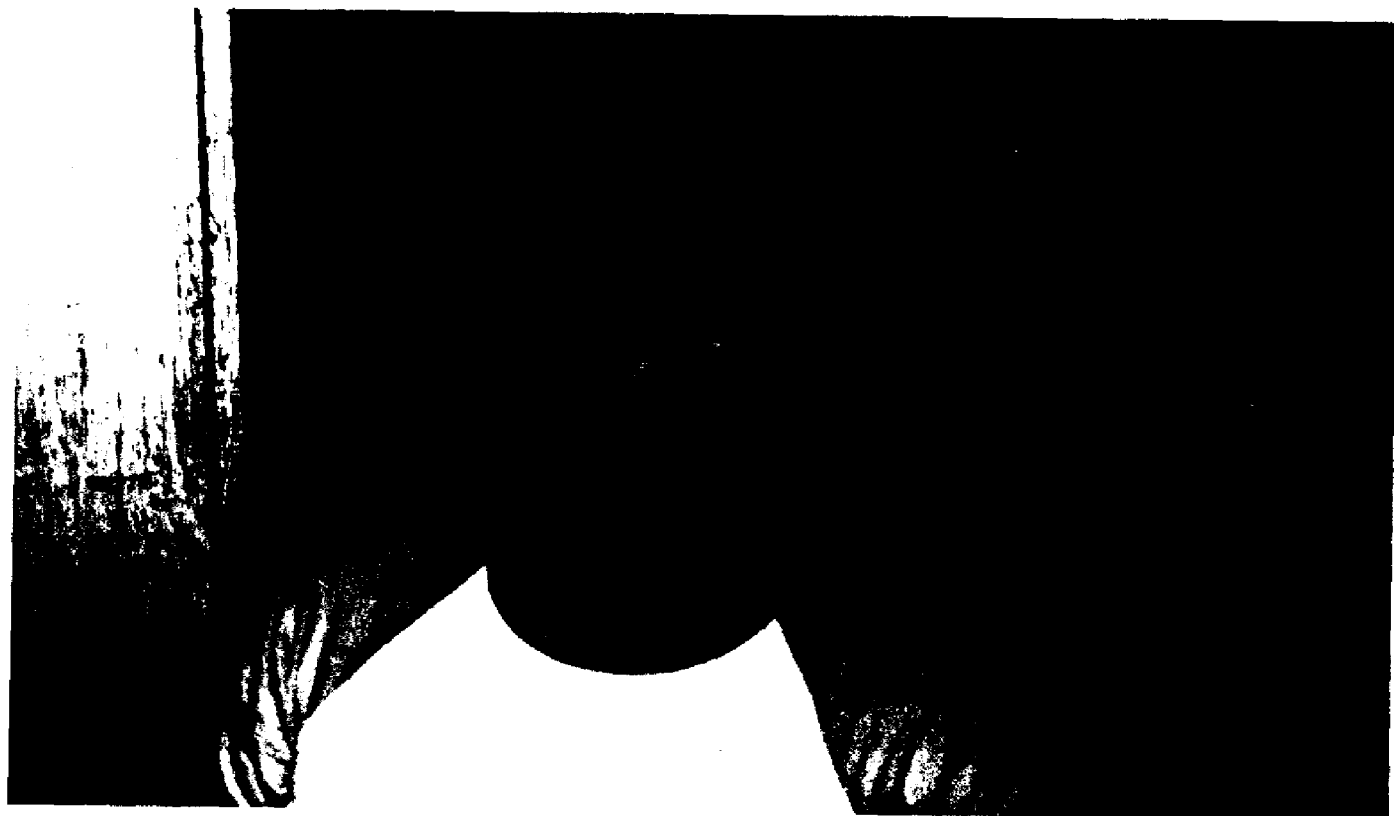

SSS-(SIC): Okay, so we allied to purchase piastres. Did you have to let everyone in on the deal?

