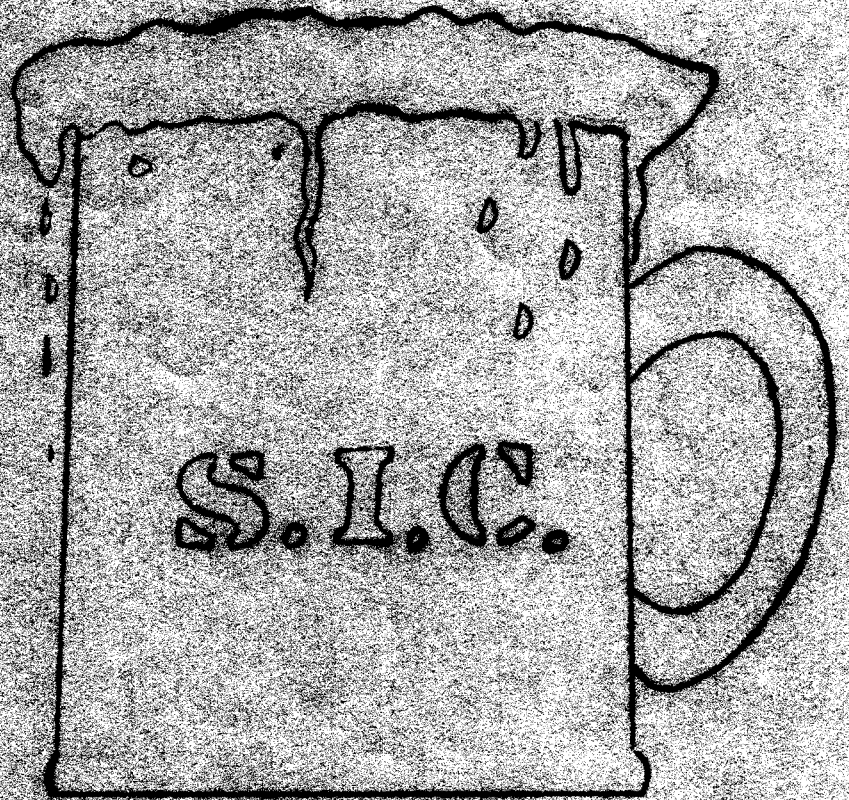

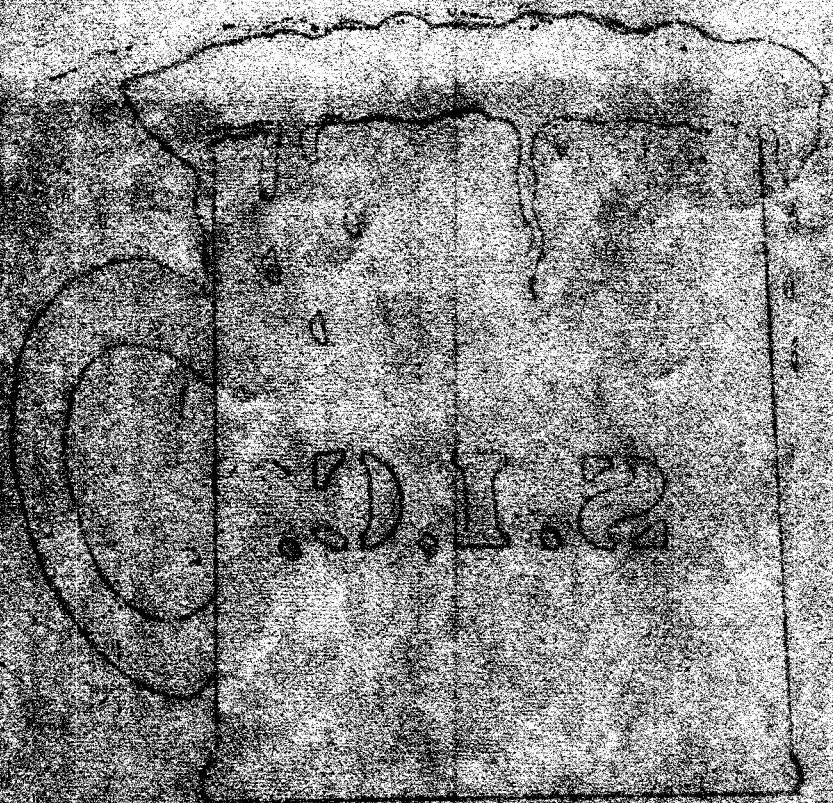

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Winter, 1901 builds are due Saturday, 13 January, 1968

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LONDON: The British Government is forced to announce that French aggression and breach of agreement cannot be tolerated. Her Majesty's Government will be forced to commence hostilities with the Imperialistic French Dogs unless they regress at once.

England calls upon her allies and friends to aid her in the destruction of this menace to European peace. The English people are solidly behind their allies, and will support them to the fullest.

OTTAWA: The British Government is widely known for its sense of humour. The Canadian Government waits with bated breath to see what happens in the Channel when hostilities "commence", and when France "regresses".

JJ # 2 Press Releases: - cont'd

**BERLIN:** Official government announcement to Constantinople: Your irresponsible advice to Italy May force us to close our embassy in your country.....and were also sorry about the fact that the mob burned yours.

**VERSAILLES:** ( 2 August )--The minor police mission performed by the King's forces in Spain has now been completed. All French forces in Spain have thus been ordered to retire via the coast ( Barcelona - Provence ) road; the rightful King Peter III of Spain and Duke Peter XIII of Anjou having been installed on the throne with a sizable loan from the Royal French Government to finance a mercenary army.

Some alarmists in France's Army Southern Division feared an Italian invasion through Monaco, and while it is emphasized that these fears are not shared by King Coleman and his leading ministers, they did not militate against the move of the speedy withdrawal from Spain.

The King states again and again that war with Italy is not likely or even expected, and daily urges peace on the Italian Ambassador, who, to the dismay of the court, has refused to travel the few short miles from Paris to Versailles to see the King, who is anxious and willing to grant him an audience.

