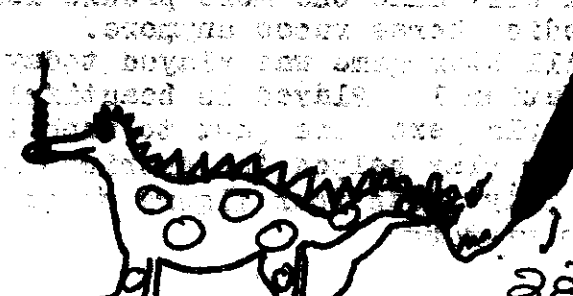
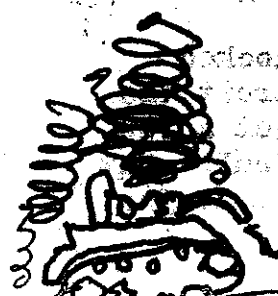

News of the World

Spring 1902

London, March 10, 1902-Our Bureau in London sent the following clipping from the Morning Times: "Today the Prime Minister said that military action will be taken against the Russians in Sweden, after our spy in Moscow, John All Bais, an Indian whose family joined British Forces during the French and Indian War, reported activity in the St. Petersburg area." The head of our London bureau commented that having a spy was unnecessary, since the stupid Russians reported all their movements in their local press. In fact, it seems the Russian Newspapers know before the Generals do.

Constantinople, March 31, 1902-Due to the unfortunate disappearance of our man in Turkey (Rumor has it that his gas mask fell off, and he disintegrated, we must rely on the (ugh) Turkish Press for news. The following is a dispatch from the Constantinople Bee: "Suleiman requests that Dictator Ben Goss guarantee through public press release that the borders of the Aegean Sea, Bulgaria, Rumania, Galicia, Bohemia, Tyrolia, and Venetia shall not be attacked or advanced upon by his or his allies forces. "Today the last surviving scattered remnants of the Greek Army reached Bulgaria,
"There were just too many of them and Italy would not give aid," The Greeks
said. The Austrian Dictator must be stopped. Suleiman requests aid from
all countries." According to reliable sources, Suleiman then had the surviving
members of the Greek army slaughtered, and feed to his horses.

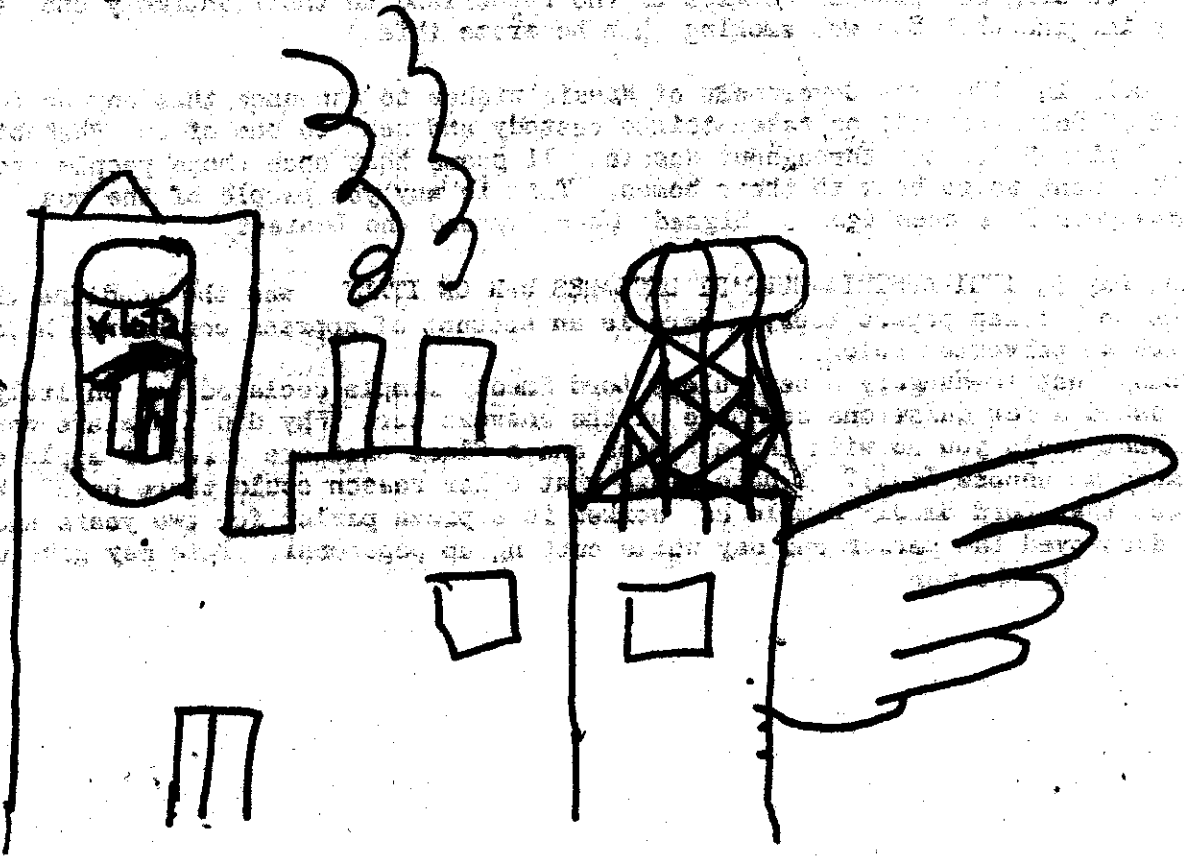
Anzio, March 18, 1902 (UPI)-Documents which had been marked top secret were

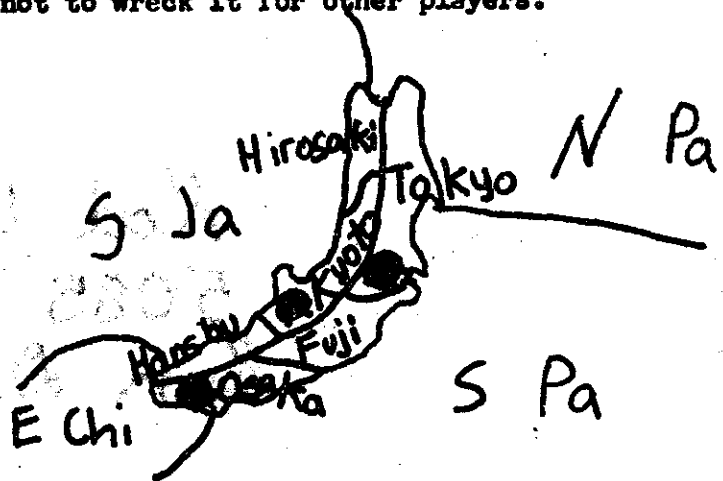

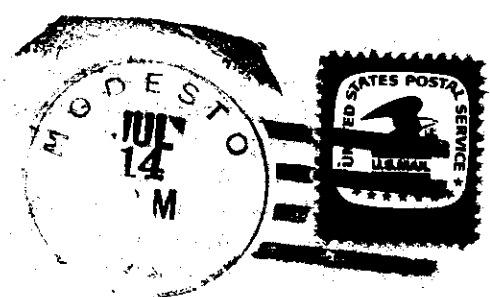
