It is strongly recommended that the publisher in question be contacted first since if he has the back issues available that you want, he can provide you with an original that is clearer and cheaper than a copy from Hoosier Archives which is mainly a service to provide copies of unavailable back issues.

For an excellent list of current Diplomacy publications with names and addresses of the editor in question, write John McCallum, P.O. Box 52, Ralston, Alberta, Canada and ask him for a copy of SerenDip #58. He should be able to provide you with a copy for about 15¢.

The most complete review of the entire literature of postal Diplomacy ever written and current to May 1969 was published by Rod Walker, 5058 Hawley Blvd, San Diego, CA 92116. This "Bibliologia" was published in Erehwon, III, 9-10 and the price of these two 'zines is 80¢ by first class mail through their editor.
