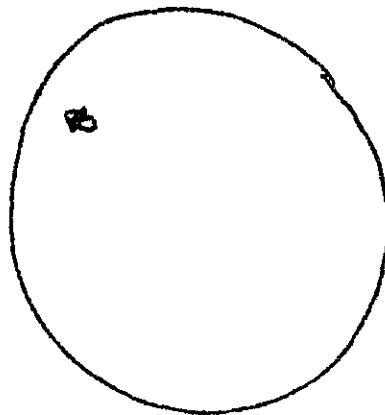

Press releases Game I

Editor's Note: As will be remembered, last month a press release came to me from England and a censored version appeared in the Journal. The Journal's man in Paris contacted the Premier of France(the main object of the press release) and asked him for comment on the charges that the pressrelease levied. Now as an exclusive to the Journal, here is the uncensored version of the English press release and the French Premier's reply.

Prussia, (English HQ), April 10, 1905-The Royal Zoological Society has been recieving reports of various strange creatures being born on the Continent of late. The most common of these are born of pigs, mainly in the "Republic" of France. They have pig-like bodies, (though they are larger than normal piglets) with heads that look remarkable human. Press Releases

Bosowskiville, Oct. 10, 1904--Czar Jenner went to Turkey again to talk to Sultan Goss. Upon seeing him he dropped dead. The British mourn his death and wish the best of luck to the new Czar, Czar Wright (?)

Once a pig slopper gain the Southern Mississippisky(or was he the sloppie(?))he must now face the task of conquering the feeble Aust Austrians. Because of his retarded mind and weak character, the Polish Con. of States will assist him in any way it can. Already an exchange program of vodka and rum has been started. 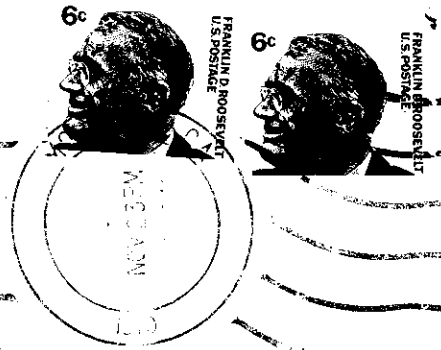
