Please get all moves in on time (that goes for me to, I forgot to move last turn) as I said last month it makes for better games.

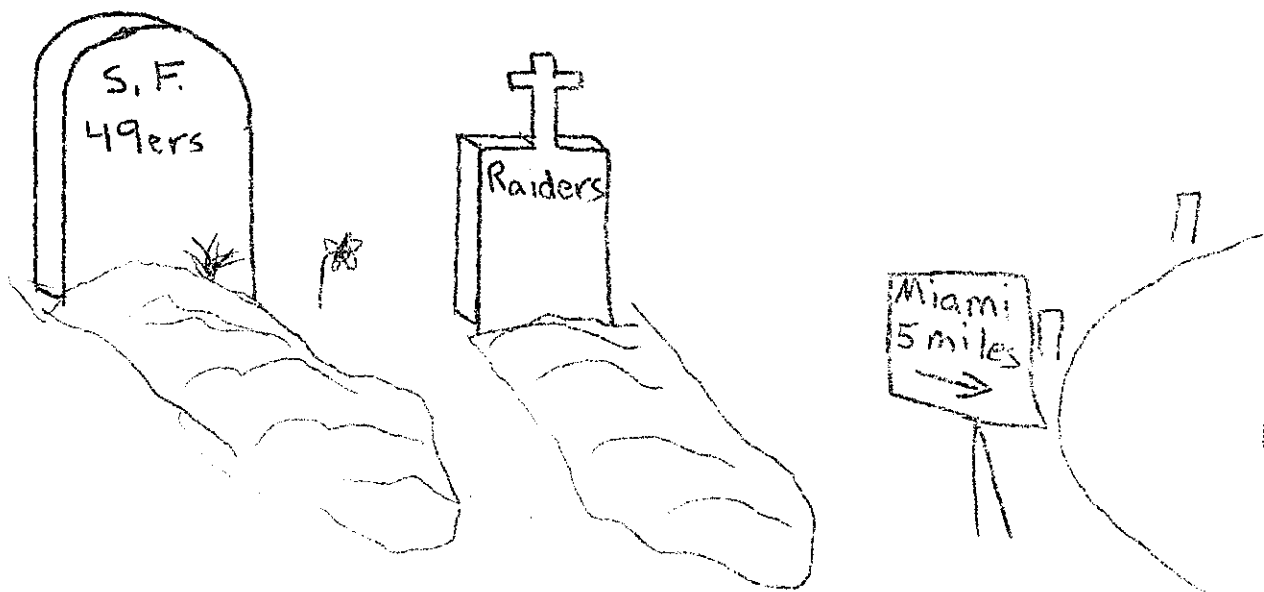
