#### How to Play Switzerland by Kevin Tighe

And if Austria moves Vienna to Tyrolia, can you trust him not to move into your country in the fall? Such questions send many a player helplessly groping for the Tylenol.

I find the best way to play the opening moves is to put a Paul Horn record on the storeog git on the bed with a couple of bottles of dark beer, or any locally made brens and assume the lotus gosition (optional). When half a bottle has been consumed slowly repeat to yourself the word "Calhamer". Boon you will see yourself transported up to the top of the Swiss Alps. As the clouds part you will be able to clearly see the deployment of the Berman, French, Italian, and Austrian fleets and troops. In my meditations I see them moving in slow motion. This may not occur to you, but that's CK. Whatever you experience will be correct for you; accept it. By the time the second bottle is empty you should have a clear knowledge of who your allies are.

For those of you fanatics about winning, just readabar that Switzerland can never be overtaken and will always share in it's neighbor's victories. Switzerland - eafe, meall, and clean, I raise my bottle of Anchor Steam to that beautiful, peaceful goddess; land of the ties.
