Information from my Diplomacy archives is vital for all this and is available to the public as well. Although the archives is virtually complete in at least xerox form, missing undamaged originals are solicited, either for purchase or a loan to permit xeroxing. Many original spares are now available from the archives; more are solicited so as to make them available to others. ARCHIVES LISTING NO. 19

In this special issue we present the first archives listing to be published in almost 2 years, the last appearing in Hoosier Archives #53 of 8 January 1972. A lot has happened in that time, but I can now say that for all practical purposes, the archives is complete.

Starting on page 3, you will find a listing of zines that represents the end result of a 3-year project. Practically every Diplomacy zine that has been published in the first decade of postal Diplomacy is listed there by publisher in the order that it is filed in the archives. I decided to separate non-active and active publishers and only give addresses for the latter since, in the former case, many of the last known addresses are now obsolete.

One reason that I've taken so long in up-dating the archives listing (besides the fact that I wanted to wait until I could list a virtually-complete collection) is that for the past 1½ years I've been recataloging the archives in my spare time. During Rod Walker's visit before DIPCON V, he suggested that I catalog the archives by index card with one card for each separate title. This I have done, and quite a task it proved to be since at the same time I de-stapled and numbered the pages of every zine. In this way I could determine what I was missing and what constituted a really complete collection of every Diplomacy zine ever published. I was aided in this by the help of Rod's old "Bibliologia," and in more recent times, working with Conrad von Metzke to keep track of all current publishers. The end result is an organized, complete published record of the first 10 years of our hobby. It is my hope that I can put it to good use.

When I begin DIPLOMACY WORLD next year (and now that the archives is complete and easy to use), I hope to use the archives for many projects and make the results available through DIPLOMACY WORLD. Our hobby has quite an interesting history, and a lot of interesting statistical information can be gleaned from the game records as well, not to mention instructive examples of good play. This was my original purpose in starting the archives anyway, and I am in hopes that some of this can eventually be published in book form. Chess has books of instructive games by the masters, and I think Diplomacy should too. And there are many fine buried articles that warrant reprinting and wider circulation. Any ideas you have in this regard would be appreciated.

Perhaps you would like to know what the archives itself looks like. ((not really--but he's going to tell you anyway. CA)) My den is known around here as the "archives." In actuality the archives itself is six 4-drawer filing cabinets and one 2-drawer fire-proof file safe. In my den I have 3 of the 4-drawer cabinets. Five of the drawers contain zines of active publishers and four of them contain the zines of inactive publishers. The zines are filed alphabetically by publisher. Each separate zine title is filed in its own manila folder and numbered, with the staples removed. This makes them much neater to store. Then the zines of each publisher are separated by a file divider with the

publisher's name on it. In this way, knowing name and publisher, I can easily locate any issue I want. But to continue the tour, another drawer is for correspondence and the last two are for spare zines of current publishers.

Next we go to the "archives annex," as our front porch is called. Along one wall are the other 4 filing cabinets. Three of them contain more spare Diplomacy zines (mostly inactive publishers) and the last is my pride and joy, the 2-drawer fireproof file safe. In it are filed all the rare zines of the pre-1966 period. Many of them are virtually irreplaceable and so the caution. Yes, I know I'm crazy, but I was made an offer by a plumber who was going out of business that I couldn't refuse! Anyway, you might be interested to know that, not counting duplicates, our hobby has produced about 20 linear feet of published material.

The following symbols in the listing warrant explanation:

(1) "*" An "*" following a number shows that it is the last issue in the series, ie, The Dispatch I, 1-2* means that only 2 issues were ever published before the zine went defunct, and that the archives has both of them. If no "*" follows a series, it means that either the zine is still active, or that the archives is missing the later numbers. An "*" following a zine title without a number means that the zine was a one-shot.

- (2) (R) A zine that carries mostly regular games.
- (3) (V) A zine that carries mostly variant games.
- (4) (P) A propaganda zine, or "propzine."

(5) (G) A genzine. This zine publishes general material about Diplomacy, but normally carries no games.

It should be noted that propzines are listed not by their publisher, but by the publisher of the gamezine that carried the game from which the propaganda originated. They normally immediately follow the zine in question. I should probably also say at this point that a publisher's main zine is listed first, and with the exception of the propzines as explained above, the other zines follow in alphabetical order.

There arose a problem about what to do with zines that had more than one publisher, the extreme example being Broddingnag which is presently active under its fifth publisher. I finally decided to list an active zine under its current publisher, but for defunct zines, I listed them under the publisher that had published it the most. Thus, Broddingnag is listed under Bob Ward, its current publisher, but if it were defunct, it would be listed under John McCallum, who published the most issues.

Before turning the page, you will note the list of the few zines still not contained in the archives in at least xerox form. These are greatly solicited in either original or xerox form, although of course an original is preferred. A few more missing zines aren't listed below since they have been promised, or owed in trade, by the publisher in question. Maybe I should also say that duplicate zines are always solicited so that they can be made available to others. Although I can of course xerox originals, I have trouble getting to a machine these days.

I would like to urge all publishers to check their listing and see if I am missing any of their zines. If so, I'd naturally like to obtain copies. And if you look closely you will also note that among the active publishers, the numbers 61-69 are missing. There are in reality only 86 active publishers. The associate editor has been roundly chastized for this error and has been put on bread and water for 3 days. ((If I have to go on bread and water for 3 days, then the esteemed editor also has to subsist on a meager diet of bread and water, since if I don't get to eat, I don't cook, and if I don't cook, then Walter doesn't eat since he (even though he was an Eagle Scout--the Boy Scouts should be ashamed of him) claims to not know how to cook. So there! (o)))
