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SPIRAL MONOPOLY Rules

- 1. Play is the same as in normal Monopoly with the following exceptions. 2. The first space is GO. Movement spirals in from there with the last space being Boardwalk. The next space after Boardwalk is Go again.
- 3. There are two spaces on the board for each railroad. If you land on one, you pay the rent (if any) and then proceed to the other space of that railroad (collecting \$200 if you pass 60).
- 4. A Free Parking Pot is accumulated containing all taxes from the board and cards plus any fines paid to get out of jail and proceeds—from the special space explained in rule #5. The Pot is collected by landing—on Free Parking.
- 5. If you land on the Match the Free Parking Pot space. You must match the amount in the Free Parking Pot. If you do not have enough Cash to do so, you are only required to match it with what you have. You do not need to mortgage property to raise cash to pay on this space.
- need to mortgage property to raise cash to pay on this space. 6. The Property Tax space requires you to pay your choice of \$300 or the following percentages of the value of your properties: 1% of lots, 2% of utilities, 10% of railroads, 10% of houses & hotels.
- 7. There are two Las Vegas squares. On the first one you roll the dice and collect 10 times the amount of your roll. On the second one you roll the dice; if you get a 2 or a 12 you collect \$300 and roll again, you continue to collect \$300 as long as you roll a 2 or 12.
- 8. There are 6 spaces on the board bearing a dice face. If you land on one you immediately roll 1 die and teleport to that space. You can not pass GO on a teleport.
- 9. Other special spaces are Advance To GO and Chance & Community Chest (combined). They should be self explanitory.

The first rule I would change would be the Las Vegas spaces. I would now make them more representative of gambling.

I imagine I should probably mention that Monopoly is copyrighted by Farker Brothers.


