I want to again remind players, especially players in the new game, that the U. S. Postal "Service" is not capable of reliably getting mail here in less than a week. Please take this into account in sending in your moves. If, a few times, your moves have taken less than a week to get here, do not assume that this will always be the case.

Graustark readers who are interested in postal games which don't run here, are invited to write to the publishers of 'zines with which I trade, and ask what game openings they have. For their addresses, see all the readers indicated by "(T)" for "trade" in the Graustark Directory on pp. 10-11. Several of these publishers run a wide variety of postal games.

I was happy to see that no one got shot by the police in the streets of Manhattan during the Republican National Convention. The nearest thing to it came when a policeman drove his motor scooter full tilt into a group of demonstrators. One of his victims, in an act of self-defense, knocked the cop unconscious. New York City is now fighting in court a large fine assessed by a federal judge because the police held many demonstrators more than 24 hours without either charging them or releasing them. #### WHY CURSING IS NOT JUST SWEARING

John Maddox Roberts, SPQR VII: The Tribune's Curse (2003, St. Martin's Press, NY; \$15 tpb) For reviews of the six previous books in this series see Graustarks ##600, 614, 708 & 740.

The first historically set crime novels reviewed in these pages were adventures of Decius Caecilius Metellus Junior, a Roman aristocrat of plebeian stock and a junior member of one of the Roman Republic's most prestigious families. It is therefore appropriate that, now that I am able to resume these reviews, we once again visit Decius. Now, in the year 699 AVC (55 BCE), he is 35, fifteen years older than when we first met him. He has recently returned from campaigning in Gaul under Gaius Julius Caesar, and has just married Caesar's niece Julia. (Julia, like her new husband a fictitious character, is introduced to us as the daughter of Lucius Julius Caesar, brother of the conqueror of Gaul. Historically, Lucius was the third cousin of Gaius, an officer under his command in Gaul, and the maternal uncle of Marc Antony.)

Decius is running for the office of aedile, which is explained on page 2 of the book, and is pitched into a political squabble over the ambitions of his uncle's current political allies Gnaeus Pompeius Magnus ("Pompey the Great") and Marcus Licinius Crassus Dives ("the Fat God" - I am not making this up). After the expiration of his term as consul, Crassus will become governor of Syria, and is taking a large army east with him for an attack on the Kingdom of Parthia, the territory now occupied by two members of "President" Bush's "Axis of Evil".

This war is strongly opposed by two "tribunes of the people", Gaius Ateius Capito and Sextus Silvius. Tribunes, who had to come from plebeian families, were supposedly the protection of the plebeians against any oppressive notions hatched by the aristocrats in Rome's self-perpetuating Senate. Their persons were nominally protected by law, although the late dictator Sulla and other military thugs in the aristocracy's employ did not always respect their status.

Ateius Capito should not be confused with another man of the same name, who founded and headed a law school during the reign of Augustus Caesar, and may have been a grandson of the tribune. Nor should we understand his opposition to a war with Parthia in terms of the anti-war movements of our own time. Any Roman politician knew that the general who conquered Parthia or Egypt would instantly become the richest man in Rome, and would be able to take control of that singularly venal society without regard to the forms of the unwritten Roman constitution. But all legal attempts to prevent this war have failed, and so Ateius resorts to a last desperate measure as Cassius' troops are marching out of the city. As the troops are marching through a city gate, he mounts that gate in a fantastic get-up and pronounces an elaborate curse upon Crassus, his war, and its supporters. (His outfit and actions are described in detail by the author, but the cover artist apparently had other ideas.) As Robert Benchley observed in one of his humorous but trenchant essays, modern men have largely lost the ability to cast elaborate and effective curses, but in 55 BCE Ateius Capito let go with a really powerful one.

In this act, watched with pious horror by Decius and a great crowd of superstitious Romans, Ateius invokes not only the Olympian gods but also a great number of native Italian and ancient Etruscan deities, including some whose names are not supposed to be spoken aloud in public. He even, Decius is told later, pronounced in public the closely guarded "secret name of Rome". It was believed by many ancient peoples that to know and speak aloud a thing's true name was to have power over it. This seems to be the real meaning of the commandment about "taking the lord's name in vain". And it is why the name of their god is to this day not supposed to be spoken aloud by Jews.

A propitiatory ritual must immediately be performed in hopes that it will avert the curse, and then Decius is assigned the job of finding Ateius and Silvius, and bringing them to justice for this monstrous, and unpatriotic, act of blasphemy. Eventually he succeeds, although the fate of Ateius as told by Decius does not agree with the historical record. And the curse apparently does succeed. In 53 BCE, the army of Crassus suffered a disastrous defeat by the Parthians, Crassus himself was killed, the alliance between Pompey and Caesar was broken, and the myth of Roman invincibility was forever shattered.

