PRESS RELEASES:

NEW NAPLES, NOVA SCOTIA: (21 Sept) To the surprise of all of Italy, and to the extreme joy of Italy's proud navy, the minister of foreign affairs and the defense minister today reported the first major battle of the Canadian-Italian War. After sailing under secret orders for 8 weeks, the 4th, 5th, and 17th construction brigades landed with 200 marines and a beer disposal team. They immediately made room for a special colonization force of 6,000 brave civilians who have agreed to colonize New Naples. No casualties were reported in the stunning invasion. Resistance is expected to present itself soon, but the leaders of the expedition are optimistic. Twelve divisions of regular troops are expected soon, along with more colonists.

AMSTERDAM, August 19, 1903: Damaged units of the English Home Squadron, battered in last Friday's indecisive action with the French off Spithead, were being received for repairs at De Neue Skipbauerft. Admiral of the Fleet Lord John Fisher, wearing his flag in HMS Thunderer, expressed the thanks of His Majesty's Government for the hospitality extended by the Government of Queen Wilhelmina and especially for that extended by the German Ambassador, the Ritter von Geyr, and the Oberefehlshaber Flanders, Colonel-General von Mackensen. "Our Continental cousins," declared the Admiral, "need never doubt the faith nor the determination of the English nation. We shall continue in the fight until the last fanatical frog-sticking Frenchman is returned to his native swamps, to view the ruins of his ancestral dung--heap. It is a sorry day that sees France struck with war madness as a dog is with hydrophobia; but since five times in two centuries the fit has come upon the French, it is high time for civilized nations to take a hand and so chastise them that they will never wish to make war again."

ROME (14 Sept.): Today all of Rome is praying quietly for success in repulsing the Austrian aggressors occupying Venice. Military experts report that the Italian Armies' Joint Planning Department, located in an abandoned Canadian Warehouse in downtown Parma, has invented a maneuver never before seen in Italy. "It involves the use of one army to support another. Nothing like it has ever been seen before, and we expect favourable results," commented one general.

CONSTANTINOPLE: The Sultan Greenbaum III in a public address before the Combined Fellows For Advanced Study of Hcps stated that there can be no peace between Islam and Russia. Only the total destruction of the Csar and his empire will satisfy the honor of Islam.

CLARION, RUSSIA: Big Brother to "Great Uncle" John Smythe; "You have lied to me for the last time! I hereby declare WAR against you in this game, in every other game and in all future games that we are in! Also I don't like you either."--HA, HA!

OTTAWA: The Canadian Government today announced that a grubby bunch of Italians were found last week washed up on the rocks off the coast of Nova Scotia. On being approached by Canadian Officials, the Italians immediately dropped to their knees and begged forgiveness for the evil thoughts which were installed in their little minds. Panic ensued amongst the Italians when the thought occurred to one of them that the Canadians just might be armed and the sorrowful looking group scrambled back into the water and began swimming back to Italy.

ANKARA (AP): Sultan Baibars, the Ruler of 150 million Moslems, called for full mobilization today. Sultan Baibars, who fought his way to the Sultanate by strangling barehanded 15 Janisaries and brea' s the neck of the old Sultan, stated that under no circumstances would he allow the Holy Throne of Turkey to be sullied by foreign insults and threats! There was some consternation in the various foreign delagate here, as all stated that he did not mean their respective countries. However, unofficial sources stated that he ment, Russia, Austria, Italy, Germany, England and France. The Grand Duchy of Luxembourg breathed a sigh of relief when they found that they were not included.