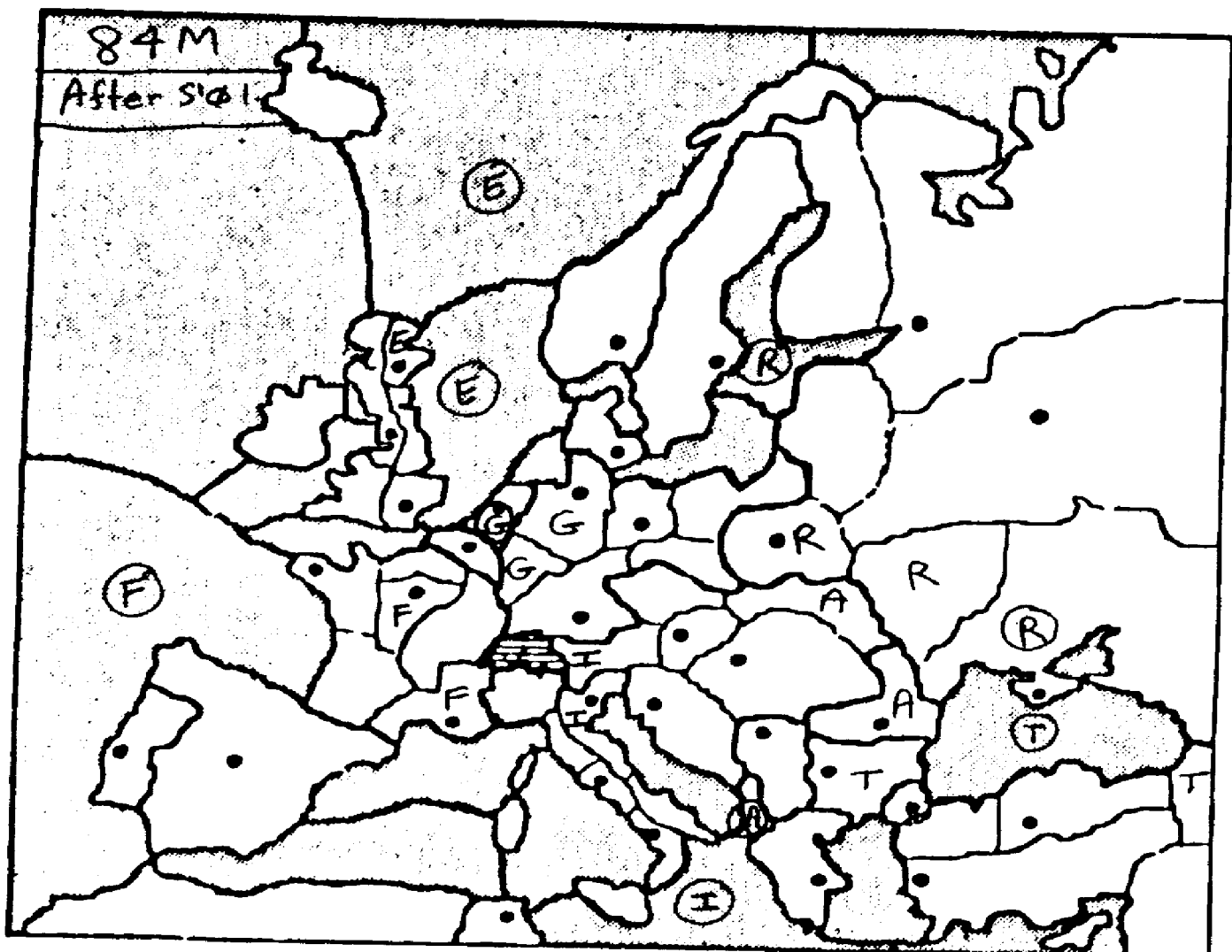
Tinamou-(SIC): Thanks for the "advies" but nothing "pools down" the Tinamou unless it's my weakness for the French. Vive le Piastre!