(Eventually, nearly two centuries later, the Roman Emperor Trajan did conquer

Iraq. But the next emperor realized that it couldn't be held, and abandoned it. Obviously, nobody in Washington knows this.)

In this book, Ateius' colleague Sextus Silvius seems to be an invention of the author, since the name "Silvius" was apparently limited to the extinct royal family of Alba Longa, a formerly important religious center which had been destroyed in Rome's mythic age by its third king.

Another minor character is young Gaius Cassius Longinus, the second in command of Crassus, and one of the few who escaped the disaster in Parthia. He eventually became one of Caesar's assassins, nine years later. Shakespeare gave him "a lean and hungry look", but Decius describes him as a muscular military type, "buff" as we would say. Since Dante also called Cassius "brawny" (membruto), his may be a more accurate description than Shakespeare's.

engaging in sheer hysteria about the Kerry campaign. (One of many examples is a heading in the New York Post of 22 September that "Hanoi John betrayed his country". Another is the website of Swift Boat Veterans for Truth, which calls the Democratic candidate "Commie Kerry".) The election of John Kerry, with working majorities of Democrats in Congress, would give conservatives apoplectic fits - no, make that apocalyptic fits. They would emit loud shrieks about the horseble prospects of peace, the downfall of Christian civilization, higher clean air standards, Satan-worship, a federal health plan, gay marriages, practicable gun control, recreational abortions, closer international cooperation, and Witches dancing in the streets.

I have my doubts about the methodologies of the polls that purport to show Bush and Kerry in a dead heat. If this were the case, why are the Republicans campaigning as if they were in the last extremity of desperation? In addition to the examples given above, a gold star mother was arrested for heckling Laura Bush while wearing a shirt proclaiming that "President" Bush killed her son. Catholic and Fundamentalist churches have suspended their historic hostility to each other while beating the bushes for Bush voters, in open violation of their tax—exempt status. Proposals to ban gay marriage and to revive the military draft have failed in Congress, not because anyone believed they could actually pass, but as ploys to score points with the Republican "voter base". Expect more of this sort of thing before Election Day. Preposterous legal barriers are being put in the way of drives to register new voters from groups that have traditionally supported Democrats, and Michael Moore has been threatened with arrest for supporting this drive.

And I am beginning to believe that we will see all these signs of panic over the election of President Kerry. This fall I have been doing an unusual amount of traveling for various personal reasons, which has contributed to the delay in the publication of this issue, but has also acquainted me with public opinion in various parts of the country. Not many people displayed campaign buttons or stickers in New York and California, but the ones that did were uniformly for Kerry. And in Maryland, which no one doubts will go for Kerry, I saw no indications that there was an election at all, except for local candidates and issues. So apparently the "blue states" are going to turn even bluer. These three states have a total of 96 electoral votes, more than a third of the total needed for election. (Foreign readers of Graustark should not ask me to explain the concept of "electoral votes". It cannot be done.)

But I also visited one of the states that is "in play", as they say. In 2000, New Hampshire was the only northeastern state carried by Bush, by a margin of 7,211 votes out of 567,805 cast. This year, with my hosts Ed and Sandy Meškys, and Connecticut science-fiction fans Ed Hutnik and Jean Wardwell\*, I spent Sunday 10 October visiting an agricultural fair in New Sandwich. Both major parties had booths there, which were handing out campaign literature, buttons, and stickers. But, in this rural region of a "swing state", many more people were wearing Kerry than Bush buttons.

So you will learn fairly early on election night whether Kerry will win. New

Hampshire is a small state, and its vote is reported early. If New Hampshire goes for Kerry by a substantial margin, you can count on him winning the election.

While this issue of Graustark was in preparation, about half of the file crashed. This means that there will not be a Graustark Directory in this issue. All the addresses in the Graustark Directory Graustark #757 remain valid except for that of Albert A. Nofi, who is in the process of moving. As soon as I have a valid address for him, I will print it in a future issue. The addresses for players in the new game, 2004C, are on p. 3.

In the 1950s there was an eccentric named Emanuel Josephson, who wrote books and pamphlets claiming that the United States of America is in reality not a democratic republic but an aristocratic republic like ancient Rome or medieval Venice, ruled by an elite group of interrelated families who kept a close control of its policies and high offices. In support of this thesis he published genealogical tables showing that most American presidents came from families closely related to one another by blood or marriage. For example, the two Presidents Roosevelt were more closely related to President Grant than they were to each other.

