## RUSSO-GERMAN ALLIANCE ADVANCES ON ALL FRONTS

ITALY: No moves received. A Pic & F Wes hold their positions.

F North Sea-Edi; F Norway S

Underlined moves are not possible.

The English army in Edinburgh is annihilated, and the Austro-Hungarian army in Serbia must retreat to Albania. The High Contracting Powers now control the following supply centers:

ENGLAND: Ivy, Lon. (2)

FRANCE: Bre, Mar, Par, Pic, Spa. (5)

GERMANY: Bel, Ber, Den, Edi, Hal, Kla, Mun, Tri. (8)

ITALY: Rom, Tum. (2)

AUSTRIA-HUNGARY: Nap, Ven. (2)

RUSSIA: Bul, Mas, Nor, Rum, St.P, Ser, Sev, Sve, Vis, War. (10)

TURKEY: Ank, Bul, Coa, Cre, Smy. (5)

Germany and Russia may each establish 2 new units. England must remove 1 unit, and Austria-Hungary must remove 2. The deadline for these "Winter 1904" moves is SATURDAY 8 JANUARY 1966.

1965A

Since England lost an army and gained a supply center in "1909", England may establish 2 units, instead of 1 as announced in GRAUSTARK #75. England builds fleets in Edinburgh and in London. France removes the fleet in Spain. The deadline for "Spring 1910" moves is SATURDAY 8 JANUARY 1966.

LONDON: The Turkish Fleet in the Clyde is about to pay for their part in the assassination of King Edward VII.

The "Winter 1903" establishments in this team diplomacy game are:

ENGLAND: Builds A Lon.

GERMANY: Removes A Ruk, A Sil.

ITALY: Removes F Alb.

AUSTRIA-HUNGARY: Builds A Vis,

A Tri.

Since no English moves were received before the deadline of "Spring 1902" moves, the dislodged English fleet in Norway may not retreat, but instead must be removed from the board. The deadline for "Fall 1902" moves is accordingly postponed to SATURDAY 8 JANUARY 1966.