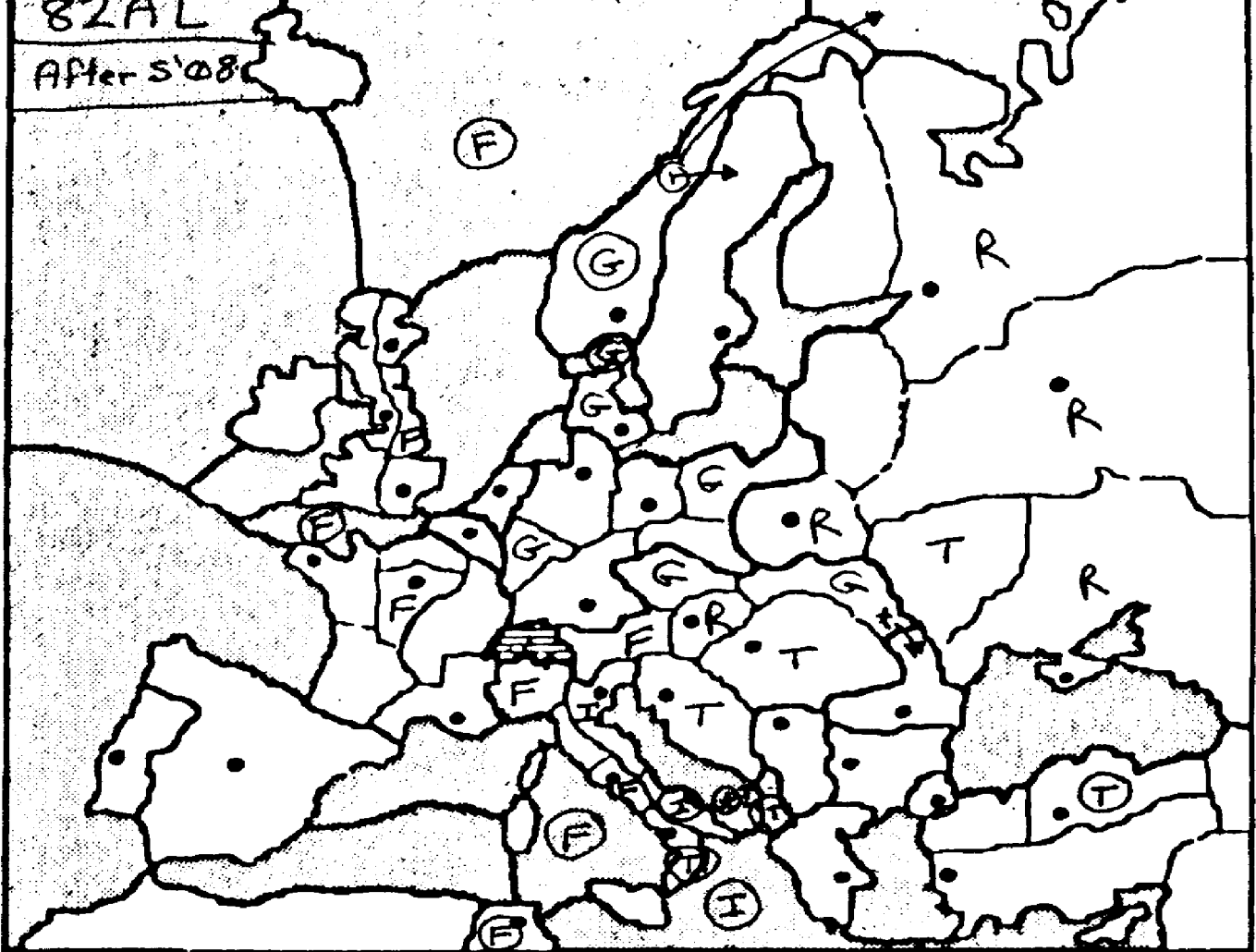
TAPP-PPM: Merger, my ass! We crime fighters are lone warriors. Of course, if our buying power should happen to coincide, all the better!