There is a superficial attractiveness to this hypothesis. With only three exceptions, all American presidents have come from Protestant families of British or Dutch origin, which were settled here before the American Revolution. Moreover, there were at that time fewer than four million people in the United States. And custom further narrowed the marriage market. People usually did not travel great distances, and marriages across class, ethnic, or religious lines were rare. So it is not surprising that many of the white Protestant families of that period, including those which produced presidents, are related to one another. As but one example, Barbara Pierce Bush is a cousin of President Franklin Pierce.

A genealogist named Gary Boyd Roberts revealed, in the New York Times of 19 September 2004, that George W. Bush and John F. Kerry are related to each other in eight different ways. (As I can assure you, WASPs are compulsive record keepers, which makes this research possible.) The common ancestor in each case lived in Massachusetts or in southern England in the 16th or 17th century. Kerry's connection is his mother's side, which is studded with old New England names such as Forbes and Winthrop. Their closest relationship is 9th cousin twice removed, through Edmund Reade (1563-1623) of Wickford, Essex.

However, if it comes to ancestor matching, Kerry had Bush solidly defeated. On his father's side, Kerry is the grandson of Fritz Kohn, a Bohemian Jew who converted to Roman Catholicism. The name "Kohn" is a form of the Hebrew kohen, "priest". And the bible informs us that all Jewish priests (kohanim) are members of the Tribe of Levi, descended in the male line from Moses' brother Aaron. Recently DNA studies have tended to support this. (However, some of Aaron's sons were no bargain.)

But this is probably not the whole story. The bible, no matter whose edition is consulted, is a conflation from several sources, written at different times by people with different agendas, and not always in agreement with one another. In 2 Samuel 8:18 it flatly asserts that "David's sons were priests". Since King David was of the Tribe of Judah, not of Levi, this text is clearly older than the monopolization of the priesthood by the descendants of Aaron.

And then we come to the question of genealogy itself. A few centuries ago, a French nobleman named Lévis hired someone to create a genealogy for him, that claimed he was descended from Levi son of Jacob, and therefore related to most of the major characters in the Jewish and Christian scriptures. When he left for mass at the Cathedral of Nôtre Dame, he told his coachman "Chez ma cousine!"

When it became evident that American troops were going to invade Iraq, a nation which had never done us any harm, there were coordinated productions of Aristophanes' raunchy anti-war play Lysistrata ("Demobilizer") all over the world. What many people do not know is that three of the eleven surviving plays of this Athenian playwright of the minus-fifth century are anti-war. The first of them, and the earliest Aristophanes

### DUNGEONS & CHRISTIANS - CLXXVI

This year we have seen the Republican Party attempt to destroy any distinction that may still exist, between a political campaign and a revival meeting. But, so far, they have not claimed that Dungeons & Dragons (D&D) and other role-playing games (RPGs) are satanic worship services designed to drag their players away from Christian belief and into lifetimes of sin, and will be suppressed under the second administration of the second Bush.

It is possible, of course, that the complete failure of such accusations to affect legislatures and court cases is finally getting across to the Christian opponents of RPGs, and that they have given up on accusations which have never persuaded any court in any country that such games cause their players to commit crimes, suicide, or any other anti-social acts. However, what is more likely is that they have found other accusations that impress greater numbers of voters. In order to arouse public indignation about RPGs, they would have to explain in some detail just what they are and how they are played, and this might seem attractive to the very people they are trying to pull away from this hobby.

Moreover, game-bashers seem to fear that the brightest youths with the best imaginations are most "at risk" for gaming. (At one time, there were similar fears that Communism would be particularly attractive to such people.) This could only persuade bright young people, who are at an age where alternation runs strong anyhow, to get

involved in RPGs.

And so instead the Christian Right is campaigning against abortion, homosexuality (including gay marriage or less formal sorts of officially recognized bonding), Muslims, and freedom of religion generally. (See the views quoted on p. 5 of this issue of Graustark for some particulars.) It has certainly not escaped their attention that in 2002 a popular incumbent Democratic senator in Georgia was defeated by a Republican who promised to station south Georgia sheriffs to keep Muslims from entering the state. have not been informed how well this plan is working.) And they have discovered to their horror that George Soros, a major contributor to Senator Kerry's campaign, is an Atheist.

