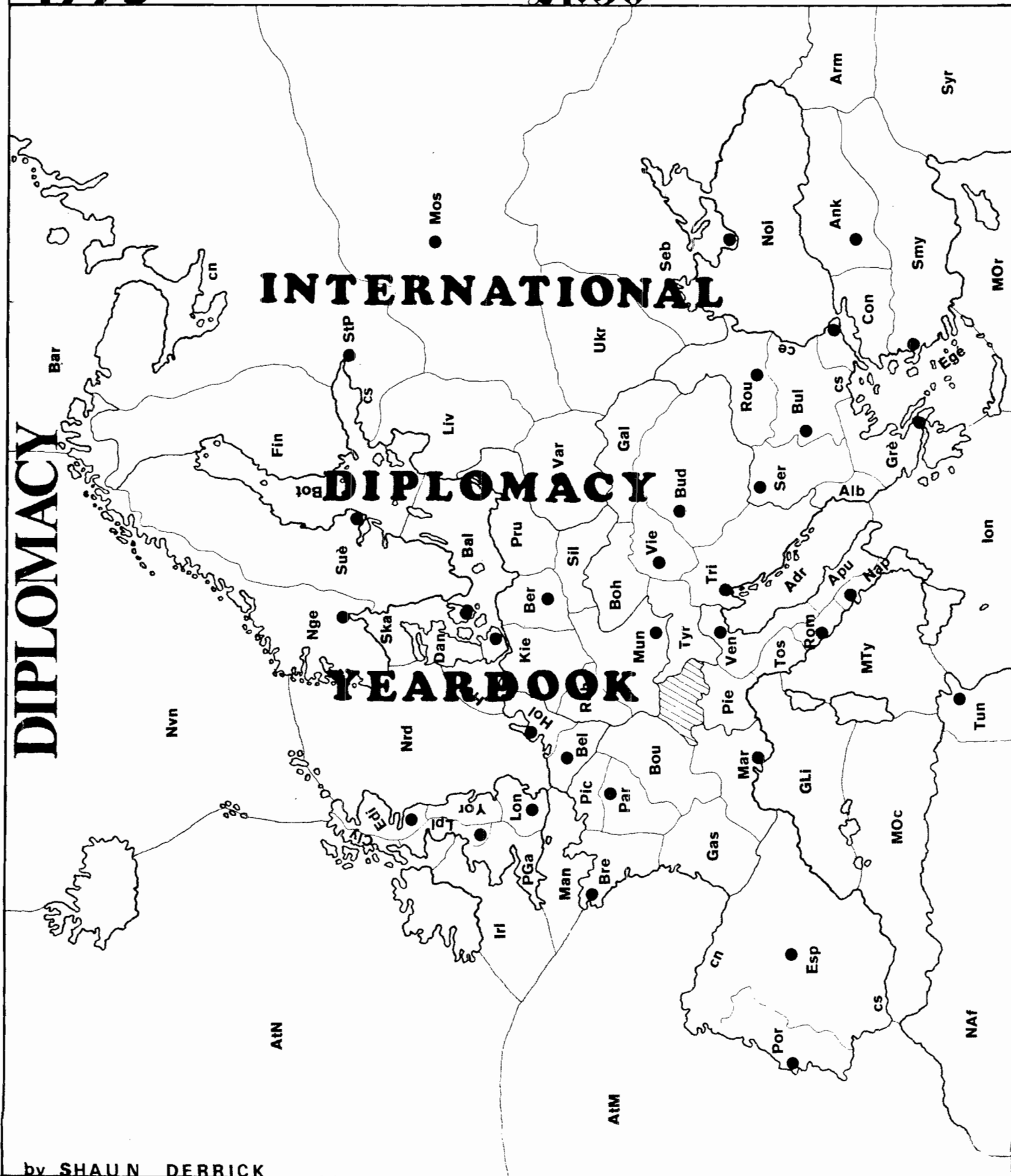

## Editorial

The 1993 International Diplomacy Yearbook in an attempt to compile statistics from Diplomacy Tournaments throughout the world. It does not contain statistics from postal or E-Mail games; it is for the face-to-face purist as well as players or non-players with a passive interest. You will find it an invaluable source of records and results in which you may be a contributor. You may be surprised to see your name amongst the Individual Achievement awards list, as some tournaments do not physically award you with a top 7 placing or give any prizes for "best country". This Yearbook puts this right, so your name will go down in the annals of Diplomacy history!

