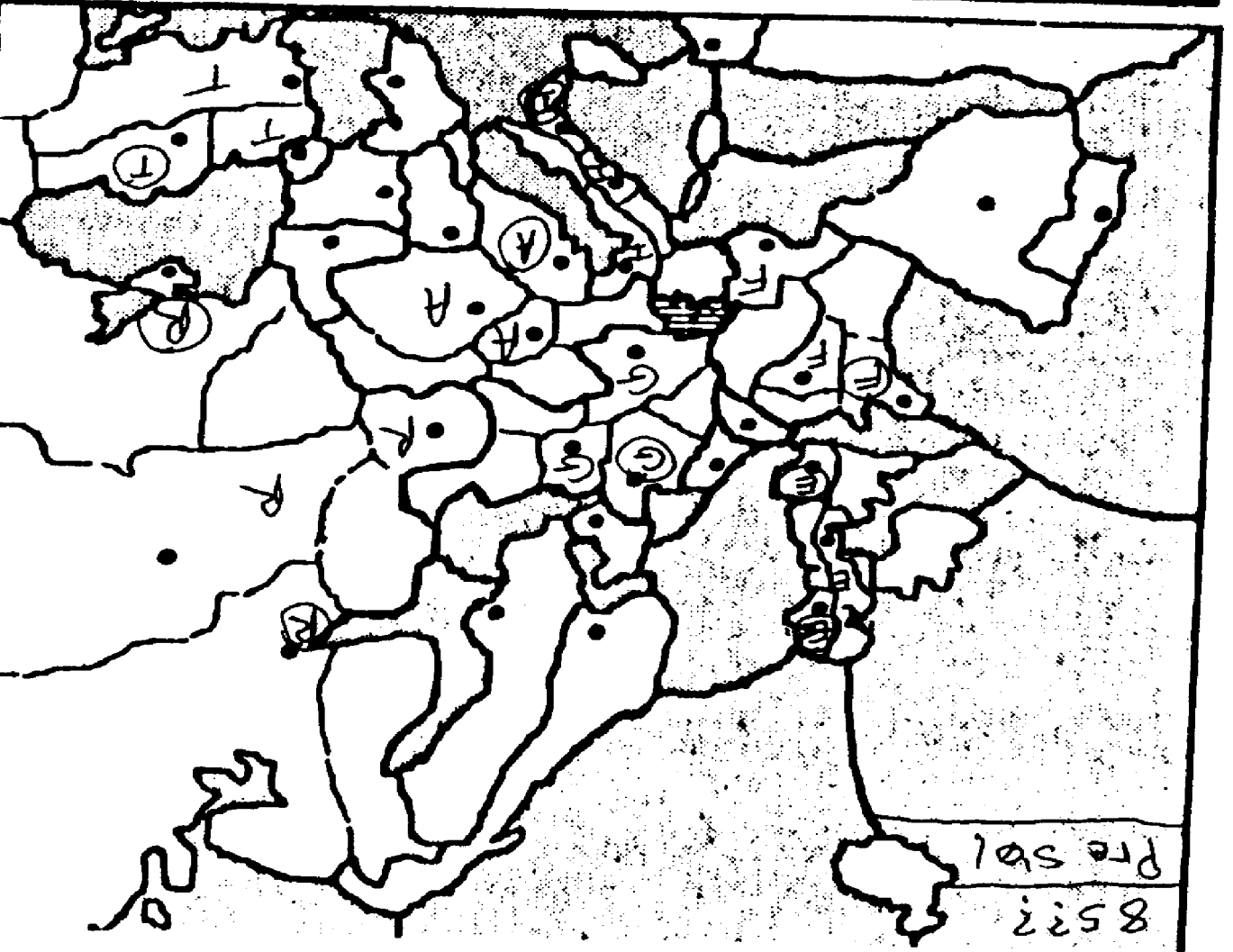
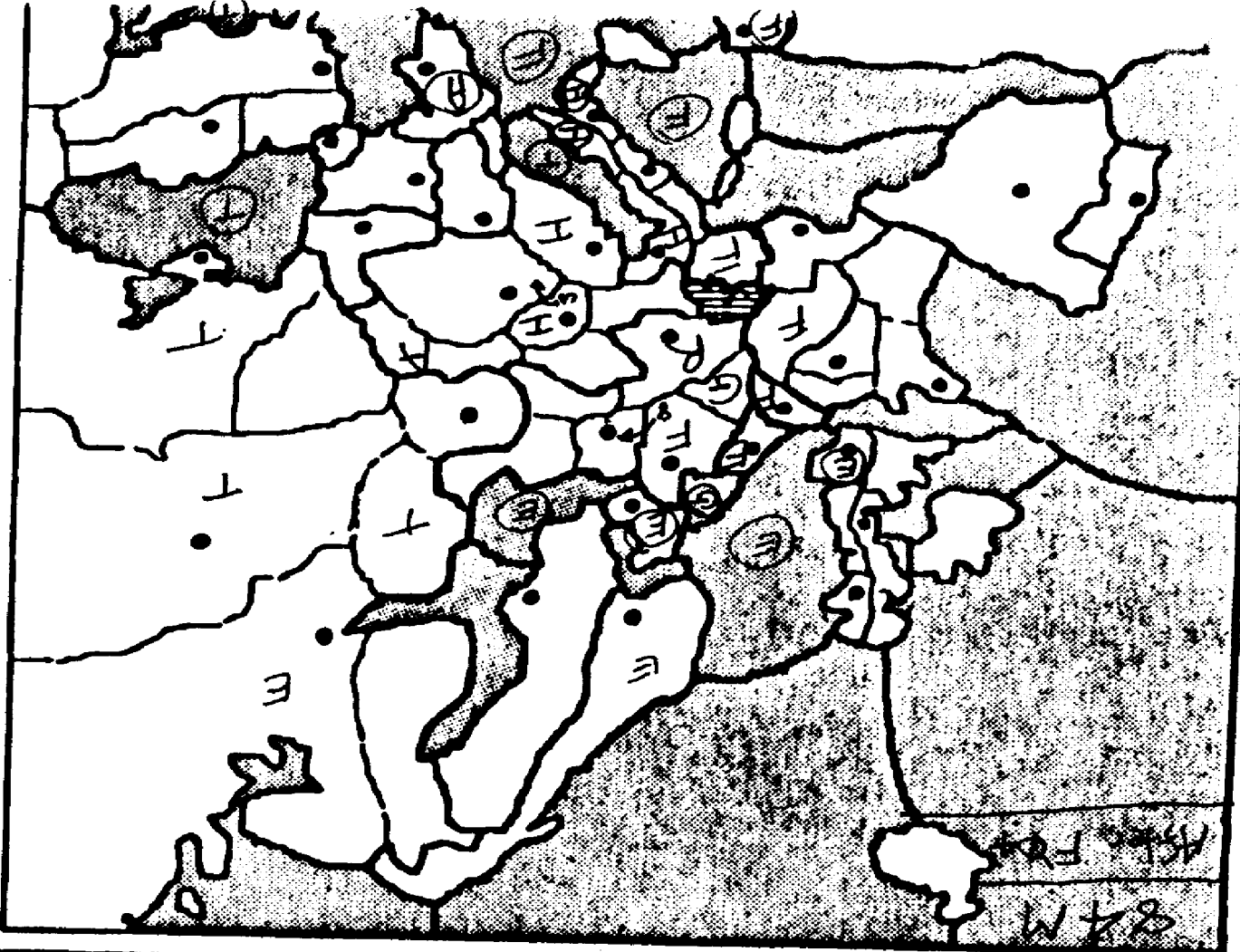

SS&S-TAPP: The Kings in question are Sacramento's new basketball team - they win just like Turkey and France - Go Kings!

