VERSAILLES, March 19, 1904: England, if you attack me I will let Italy
walk in and concentrate everything against
you. On the other hand, if you do not attack me, I will tread on Italy
for you.

LONDON (May 28): Today the defense ministry announced that the newly
commissioned 4th fleet was on spring maneuvers in the
Channel. They were also to guard against any possible French treachery.
The veteran 2nd fleet assisted in the Channel operation.

MOSCOW: Upon the discovery that the War Ministry had created three new
armies and that there are now six armies mobilized for the
services of the Czar, the Ministry of Census blew its lid. The Ministry
had just learned to count up to three and expected to learn four by the
summer of this year, but six is far too much to expect graduates of Moscow
Tech to learn in only one year. The Ministry and then the navy complained
that another fleet should have been built; the navy because they were
itching to get back out to sea, and the Ministry because it is a lot
easier to count five soldiers and four boats than six soldiers and

FOR SPORTS FANS

Quick now, gang, what's Canada's national game?

Most of you are quite wrong. It's not hockey; it's lacrosse. The main distinction between the two is that lacrosse is played on fields of grass, concrete or dirt as opposed to ice, and that lacrosse is a faster, more physically demanding, and more violent game than hockey.

It's got the same object, to put a wrong object (the Indians sometimes used human skulls) into a net at one end of the playing area. If you can survive the energy demands caused by running up and down the rink for an hour, and then make it through the enemy team in one piece you get a chance to score.

(My first contact with lacrosse was in high school when a buddy of mine--FDSSA All-Star in both hockey and football, played lacrosse for a while but quit when he found it "too tough".)

Lacrosse used to be a strictly amateur game populated by guys who seemed to figure drinking and fighting in the Canadian Army was too tame for them. Outside Quebec and BC it was watched only by sadists. The rest of us watched and played Yankee baseball.

But baseball is dead in the Canadian cities, and lacrosse appears to be filling the gap. It has been prodded into this by the formation of a professional league (with eight teams, six of them Canadian), and, in the Toronto area, televised matches of league games. Professionalism speeded up the game and improved tactical skill (as opposed to the bull drive in normally required).

Besides, the money moguls of America haven't bought out lacrosse yet like they did hockey . . .

(And for those who like violence in sport--for the liberal pseudonym read: bodily contact--lacrosse has got it. It's a little tamer than in Indian days when people used to get killed playing it, but a normal game still results in numerous penalties and injuries, especially broken bones and concussions.)

And what sport has a team with such a lovely name as the New Westminster Salmonbellies . . .

So if you like your sports fast and rough, watch lacrosse. It grows on you.

THE RULES OF POSTAL DIPLOMACY

The rules disputes division of postal diplomacy had been fairly dormant until Welles, Reinsel and McCallum burst into print on the subject a few weeks ago. The resulting discussion necessitates our explaining, clarifying, and adding to JJ rules.

First, an explanation. In JJ#2 three consecutive missed moves mean you're out of the game. My rationale * for this was to remove the uncertainty caused by having a unit in the game that no-one knew whether it was going to move or not. At the same time I didn't want to penalize anybody because they missed a couple of moves, or even half the moves in a game (as long as they were staggered misses). Besides, in real life a country that goes into civil disorder in the midst of a war for a period of a full year would be knocked out of the conflict.

Now, A RULE CHANGE: A victory will occur in all JJ games, past and present, when a Power achieves 18 units on the board. (Our reasons for this are better put, and influenced by, John McCallum in #84 Brob.) NB: Objection by any one player in a present game will cause the victory criteria for that game to revert to the old system.

A rule addition: Ties and draws are declared by all surviving player's agreements OR after three game years without change of supply centres the gamesmaster may exercise this option.

In the first days of Scarborough diplomacy an army being convoyed by a fleet that was dislodged was sunk. I'd like to use it again, but we won't make it a rule for present games, and probably not for future games if there is too much dissent in general dippydom. REPEAT: we are not making it a rule.

Any future games in JJ will use the Miller-Calhammer system for resolving Boardman's Dilemma.

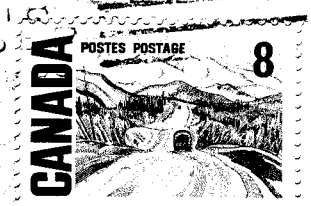