With so many tournaments taking place throughout the world (34 in 1991) it is hard to keep up with the number of results that need to be collected. Alas, due to the present reluctance of some tournament directors to maintain records, it is proving impossible to obtain every result. I would like to think that this Yearbook will encourage those who run tournaments in the future to keep records and send me, or whoever my successors may be, the full results in order to build a useful archive.

It has long been established that each Diplomacy tournament is held at a convention, and as such any national or international titles have been overshadowed by the convention e.g. The British Individual Championship is held at ManorCon, thus players regard the winner as the ManorCon champion, not the British Individual Champion. On the continent each Diplomacy-playing country has an organization which endorses its National Championship and any other tournaments run in that country. I would be keen for the English-speaking countries to follow the example of France in particular, as they have certainly encompassed the idea of highlighting the actual championship as opposed to the convention at which they are held. Certainly in Australia this seems to happen where the Victorian or New South Wales Championships are promoted as just that! The underlying reason is that such titles attract outside interest far more than "...Con" championship. A classic example was WorldDipCon III, where the local TV station were present along with the local press because it was the "World Championships", the normal title of CanCon being relegated to small print for the convention.

Another factor which ties in with what I have said above is the titles on the trophies. It was such a shame that the 1990 WDC in the USA was overshadowed by "DipCon", and as such all the trophies were for DipCon XXIII and not <sup>World</sup> DipCon II! Why not put all the various titles onto the trophies but highlight WDC. There should be a simple hierarchy of titles as with any competitive pastime with the World Championship taking precedence over all other titles, followed by the European Championship, then National titles, and finally any other tournaments. Numbers of delegates at each of these conventions should have some bearing on the importance of a title, but not be the overriding factor.

I have listed each tournament by its championship rather than hosting convention name, but to avoid confusion, I have, I hope, made it clear at which conventions they are held. There are some tournaments that have no specific championship role, thus have been listed under their convention name.

Whatever you think, get a board out, get six "rats" together and ...enjoy!!!

#### **1983: Guy Thomas as Italy (18 centres) Individual Championship (Mancon)**

Guy had university pals Richard Young(G) and Chris Gray(T) helping him to victory against, what I would consider, good opposition in Martin Clifford-King, Steve Jones and Tony Ross.

#### **Bart Huby as Russia (22 centres) National Championship (MidCon)**

Another freakish number of centres, and yet another university entente. Cambridge supporters David Long(T) and Howard Sayles(G) assisting in all departments.

#### **1984: Edward Richards as France (18 centres) Individual Champ (ManorCon)**

Eddie burst onto the scene and disappeared just as quickly, making this his only noteworthy success. It seems a genuine win. Mike Parker(G) was his closest rival and Rob Chapman(T) - an excellent postal player - would not have let him win...would they? Or did they 'flop' on the day. A mystery to be solved!?

#### **1985: Shaun Derrick as England (18 centres) National Championship (Midcon)**

I was stuck on 17 centres, a stalemate line had formed, but Judy Lock(I) had 1 centre left - Berlin! It was the only one I had the chance of taking if I could persuade Richard Downes(T) to stab John Gatheral(A) - he did, perhaps because the scoring system did not penalise for an opponent winning in the same game. You could say that the scoring system 'allowed' me to win.

#### **Martin Clifford-King as Germany (19 centres) Nat Champ (MidCon)**

Just to reconfirm what I said about the scoring system. Pete Mason(I) came 4th in the championship overall, so there was little incentive to stop a player winning if you were going to get a good score anyway. Perhaps the most genuine win to date.

#### **1986: Geoff Kemp as Turkey (18 centres) Individual Championship (Manor.)**

I know virtually nothing about this game, but here's a clue: David Long was playing Russia - nuff said!!!

