose it was nominally independent in the mean time.

Euzkadi proclaimed its independence ((in the Basque provinces)) during the Spanish civil war, and fell in 1937.

Manavadar was a no-account, minuscule princely state in India near Junagadh (or Hyderabad, I am not sure which). It was one of the four states which had not acceded to India or Pakistan by Dominion Day, thus enjoying a brief independence. The other three were Hyderabad, Jammu & Kashmir, and a similar overgrown estate named Mangrol.

((It's my understanding that the Maharajah of Jammu & Kashmir acceded to India but that Pakistan refused to recognize the act, leading to the present impasse. Hyderabad attempted to go it alone, but it became a base of bardit operations against India, which surrounded it on all sides. Since the Moslem ruler had refused to accede, and since his subjects were about 85% Hindu, the Indian government put an end to the farce shortly after Dominion Day.

("Hydunderabad", which has appeared in the press releases for 1965Q and 1968CI, was created by Al Capp for the comic strip Abbie and Slats as a scene for the sometime adventures of Bathless Groggins.))

The State of Maindomba was proclaimed during the civil war in the northern Leopoldville province of the Congo.

Alash Orda soon split into factions, due to the location of its government in several cities. I believe Rod's East Kazakh Republic was one of these factions.

Mountaineers' Republic: In full, Islamic Republic of the Mountaineers of Dagh-estan, a north Caucasian state 1918-1919.

Tellguria is not a misprint. It was one of numerous client républics set up by the French, and as usual they used a Latinate form.

The government feels that this disservice to our service was the work of agents of Trypheme, masquerading as lackeys of Don Alduc of San Guin, mortal enemies of the Hernian People. Don Alduc, of course, as well as being in the employ of the infamous Sir Occo, is bound by sinister ties to the Antrum of Highmore, hereditary ruler of Clan McLeod. The real name of our news agency is derived from our practice of tying messages to the back parts of goats, and speeding them on their way with a swift kick. Because of our use of goats, the correct name is the 'Gruff Press'. We also publish dirty books.

If past precedent is any indication, the Sultan's recent bad temper will have been assuaged by the time he emerges.
