He told the people that we have just entered a war which will cost the lives of thousands of Frenchmen. He then asked for a moment of silence. After which he asked the people to sing the national anthem along with him. There wasn't a closed mouth or a dry eye in the country.

THE MINISTRY OF MISCELLANY

One week after I published my comments on the Agent Crange mess in the last issue of GRAUSTARK, Elmo R. Zumwalt III died of the effects of this defoliant at the age of 42. His father, Admiral Elmo R. Zumwalt Jr., had ordered the use of this agent, and both Zumwalt continued to justify its use even when it became clear that the younger one was dying of it, and that his 11-year-old son Elmo R. The implacable hostility of Vietnam veterans to the concept that peace is preferable to war is leading them over the edge of rationality. Congress can put no one on trial except impeached federal officials. (Does the VFW think she is one?) But the VFW's action shows that there can be no dialog or compromise with the bloody-minded maniacs who continue to think that the American attack on Vietnam was a good idea.

Laura Palmer's column in the New York Daily News (21 & 28 August) asked readers to comment on her belief that, while the war was a good idea, the campaign against Fonda is stupid. She got 51 responses, of which 29 disagreed with her. I can confidently assert that the language used in the anti-Fonda letters could not be printed in a daily newspaper - but then, we all know what Vietnam veterans are.

Palmer also addressed the nomination of J. Danforth Quayle III as the Republican candidate for Vice President. (Is there something about people with numbers after their names, that we don't know?) I cannot see why everyone is so mad at Quayle for going into the National Guard and thus staying out of Vietnam. Anyone who was 21 in 1968, and kept his ass out of Vietnam, deserves our respect and maybe our votes. This, remember, was a matter of saving his life! If he were drowning, should he say, "I'm not going to inflate this life raft my rich daddy gave me, because it wouldn't be fair to the men who don't have rich daddies to buy them life rafts"? Would Quayle be better liked if he had been at the bottom of the Mekong River for the last 20 years?

And what about the men whose families couldn't pull strings to get them out of Vietnam? Well, the buses still run to Canada. It is not all that difficult to get Talse identification and "go underground", or send a realistic looking death certificate to your draft board, or find a friendly physician to certify you as physically untit. Every man who went to Vietnam to kill people, went there because he would rather be in Vietnam killing people than anywhere else. Spare them your tears.

Palmer, needless to say, praises the late Lt. Zumwalt and condemns Quayle. She goes so far as to call Zumwalt, who suffered nothing that he had not been willing to inflict, "an American hero". Zumwalt died. Quayle survived. If Palmer has any complaints about this, she should take them up with Charles Darwin.

Robert Sacks, acting through the unbelievable name "Karel Alaric", has sent out Darkside Analysis - a Self-Testing Procedure.
