Autumn & Winter 1905 and Spring 1906 orders are due Feb. 17, 1931. If I receive two requests, I will separate the seasons and only Autumn & Winter 1905 will be due. BUT protect yourself and send in conditional orders for Spring 1906:::

Since France is now a two center power and no one wants to send in orders for that country, I regretfully (but in accordance with Claw & Fang house rules) I officially declare the Republic of France to be in permanent and total Civil Disorder.

Now a word about POSTAL Diplomacy. This game is meant to be played through the mail. I don't care how many times you players call each other and I don't mind taking orders over the phone, but some of you (who shall remain nameless) are using the phone a bit too much. I'm giving you this lecture for your own good - lately I've been spending very little time at home. Therefore I am becoming hard to reach by phone. Protect yourselves and mail some orders in. My mother and father are capable of writing down your orders but you are warned - any such orders will be used at your own risk - you, and only you, will be responsible if there is a mistake in the orders you that are relayed to me through my family. To avoid any hard feelings anywhere, I urge you to mail your orders in:
