Italy to Germany: You're right about your assumptions. Good luck in the north. The south is set.

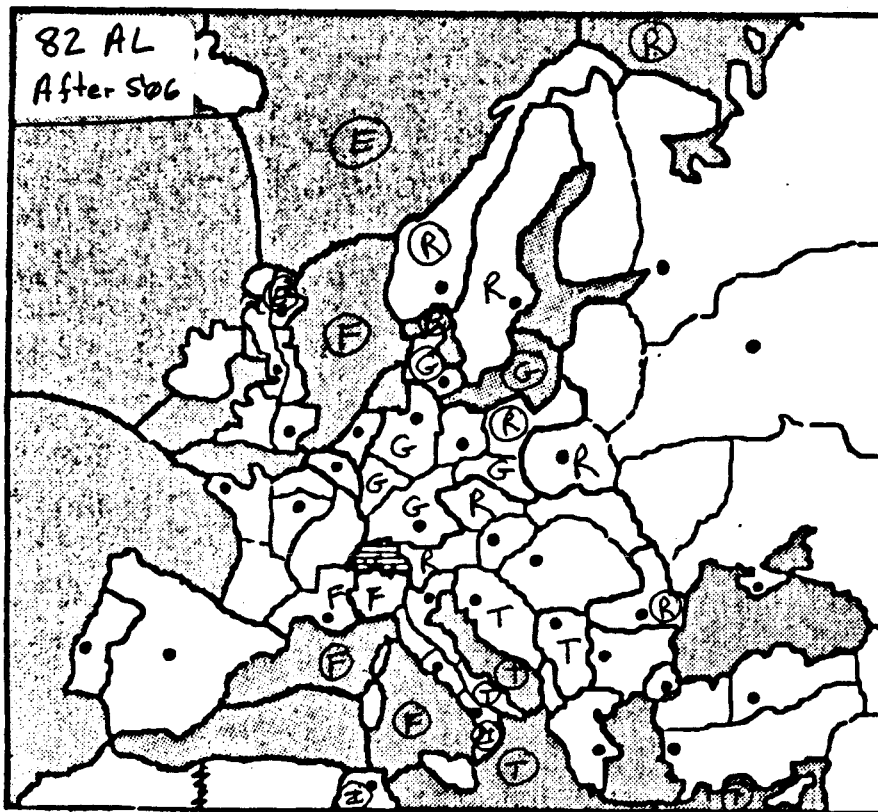
Italy to France: The move to Tyrrhenian was to keep the Turk from slipping in (Also, in case I was set up.) (I never hold.)

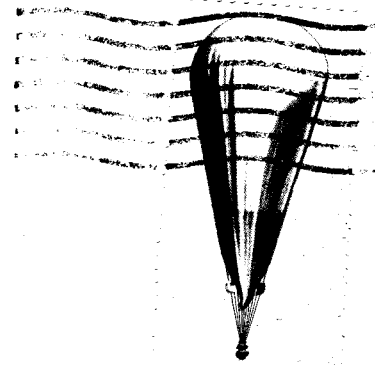
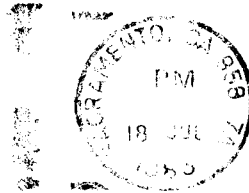
