Vienna, October 10, 1907-Grandpa Schmirtz was released from Smellview Hospital today, after recovering from an attack Ben Goss made on him a couple of months ago with a poison pie tart. It seems von Roche has taken a liking to him. Said von Roche, "I have taken a liking to him." Von Roche gave Schmirtz a high ranking position in the government, Secretary of the Inferior. It was held formerly by Kaiser Douglas.

Again from Vienna, a more tragic note-At a party hosted by von Roche, Kaiser Douglas died. It seems he became overly indulgent in intoxicating beverages and dressing up in a ballerina's tu-tu, dropped dead in the middle of a pirouette. "How embarrassing," remarked von Roche. In Vienna the Austrian people are rioting in the streets and thousands have been slaughtered by the Austrian INTERNAL SECURITY FORCES.

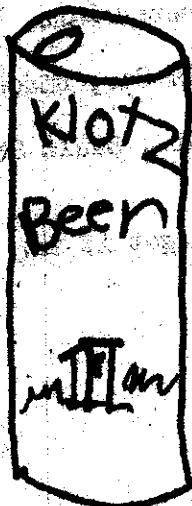
