TENNESSEE TANKS

Several individuals have expressed an interest in the whys and wherefores of the games that Edi Birsan, Bob Keathley, myself and others have been ranting and raving about for the past several months. Bob Keathley being a rather shy, withdrawing fellow, the burden of explanation falls to your humble narrator.

First off, the tank models themselves. These are HO scaled models produced by ROCO of Austria and distributed in this country by AHM or somebody similar. All models used are by them. There is another company called ROSKOPF which theoretically distributes a similar line of HO scaled tanks, but the differences in the appearance and proportions led all to assume that the scales are much too diverse to be interchangeable. Thus only ROCO models are use (or some scratchbuilt models off the ROCO chassis).

Secondly, the tanks are then weighted, preferably before glueing them together. After much discussion and experimentation, a scale of 10 grams=1 TON being the arbitrarily assigned figure. Material used in weighting varies from a combination of dentist's casting plastic and lead to modelling clay. An accurate scale is a necessity. Remember include the weight of the model when computing the amounts.

THIRDLY, a piece of lead or other malleable metal is encased into a glob of the caulking stuff used around bathroom tubs. The reason for the special caulk is to prevent it from totally becoming hard, yet not putty-like in feel. Place a small amount of the caulk on a piece of glass and then press the metal glob into it. The finished product should look like this:

FOURTHLY, and perhaps most important, for this is where the game begins to differ greatly from other board games. You must procure, beg, borrow, steal a couple of BRITAINS 17 lb guns. These are metal models, available from Polks Hobbies in New York and many other sources for about a \$1.00 or so. If you've seen any of these models you know that they are not HO scaled, but something much larger. I think these are the 17lb models at least. They have long barrels, adjustable elevations, and a primitive firing mechanism (PUEL IT BACK, TWIST, AND THE MECHANISM IS LODDED). These are capable of firing a long dowel fitted with a weight on the end. (VERY SIMILAR TO A Q-TIP). The weight assigned to a shell depends on the caliber of the tank gun it will be used for. Briefly, 37mm to 75mm guns are given shells with weights of 20 grains, 75mm to 90mm 25 grains; I have misplaced all pertinent data on this, but you get the idea. Colors are assigned to the various weight/caliber designations and the weight on the end of the dowel and the tip of a corresponding tank are painted the same color.

HARD SUBSTANCE

Thus we now have a weighted model of a tank, a beanie-like thing to be placed on top of the tank, a gun capable of firing a caliberated shell for the tank. Scale movement speed are figured using about 1/5 of the actual road speed and a board similar to a Napoleonic game grid with 2"x2" squares provided for. Put the beania on the tank, insult ur opponent, and figure out how to fire accurately and quickly before he blows your anie off your tank. If you pmsue this this far, the subtitles will come to you. An accurate description of tank statistics is a prerequisite. We have spent a great deal of time argueing rates of fire, but have arbitrarily assigned one move=one fire turn=one complete turn. Questions may be directed at me or at Bob Keathley. Have fun.