Latest is a Republican claim that if "liberals" win they will ban the bible as "hate literature". Well, of course it is hate literature. What is the use of even having a religion if you can't use it to be masty to people? But the bible should not be banned - far from it. The strongest arguments against Christianity often come from within the Christian bible, from its endorsements of war, racism, slavery, genocide,





Hallowe'en approaches, and with it Christian condemnation of this harmless perpetuation of a once serious ritual. Hallowe'en is in fact much older than Christianity, older than the notion that the souls of the dead forever go "elsewhere" for rewards, temporary or perpetual punishments, or reincarnation. In ancient times it was believed that ghosts got to wander the earth on one night of the year, during which their living descendants prudently kept radoors and left propitiatory gifts of food on their doorsteps for their ancestors. Christians have been unable to suppress "trick-ortreating", which is the present form of this ritual, and most of them don't bother trying, or even encourage their children to participate. It certainly says something about the effectiveness of Christianity, that after two thousand years many people who call themselves Christians also believe in such non-Christian or even anti-Christian concepts as ghosts, ass trology, communication with the dead, reincarnation, or "the little people". (President Kennedy's devoutly Catholic grandmother once sacked a maid for dumping dishwater down the back steps; it was an insult to "the little people".)

In recent years, rather than trying to suppress Hallowe'en decorations and parties, some Christians have marked this season with "Hell Houses" in which volunteers or hired actors simulate the tortures of the damned, particularly those who are damned for currently fashionable sins such as homosexuality, incest, drug use, or Pacifism. Presumably such activities are also planned for this year, although no reports on them have yet been printed for the amusement of city-dwellers. The nearest we have come to it is some extra Christian concern over the fact that this year people will observe Hallowe'en even though it falls on a Sunday.

I would appreciate it if readers could send me clippings about any anti-Hallowe'en activities that they may find in the papers.

play whose text we have, is his prize-winning The Acharnians.

Acharnia is an outlying deme, or as we would say "suburb", of Athens. The play's hero realizes that his farm lies right on the most likely Spartan invasion route. So he gets a relative, who is a diplomat, to negotiate a private peace treaty for him. When the Spartans invade, he establishes what we would call a "free market" on his farm, taking profit from both sides and living in an island of tranquillity while the rest of Greece is ruined by a war that eventually lasted almost thirty years, and resulted in a defeat for the over-confident Athenians, from which their city never recovered.

An off-Broadway production of *The Acharnians* is now in progress, and I expect to see it before it closes on 24 October. I will report on it in the next issue.

The second of the anti-war plays of Aristophanes is the rarely performed *Peace*, probably the weakest of the three. The third is the notorious *Lysistrata*, the most popular because it satirizes not only war but also sex roles, marital discord, and the control of public funds.

snickered, "He's a 'half-wit' or a 'nit wit'." Others saw some reason for hope, thinking Ivan a 'no wit'.

WOGASTISBURGER-NEUSTADT, GRAND DUCHY OF WOGASTISBURG-SCHLAMPENBUTTEL (URRP [United Rabble-Rousing Press], May 2, 1901): A Foothill Conference convened today in this picturesque town high in the Balkan Massif, for the purpose of discussing the reaction of the Four And A Half Kingdoms to the outbreak of war in Europe. The conference had originally been scheduled for Anakhit, the capital of the Kingdom of Skandalutz, but was moved after delegates learned that, despite the generally permissive customs of that ancient matriarchy, sexual relations are forbidden there during the month of May.

The delegate of the Temporary Roman Empire refused to recognize the existence of the war, since it regards most of the nations, involved as illegal squatters on rightfully Roman territory. The Pravoslavnian Patrimony of Polykarp is also reluctant to deal with nations which reject the Holy Quaternity as revealed in the Newer Testament. Skandalutz made its traditional offer of asylum to soldiers escaping from any side of the war. As usual, the delegate from the Kingdom of Pundschdruk had received neither instructions nor an expense account from his government, and was last seen camping out in Grand Duke Gurgustius IV Park. The Grand Duchy, which is the region's "Half Kingdom" since it is technically a feudal dependency of the Holy Roman Empire, is expected to formulate a policy towards the conference as soon as a new cabinet can be arranged in the Landnacht following the collapse of the coalition of the Libertarian Socialist Party, the Extreme Radical Centrist Party, and the Poets and Peasants Alliance.

In a related development, President William Jennings Bryan of the United States of America withdrew a commitment to sent an observer to the Foothill Conference. He apparently disapproves of several of the customs of the Kingdom of Skandalutz, including the orginatic Winter Solstice Festival, the Summer Outdoor Erotic Verse Competition, and the annual festival of the works of the great Skandalous playwright William Shakewrist. (The plays chosen for this year's festival are Two Gentlemen of Gomorrah, The Merry Wives of Lesbos, and Romeo and Julius.) "Do these degenerate Skandals think that human beings are some kind of monkey?" President Bryan indignantly complained.
