Propaganda --

Paris -- Regardless of Italy's intentions, the Tsar is advised to attack him immediately. France pledges full aid to Russia in taking 6 Italian centers. Russia and Italy are the strongest powers in Europe, and Russia's south is exposed. As we proved in the last season, we have no desire to attack Russia's German territory.

Rome -- I will return Rumania if you still need it; however, as we are now at parity, it would perhaps be better if we hang on at an even number of centres and work for a draw. The unexpected Turkish capture of the Ionian Sea is a severe blow to our eastern front, and may take much work to repair. It appears that it will be you who becomes Sultan of the Ottomans, not I, and so perhaps you might let me be King of Rumania? ##### More consultation on this matter is needed. Edidio will be in Wroclaw on 12 May to discuss the question. Yours in cordiality, Victor, Rex, Imperator.