#### **1987: No outright winners this year.**

#### **1988: Phil Day as Russia (20 centres) World Championship (ManorCon)**

Phil won the World title with this win against mediocre opposition. Looks like a genuine win - deserving of the championship. I can only say that Mike Thomas(G) must be happy losing, deluded by the false grandeur of 2nd place perhaps!

#### **1989, 1990 & 1991: No outright wins at all.**

#### **1992: Shaun Derrick as Germany (20 centres) Individual Champ (ManorCon)**

My most satisfying game to date - a real game of Diplomacy without a time limit. I had a solid game-long alliance with Ken Dennis(F), we eliminated all the opposition, helped by Tim Troman(T) who attacked Austria to break the potential stalemate line. He was looking for the 3-way draw, which, in 95% of games he would have got. But we persevered until he was out. Last minute stab secured my victory - Ken is too 'nice' to win, though after this experience he may well have joined 'assassins anonymous'!

#### **Toby Harris as Italy (18 centres) Individual Champ (ManorCon)**

Up against Vic Hall(F), a previous round winner, the win looks pretty genuine. Toby wins his first tournament game but didn't even make the top 3, even though he has won the tournament the last two years.

#### **Phil Day as Russia (18 centres) Individual Championship (Manor.)**

At the time of writing I don't know who his opponents were - a good player like Phil will surely have secured victory in a genuine fashion.

#### **Vic Hall as Russia (18 centres) Individual Championship (Man..)**

## Explanation of format for Individual Player Achievements

The Individual Player Achievement(I.P.A.) is fairly self-explanatory but I will herewith provide a brief for those unfamiliar with tournaments:

Each player has been listed in order of surname followed by first name. Some names have been underlined, those that have their whole name underlined have won national titles, those with just their surname underlined have won tournaments other than national titles. Three individuals are in upper case and underlined, these are the three world champions to date; Phil Day, Jason Bergmann and Steve Gould. The asterisk after a players name denotes that he was part of a winning team in a team tournament.

Next comes the players' country of origin or residence, as far as my knowledge allows - there may be some discrepancies here, so please let me know if there is.

Next we have the four-letter abbreviation for each tournament in which that player won an award, the abbreviations all start with the two-letter abbreviation for the country in which the tournament took place. The list of abbreviations is on page 24.

Next we have the awards starting with the year in which the award was won, followed by the placing and in parentheses, the best country award, if any. Some awards are purely for best country. All tournament winners have their awards underlined.

The World Championship and World Team Championship are highlighted due to their importance!!

Team abbreviations are as follows: LPL = Liverpool; BU = Birmingham University; MP = Mad Policy; WP = War & Peace; OJ = Ode "J"; ODE = Ode; Ben = Benzene; SC = Southern Comfort.

There are 531 names listed from <sup>14</sup>~~13~~ different countries; the breakdown is as follows:

USA 157; UK 127; Australia 71; France 59; Sweden 45; Austria 23;

Norway 16; Canada 13; Switzerland 13; Belgium 2; Portugal 2;

Germany 1; Greece 1; Rumania 1.

The most tournament wins that I have recorded are 3 by three players; Jim Mills(UK), Jim Yerkey(USA) and Steve Gould(Aus). The following players have won 2 tournaments: Phil Day; Moï Fink; Toby Harris; Frank Jones; Kaweh Kristoff; Brian Larson; Marc Peters; Jean- Gerard Pont; Denis Serrano; George Smirnow; Mark Stegeman. I feel sure that there are more to add to this list, so if you know better, let me know!

Only the UK has an ongoing team tournament, though Sweden started one this year. Liverpool have won 5 out of the 11, Birmingham University have won 2, and 1 each for Mad Policy, War & Peace(also World Team Championship); Ode "J" and Ode. Ever present players in the victorious Liverpool team are 2 in number: Paul Oakes and Alan Sharples.

Somewhere in this Yearbook should be a very rough guide to tournaments being held during 1993...I don't know where, just keep looking!! X ,

## THE "TOOLS OF THE GAME"

H.P. Gibson & Son have held the UK licence to produce Diplomacy for about 10 years, before that Philmar held the licence; but, to this day there have been very few changes to the components of the game. The board has remained unchanged in its gaudy colours, thoroughly inappropriate for a game based on events at the turn of the century. The pieces have hardly changed, the most significant difference being the 'upgrading' of the fleets from little plastic oblongs with a pointed end to the cruiser-style moulding. Furthermore the Austrian pieces have changed from red to brown in order to fall in line with its mapboard colour. So, do we need a change? I certainly think so, and so does Roger Heyworth a director at Gibsons Games!