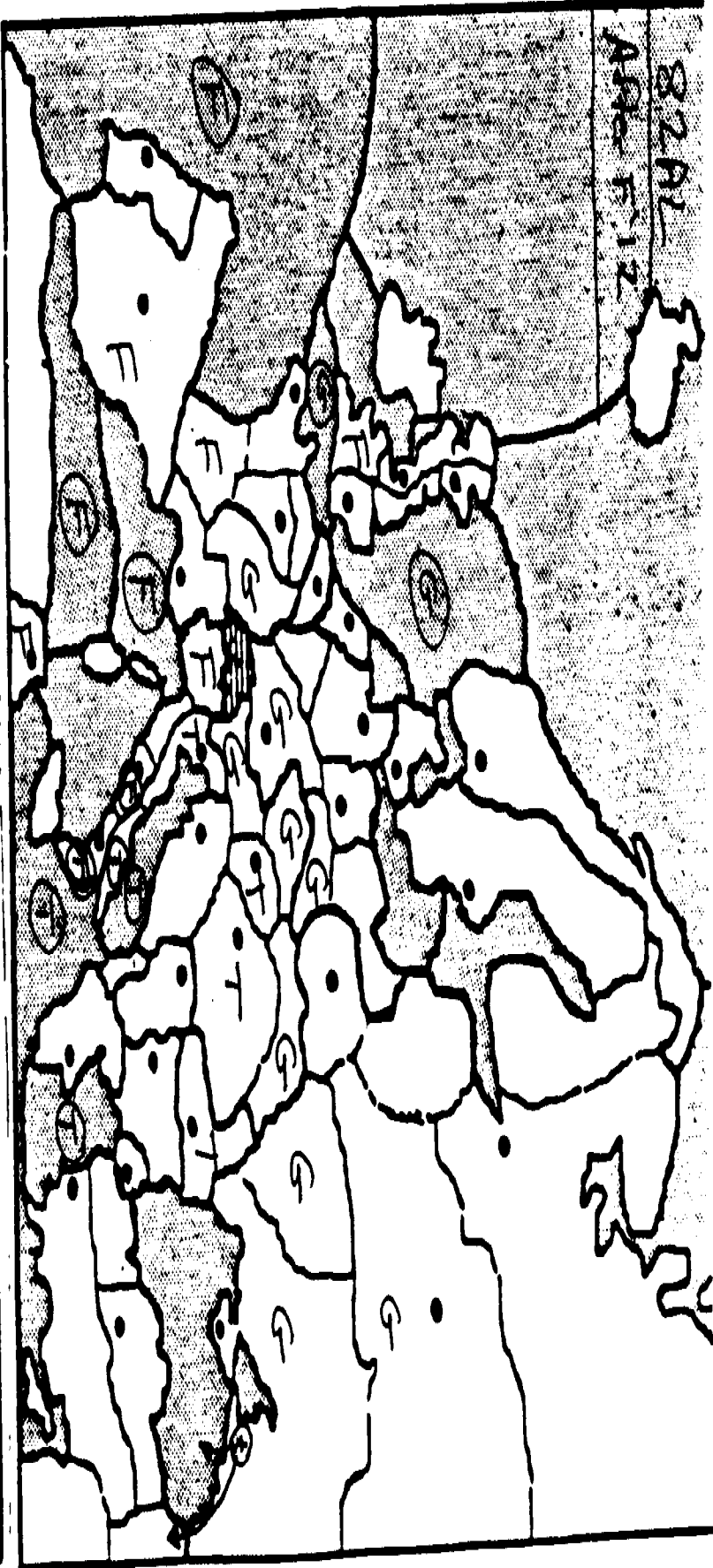
SS&S-Germany: Nothing personal, but you got to sell in order to buy and I've got to buy!

