Ankara- The Moscow to Ankara het line became mysteriously inoperative sometime before Spring 1901 and has not functioned properly since, Technicians suspect that transmissions prior to the break down were somehow also routed through Italian and Austrian sub-stations. Sources in the Turkish High Command are viewing any incidents involving Turkish and Russian units as solely due to this break down in communication. Russian authorities declined comment.

Sophia - The Bulgarian Ministry of Hill Skiing (Up and Down) has called for a boycott of Greek gifts in view of the seizure last spring of ten Bulgarian downhill skiers by elements of the Third Sunday of March in Komotini Remembrance Coalition during festivities at the Central European Alpine Ski Bonanza in Tyrolia. The crowd dispersed peacefully 5 seconds after confronting the bull who also lived in the pasture.

We seem to be having a few problems here. As they cover both games I'll cover them here in the hopes of adding to the general enlightenment.(1)I do not call for moves. I reserve the right to call once if it is clear that a player does not understand postal diplomacy as distinct from diplomacy. This is a matter of judgement and I am using mine. The only example of this to date was a player who didn't understand conditional orders well enough to know that they must include a general case. By now you've all been warned and are on your own. One player has protested this to me. I reject the protest. If the publisher winses to replace me that is his option. (2) moves are due the 7th of every month. I see no reason to repeat this time after time as it NEVER varies. (3) I've been informed that my formatting is confusing by a player-any other takers? (4) Press is published on a space available pasis. As I do not publish this myself I am bound to get the adjudications out on time and this occassionally entails dumping the press in whole or part. So it goes. (5) Due dates are variable. That is to say that anything reaching me up to the close of my business hours -6PM Eastern Time. Will be accepted. An thing reaching me after that will be accepted if the games have not yet been adjudicated. So if you are late you take your chances. I usually adjudicate with 24hrs. However, one can get lucky as Mr. Forte seems to/(6) telephone orders are at your own risk-I adjudicate what I get in whatever form I get it in-I have a full time staff of four with 4-5 others who are here sometimes but not always. Only one of them is a trained GM and she's here less often than most. Numbers are 516-295-5855: 212-327-5533. You CAN also call me at home. The number is 212-845-1228, I am rarely there but no hour is too late. If you don't get me you will possibly get Ruth. She does understand moves but will usually deny it. She usually takes accurate messages as does the answering machine on 212-327-5533. Note the listing for me in the Nassau County phonebook is actually my parents house- I don't live there and sometimes do not get messages for weeks. Caveat Emptor: (7) results are in the public domain anytime after I adjudicate. Mr. Compton gets his by telex for the duration of the postal difficulties in venezuela. If anyone has any further questions please feel free to enquire but those are the rules as I GM them.
