Press Releases Game I

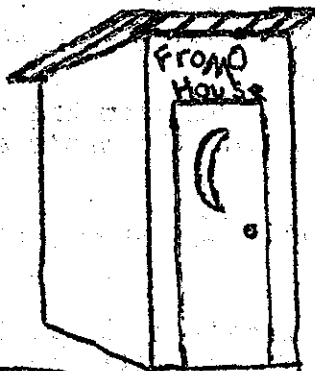

March 30, 1901, **Istanbul**-The Sultan today announced the appointment of Field Marshall Sir Timothy Tilson, K.G.B. to the position of Grand Exalted Fazir of the Empire of Mohammed the prophet.

May 24, 1901, **London**-Our man in London reports that things are in an uproar here in Great Britain. The Armed forces have looked to Pat Kitano for leadership. However, he would rather clean chimneys than be Commander in Chief. Finally, to get the Admirals and Field Marshall's off his back, he closed his eyes, turned around and thrust his hands on a map. Thus, he ordered the Army to march aimlessly through the English countryside, while the fleets burn up fuel in pointless maneuvers. Ah, but at least there is now a leader at the helm.

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April 11, 1901, Vienna-Upon hearing the news from Novi Sad, the Emperor Franz Josef declared war on the Ottoman Empire (i.e. Turkey) for instigating the murder of the Archduke.
