LONDON: The Bank of London has placed £ 100,000,000 in the account of the French Government. The money was donated by Englishmen to help the French Government endure the Turkish confrontation. If, and only if, the French Government requests English support, two English fleets will be sent to assist the French. Otherwise, England will honor the Treaty of 1901 and not enter into the Channel, Irish Sea, or North Atlantic.
