Dhidhimotikhon, Electorate of Bulgaria and Upper Sweetwater Canyon (11 Nov 1905) -- In the capital city of this newly-formed nation, the first successful nation in five years on the European continent, the celebrations of joy are continuing far into the night as the population heralds the now-stable government which has risen out of five years of continental anarchy and civil war. The blessings of the Bishop of Dhidhimotikhon were punctuated last evening by a series of proclamations of the Elector, Ferdinand Alexander Drakuleivich I, outlining policy for the new nation. Conquest of Vienna, with the summary execution of the Viennese Usurper on the steps of St. Aegedius Cathedral in Graz, figured prominently in all the documents.

Vienna -- Trieste: Illiterate! And you must be one because you failed to write me of this alliance. Perhaps it doesn't exist or you can't write. So I'll spell it out, so even you can understand it. If you don't write and confirm that alliance you are so hot to get (the Alliance, not me!), you will cease to exist as a nation. This will be because I'll make it my chief and only occupation to do you every disservice in this game that I can, such as taking all your centers I can get my hands on, tying up all your armies and fleets I can, so your fun-loving neighbors can do you in at their pleasure. And watch your language. I got this position due to your partner leaving. What happened? Didn't you use Scope?