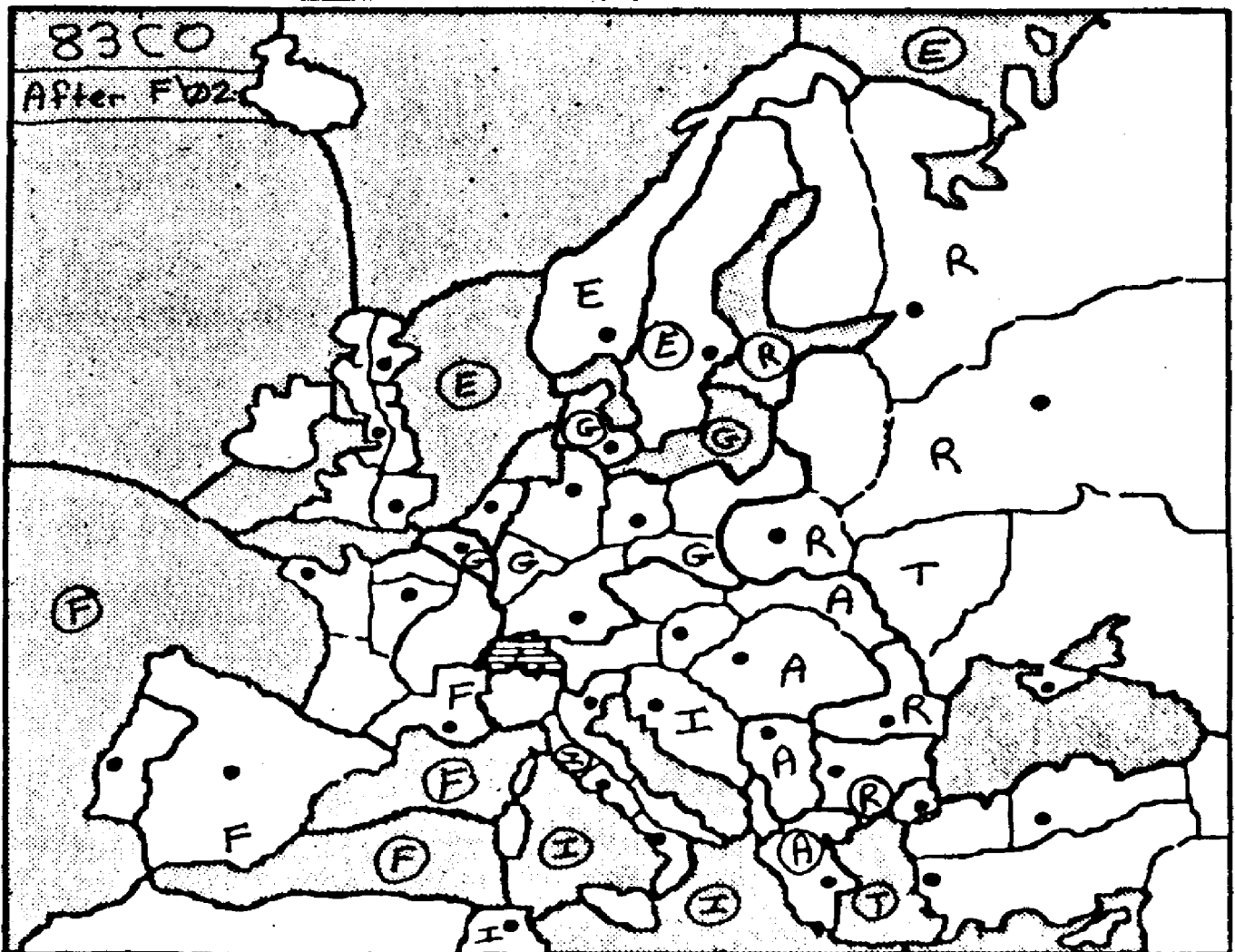

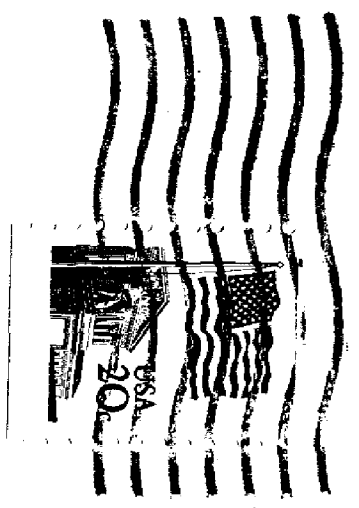

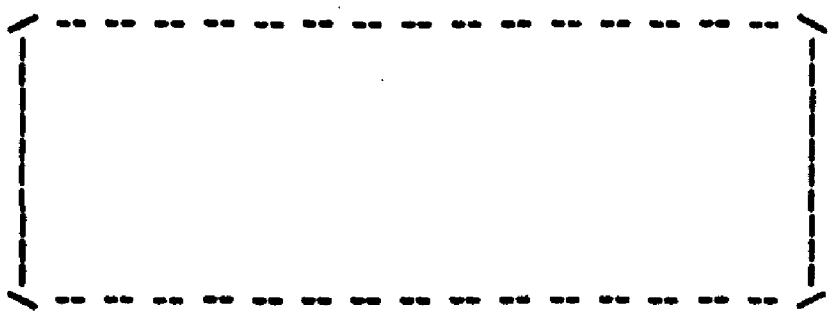