**BRUSSELS:** ( 19 October ) Brussels is approaching hysteria. From the threat in May of a French invasion, to one in late June of an English amphibious landing near Ostend, to more current threats of invasion by Germany, now surrounding Belgium in the north and east: the populace is afraid and distraught. No-one what to expect, apparently not even King Lendex IV. The King has not appeared publicly for over two months. Is he ill? Dying? or concealing evil news? No-one knows, and everyone worries. Meanwhile, boarder incidents with the Germans and French continue. So far, no serious push has been made by any of the three great powers surrounding Belgium to invade it, but it is more and more apparent that when one comes, the Royal Belgian Army will be in no state to resist it.

**WIEN:** ( 17 September, 1901 ) ( Official War Ministry Bulletin )

"At the request of the Government of the Kingdom of Greece, units of the Adriatic Fleet under Mühler and the Hungarian Light Cavalry (VII Corps) have occuoied the Greek cities of Salonika, and Athens, and the temporary suspension of civil liberties in Greece. The War Ministry emphasizes that this measure is only a precaution against Turkish agression in the Balkans."

"As soon as Turkey withdraws its troops from Bulgaria and the Aegean islands the state of emergency in Greece, and the older one in Serbia will be withdrawn.

War Minister von Korber also announced the withdrawal of the Austro-Hungarian Minister to Canada. This move is in retaliation for the shipment of a mixture of hydrogen peroxide and swamp gas to Trieste, where it exploded. Government officials were at a loss to explain the cryptic notation on the shipment: BHEER "

**TORONTO:** That wasn't bheer, that was Red Cap.

**MOSCOW:** The Russian Government wishes to announce that according to past results Russia will once again pursue that imperialistic policy of doing nothing.

