* I HAVE CONDITIONALLY PLACEDTHE BONDON BUILD IN MINAS TIRITH. IF BONDON WISHES TO BUILD IN DOL AMROTH INSTEAD, PLEASE NOTIFY ME WITHIN TEN DAYS AND W WILL INFORM ALL PLAYERS CONCERNED. THE ONLY OTHER DIRECT ORDER OF BUSINESS WILL BE HRIVE RING MOVEMENTS. THE DWARVE PLAYER WILL BE REQUIRED TO SUBMIT SAID MOVES (IF ANY) IN WRITING. SAID MOVES WILL NOT BE ANNOUNCED, EITHER AFFREMATIVELY OR NEGATIVELY. RING MOVEMENT MUST OCCUR BEFORE THE TUILE DEADLINE ACCORDING TO THE RULES.
