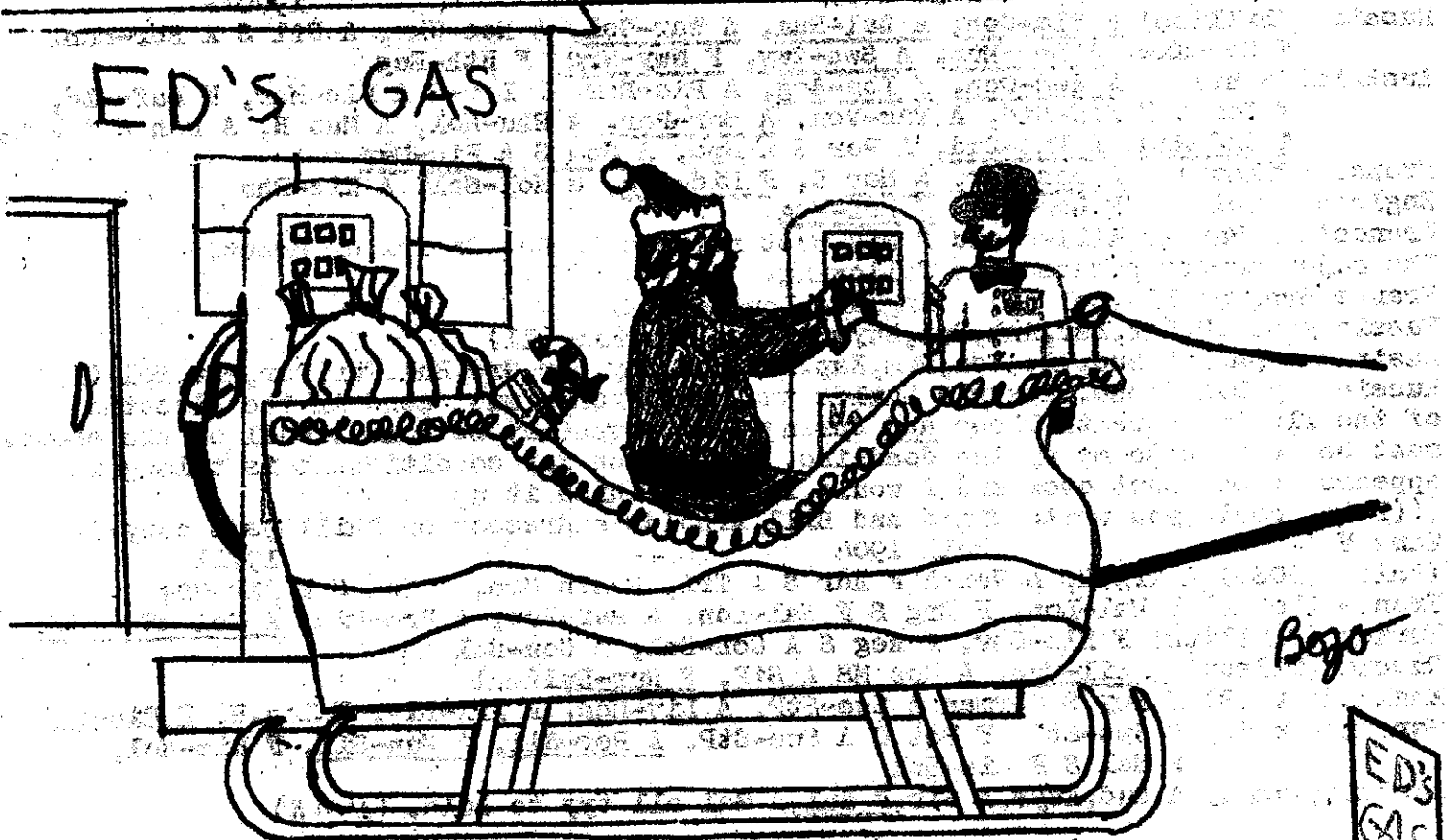
Game I (1970 I)

In response to last week's editorial, Doug Schaefer patriotically tried to enlist in the grey squirrel army, but flunked the physical- his tail wasn't bushy enough.

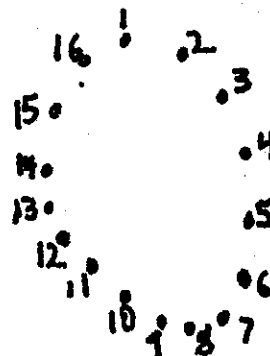

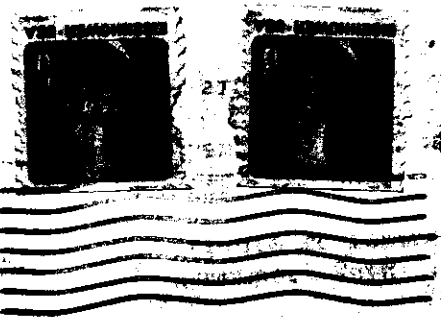
