Important Notice for all players

New houserules are included on page 8. The only real change is that
orders sent via any means that requires me to sign for them are not
allowed unless you have my prior approval. I have just had an awful
experience with express mail. I have found that the combination of
idiotic USPS rules and USPS incompetence make it almost impossible for
me to receive mail sent that way.

Odds and Ends

If I get at least seven people who want to play bourse on my new
game I'll start one up. There is no gamefee for bourse. You need only
maintain a sub and not be an original player in the dip game.

It almost seemed like a conspiracy to make this next deadline when
it is. But there are three good reasons why it's not until the second
week of November. First there was players request the deadline be
extended, then there is the fact that I'll be in and out of town thru
the first week of November so I probably wouldn't be able to do anything
with to results anyways and will be very hard to get by phone as it is,
and finally the fact that the orders that arrived by express mail (by
the deadline) were not received by me until well afterwards.

How to Write a Good Order

- 1.0 The 1776 Rules of Diplomacy will be used unless specifically overridden here or by the rules of the variant being played.
- 2.0 Preference lists will be used if supplied.
- 3.0 Spring 1901 NMRs will delay a variant. Neutral orders will be used in regular dip.
- 4.0 Conditional orders are encouraged.
- 5.0 Two requests are required to separate seasons unless stated otherwise.
- 6.0 Orders should be on separate pieces of paper for each game and should also be separate from all other correspondence.
- 7.0 Orders should include the game's number or name, the country, the season, the date, and the player's signature. Orders with the latest date or the highest priority number will take precedence. Where two or more sets of orders have the highest precedence ambiguities may occur.
- 8.0 Each unit MUST be individually ordered and MUST have the correct ID. A or
- 9.0 I will attempt to interpret badly written orders to an extent. But if you do badly write an order you MUST accept my interpretation of the move. If you want an order to be truly mis-written, tell me.
- 10.0 You are free to use whatever abbreviations you want. But, if you don't use standard ones, you get what I decide, NO arguments. NOR usually is NWY.
- 11.0 The unwanted convoy will be allowed. Even to disrupt a purely land move.
- 12.0 Orders may be mailed or phoned and must arrive on or before the deadline. Deadline dates and times will be stated in each issue. NO calls after 11:30PM. ABSOLUTELY NO collect calls. NMR insurance calls will be made if possible. I make NO guarantees that you will be able to reach me by phone or that I will be able to make NMR insurance calls. In order to receive an NMR insurance collect call you must have let me know you wish to have NMR insurance and supply a phone number to call.
- 12.1 Player codes will be assigned. You should use your player code when phoning in orders. It is not required though unless you request it to be. You may request to have a new code assigned at any time.
- 12.2 Any orders sent in a way that requires me to sign for them will not be allowed unless you have my specific permission to send them that way.
- 13.0 Errors in adjudications must be reported by the next deadline or they will stand.
- 14.0 Standard treatment of NMRs. Standbys will be used if available.
- 15.0 Resignations will be accepted with a final set of orders. The player can recommend a replacement.
- 16.0 A player may win by meeting the victory criterion or by concession.
- 17.0 Draws and concessions may be proposed by and may include any remaining country. I will NOT run DIAS games.
- 18.0 An NVR is a vote against yourself.
- 19.0 Grey press except on black press games. You may dateline press from a where except for anyone else's home centers and the datelines: Vondium, GM, HJ, Hai! Jikai!, Orangevale, Vallia, & Dray (Prescot) which are mine.
- 20.0 If you deceive the GM here, bad things WILL happen to you.
- 21.0 These rules may be changed or ammended at any time.

Well, there they are. I tried to keep them very simple. If you have any questions about them, feel free to ask.

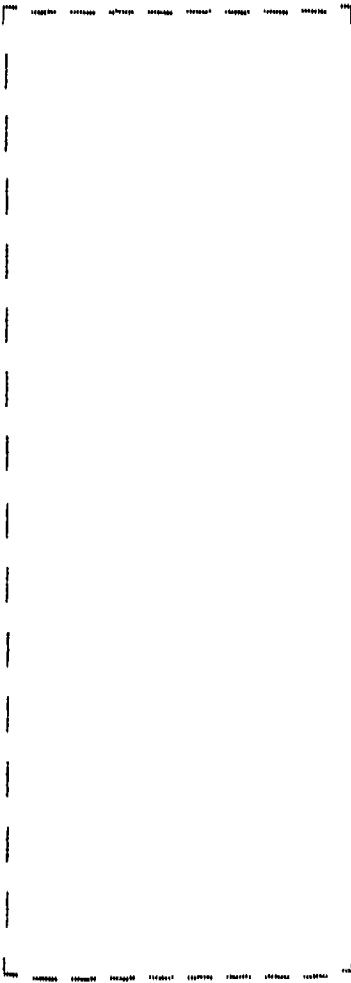