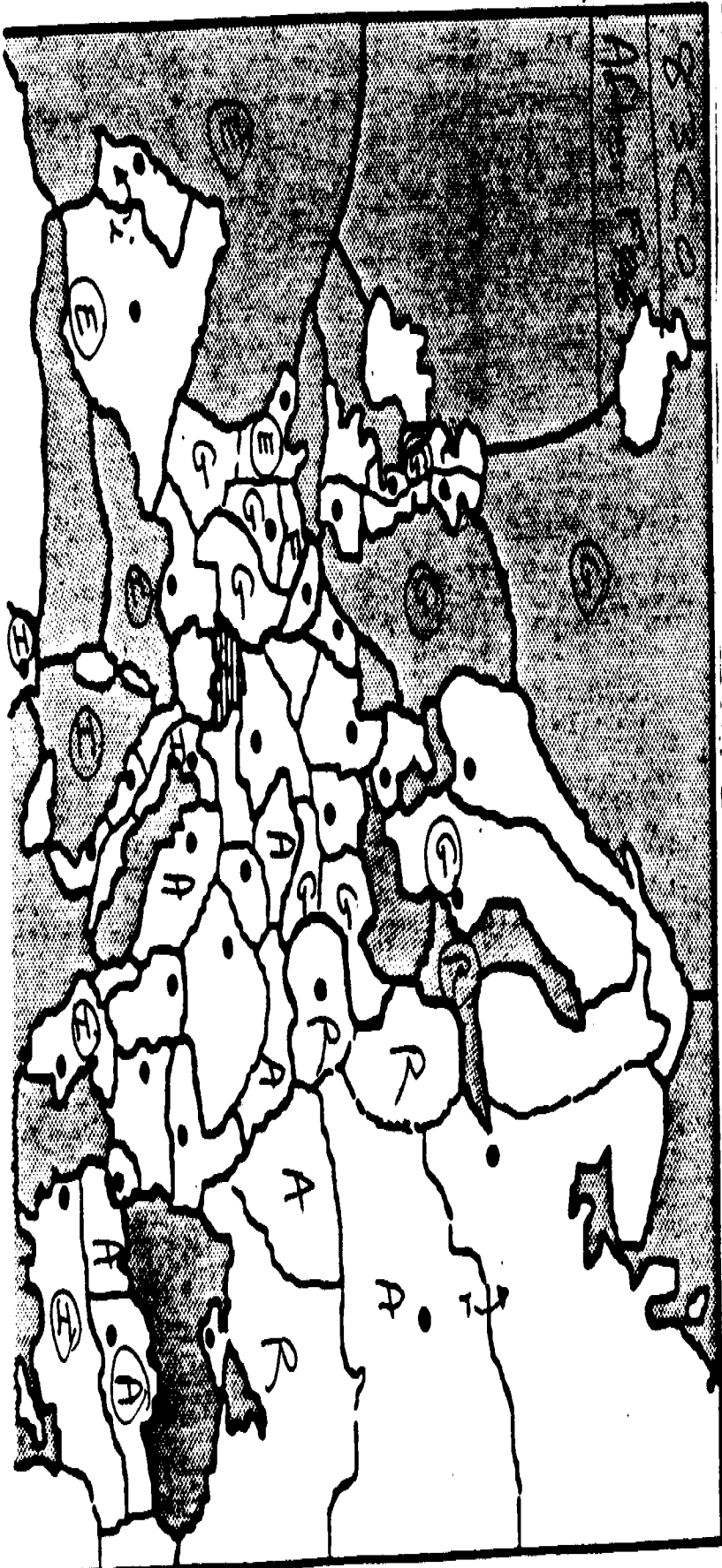

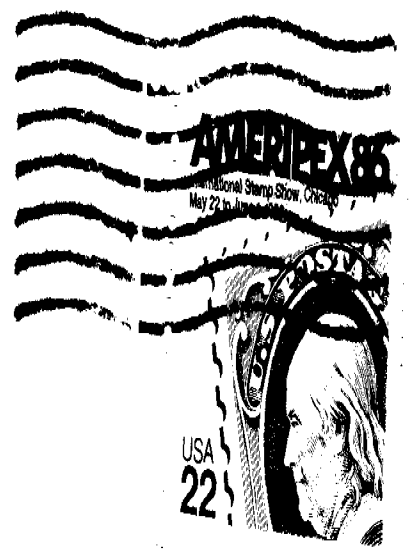
