As a result of the above moves, the Italian Fleet Ionian Sea is dislodged and must retreat to one of the following locations: Tunis, Tyrr. Sea, Naples, Adr or GREECE. In the event that Italy retreats the fleet to Greece, she will be able to build a unit and Austria will have to remove a unit on the winter turn. In order not to delay the game, I am asking the Italian player to send in along with his retreat, his build if he elects to retreat to Greece, and the Austrian player to send in a removal in the event that he loses Greece. The following supply center chart reflects the situation at the end of the fall turn, minus the fall retreats.

JJ # 1 Press Releases:

ROME (4 Sept) Nearly all supplies of Canadian beer remaining in Italy have been collected and are now being loaded onto specially padded transports of the vast Italian Merchant fleet, The fleet, reportedly heavily escorted, has a secret destination. Its commander is the noble Admiral Scuttleria, still remembered for ramming the Injuria into an English beer barge in 1889.

FALL 1903 MOVES ARE DUE ON SATURDAY 27 APRIL, 1968

PRESS RELEASES:

LONDON: The British Navy, at the request of the exiled government of Denmark, is moving to liberate the country from the last remains of German tyranny. The king and government of Denmark will be restored as soon as the country is made safe for them by the British Marines.

VERSAILLES, MAY 4, 1903. The French Government condemns the invasion of Austria-Hungary and France by Italy. The government will direct all its energies to the elimination of this traitorous nation to the exclusion, if necessary, of all others. But fear not, loyal Frenchmen! The royal Government marches on, does not flag or fail, does not cry for quarter, does not give up Frenchmen's lives in vain. Vive le Roi, vive les francais, VIVE LA FRANCE!!!

ROME: Italy has no quarrel with the French or Austrian peoples, its your countries we want, not you. So if you'd all be willing to leave we would be grateful. By the way Austria, since when we entered your country we found out you had already exterminated our brother wops, there is now no reason for us being there, since you beat us to it. So we are willing to make peace, also, since the newspapers revealed to the people that people got killed in wars there has been violent protesting. Thank God our soldiers run when they are shot at and in looting the countryside only rape little old ladies, or our casualties would be much heavier than 2 wounded and 1 killed.

VIENNA: Italy, I'm beginning to get annoyed at this. I have done nothing to antagonize you and yet you persist in this ridiculous war. Unless you cease and desist now I will be forced to take action, and that includes pulling such nasty tricks as taking Naples if I got into the Ionian this time.

DRESDEN: Forward units of the Third White Army reached the city today after light fighting with the German Wine Makers' Guild. News spread through the city that Italian troops operating out of the Tyrolian Alps had taken the Bavarian capital of Munich. Hearing the news of German defeats in Bavaria, Silesia, Belgium, and Denmark local troops of Germany's Home Army came out of hiding and surrendered in full battalions to the handful of Russian soldiers occupying the industrial center of Dresden. This is the black day in German military history.

LONDON: The war department today announced that the British First Army has started its annual spring maneuvers in South-western Britian. The maneuvers will be over in a couple of months, at which time the army will probably be shipped off to Canada to aid their hard pressed forces against the American aggressor. The war department was also happy to announce that Japanese marines had landed on the U.S. west coast and were advancing inland. Soon the dirty Bheer drinking American dogs will be finished.

MONTREAL (April 19, 1903): The U.S. First Army, after thawing out after the winter in Suglug, has returned to civilized areas (or are they civilized?) minus about 20,000 men lost from frostbite. 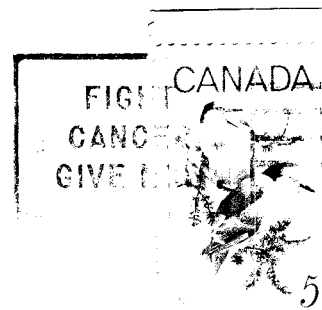
SPRING 1903 MOVES ARE DUE ON SATURDAY 27 APRIL, 1968