FALL 1902 MOVES ARE DUE ON SATURDAY, 24 FEBRUARY, 1968

PRESS RELEASES:

WARSAW: In an attempt to control Polish raiders on Russia's Border with Germany and the Baltic Sea the Russian Government has ordered the First Northern Squadron based in Malmo and the Tsar's Hussars to patrol the border. It is believed that Polish pirates are operating out of the island of Bornholm under the supervision of the pro-German Government of Denmark. With Russian shipping taking a heavy toll passing through the Baltic Sea on its way to the Atlantic the Government has been pressured into action. The First Northern Squadron will organize Russian merchant ships into defensive convoy units in their passage through German and Danish waters. To conduct an efficient hunt of the pirates the Tsar's Hussars have been ordered to cooperate with the Navy in this matter. To do so the Tsar's Hussars have organized a campaign to trap the pirates on the coast between the Navy and the Army and then annihilation. It is hoped that the German Government will not interfere with operations.

LONDON:(Dec 19) The British gov't today announced that a state of war exists between the British Empire and the United States of America. The P.M. in an official press release stated: "We knew it was only a matter of time--- the bheer thing was getting more involved each day. We even offered to reduce the price of Scotch, but the bheer hungary Americans wanted Red Cap and Boh. The American invasion of Canada today leaves us no other choice but to protect the integrity of our Dominion with all the forces of this great Empire."
The British gov't also issued an appeal to the Japanese government

and all its other allies to aid them in destroying the top heavy, imperialistic, power-drunk American aggressors.

CANBERRA (Dec. 19) The Australian government declared war on the U.S. Imperialists and dispatched the first and second Australian Divisions to aid in the defense of Canada.

KATMUNDU (Dec. 20) Today the government of Nepal, at the request of the British, dispatched 5,000 Gurkas to aid in moping up the eastern seaboard of the American aggressors. (They were especially instructed to destroy all the American bheer that fell into their hands, lest it contaminate superior Canadian brew.)

CAPE TOWN, SOUTH AFRICA (Dec 20) South Africa declared war on the U.S. and dispatched 251 head hunters and 3 witch doctors to assist the Gurkas.

TOKYO, JAPAN (Dec 20) The Japanese gov't today announced that due to its treaty with Great Britian, and due to unprovoked American aggression, it is declaring war on the U.S. The Fleet sailed today to engage the U.S. Pacific Fleet.

WAKE ISLAND (Dec 22) There is not a trace left of the U.S. Pacific Fleet here after it was engaged by the Imperial Japanese Navy and sunk to nearly a ship. American gunnery was very poor, and rings of cheap American bheer surrounded many sinking ships. The Japanese Navy did not lose even a rowboat.

LONDON (Feb 15) The British Parliament, which has been in a terrible state of anxiety ever since Germany broke the Anglo/German pact by building a second fleet, has finally decided that such a situation cannot be allowed to persist or reoccur. The British Gov't therefore ordered the fleet to take battle stations against the German oath breakers. The PM urged all the nations of Europe to consider carefully this menace to European peace.

VERSAILLES (Feb 28) British Diplomats are still consulting with the French here today. As of yet no agreement has been reached, but the talks are progressing satisfactorily, and something seems to be in the offing.

VERSAILLES (14 March) The French Royal Government's move in 1896 from Paris to nearby Versailles today was proved justified when the Paris mob, rioting out of control throughout the city, murdered some 400 government bureaucrats and set fire to the old Royal residence. The fires were soon doused, but it was clear that the mob was in no mood for government. While some rioters set out for Versailles, they were exhausted long before they had marched the eleven miles to the capital. Thus King Coleman I of France and his government escaped harm.

Examination of the causes of the riot brought Coleman to the grim fact that France was a desperate country. After hardly more than a year of war, accompanied by fantastic inflation and shortage of commodities, the populace is ready for peace.

But fear not, loyal Frenchmen! The Royal Government marches on, does not flag or fail, does not cry for quarter, does give up Frenchmen lives in vain'. Vive Le Roi, vive les francais , VIVE LA FRANCE'.

VERSAILLES (30 April) King Coleman I of France is forced to announce that, in the event of German armed forces attempting to cross the French border this spring, a state of war exists between France and Germany.