In my correspondence with Roger, I have suggested toning down the colours to fit in with the period, ie drab hues, and perhaps, to eliminate those drawings of Hugh Bredin which add nothing to the board in my view; being more the subject of humorous 'press' in postal games. As for the pieces, I can live with them, but again tone down the intensity of colour.

Roger intimated that a new design could be on its way in the near future, if this is so I would like to see the Spain/North Africa and London/Liverpool ambiguities made clearer. There are no such problems with the Avalon Hill set nor indeed Parker Bros continental version...talking of which...

The continental version of Diplomacy is, in my opinion, the best of all designs, my only reservation being the size of the pieces which I will come to later. The board is a geographical map of Europe with softer contour shading than on the Avalon Hill version, each countries' colour is outlined around the borders standing off from the coastal provinces to clearly indicate the coastal areas as opposed to the sea areas. All the ambiguities of the other two sets are non-existent, even the neutrals have a thin black line around them just offshore to indicate the existence of coastal areas. The colouring for each country is as follows: Austria(Red); England(Pink); France(Blue); Germany(Black); Italy(Green); Russia(Yellow) and Turkey(Grey). The colours of each piece are distinctly different from the others, only in artificial light can the red of Austria and the pink of England be confused, and what little gems these pieces are! Armies are small square blocks

less than a quarter of the size of the old Avalon Hill wooden pieces, a little too small in my opinion; the fleets are little "olives" - three-sided beads with flattened end very reminiscent of necklace beads without the holes!! Furthermore you are also supplied with a set of supply centre discs of the appropriate colour so that each autumn turn you literally mark each supply centre with the appropriate coloured disc dependent on ownership. All home centres are already marked in the colour of the home countries units, but it does prevent the odd dispute that may arise, or even the odd mistake to be made over supply centre ownership.

Onto the American version. Originally this was a three-piece

board which skewed apart during play and came with large wooden blocks for the armies and strips of wood for the fleets, more in keeping with a toy rather than an adult game - yes I did find the original American set the worst! The board was, and still is, a geographical map with heavily shaded contours but without any colour distinction between the powers. My main objection to this version was that the pieces were just too big and irregular. My set contains fleets of anything from 1½cm to 3cm, and the longest fleets are the Austrians! Furthermore the colours for the western powers of Dark blue for England and Light Blue for France, Green for Italy and Black for Germany were all so similar that in artificial light it was very difficult to tell them apart. I have always maintained that the blue for England had more to do with political prejudices than practical application.

The later American set uses an all in one folding board and plastic pieces, stars for the armies and anchors for the fleets - at least they have an easily-handled dimension to them, being about 1cm high. I may be in the minority but these are far better than the wooden goliaths of yesteryear!

Whatever version you prefer it is surprising how each can provide a different angle on the same position; the old wooden blocks make the board look cluttered and cumbersome, a proverbial 'sluggerthon', while the continental 'miniatures' hardly look any more menacing than the 'iron' in Monopoly! One particular feature of the British fleets are that they have a bows and stern making positioning either aggressive or passive - try

placing those Italian fleets in WMS, GOL and TYS pointing westwards, they certainly make the French player nervous; now turn them the other way and they don't look half as aggressive after all. A purely arbitrary piece of nonsense, I know; but I have known this kind of positioning make a minor psychological difference.

Some sceptics out there believe that the sales of Diplomacy sets is dwindling as the computer revolution takes hold, and even those who do like Diplomacy will play by E-mail in the future. Well, the general trend from Gibsons in the UK was that sales rose from 1982-85, gradually fell from 1986-90, only to pick up quite dramatically in 1991. 1992 seems to be on a par with 1991. Predicting sales in the future will be difficult, especially with computer dominance of the market, the younger generation from 14 to 25 have been difficult to recruit, but once the game and hobby publicise itself more we could attract far more players from the younger age group by the end of the century.