FALL 1901 MOVES ARE DUE ON SATURDAY 13 JANUARY, 1968

Press Releases.

BERLIN: Recently a German envoy to Canada returned. he looked very distressed and kept muttering to himself. No one has yet figured out what he is saying, but it sounds like he is saying "How on earth could anyone ever find ontario? The whole place is one big wilderness." Since no one knows what an "Ontario" is, we are having trouble understanding him.

ROME: Spring 1901 (Screwters News Service) The Prime Minister made a stirring speech here as Italian troops crossed the Austrian boarder: "The guilt for this war is Austria's. We are merely defending ourselves against totally uncalled-for aggression. Austria has provoked us deliberately ... treaty violations ... inciting civil unrest ... and many other constant provocations. We did not ask for this war, but now that it has been thrust upon us, we shall fight on to victory. Austria will be destroyed ... Our army, equipped with the very best, cannot fail ... Many secret weapons... Even now canisters full of liquid Swiss chocolate are arriving at the front. Sprayed upon the enemy by the powerful Flying (we invented the airplane first) Corps, all the Austrian Weapons will be hopelessly gummed up ... our agents in Austria are very active already ... many plots being put into effect ... all Tyrolian hats to be stolen, destroying enemy morale ... sit-ins to be held at Vienna ... Ban the Bullet demonstrations at Trieste ... The Austrian demanarchy is bound to collapse ... completely incapable of resisting us."

UKOMAASIA: (United Kingdom Of Montanagro, Albania, And Serbia) VIENNA:  
The last Austro-Hungarian Stronghold (Vienna) has fallen, and with it, the entire Austro-Hungarian Empire. UKOMAASIAN soldiers, who have been fighting against this once formidable enemy for 3 years, can finally rest. But their rest may be short, because already the Great Powers of Europe are mobilizing their forces; the destruction of Austria - Hungary appears to have upset Europe's long-standing alliance checks-and-balances system.

SKOPJE: From the capital of the UKOMAASTIAN Empire comes this start-  
**ling** statement: UKOMAASIA announces a complete withdrawal from inter-  
national affairs. To Facilitate this complete neutrality; a 5,000  
mile long wall, which will completely enclose the Empire, will be built.

BUDAPEST: Many Austrian Prisoners are now receiving full pardons, after pledging allegiance to UKOMAASIA, and promising that they won't laugh at the name. At present, large prisoner-of-war camps exist in Serbia, Albania and Budapest.

LONDON: Her Majesty has called upon the right Hon. Edmund (Ned) Burke to form a government. The MP from Malton would have been invited to kiss hands had he not been dead for 103 years. high government sources ADMIT that this development is unusual. However, a young Canadian scholar has been set to work discovering policies amenable to this great statesman, and has been installed in the Foreign Office. It is feared that Mr. Burke's regime might be hostile to France.

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#### EDITORIAL

Following is an editorial by Bob Lake on the subject of Diplomacy rating lists.

What I am about to propose is not another new type of rating list or modification of any existing ones, but rather an end to the rating list dilemma. I cannot come up with a rating list that is perfect and I don't think that anyone else can either.

What I propose is this: Why not let the players and in particular the various gamesmasters decide for themselves from the rating lists now in use and from the proposed ones, which one they would like to have adopted as "the official" rating list, to be followed by all gamesmasters. A summary of all the lists now in use and of some of the proposed ones could be published in one of the leading Diplomacy magazines (either STAB or BROBDINGNAG as both John Koning and John McCallum are quite familiar with the rating list situation) and sent out to all active Diplomacy players and gamesmasters. They would then write their comments and choice on the summary and return it to the sender. The rating list deemed most popular by this pole would then be adopted as the Official Rating List for Postal Diplomacy and employed as such.

I admit that this plan will not please everyone because as long as there are rating lists there will be arguments about them, but we will have a rating system to work with, the arguments go on.
