



TSAR TREK The Motion Sickness Part two



CONSERVATIVE CONVENTION - The Aftermath.

Oh well, I've been wrong before and no doubt will be again. Michael Wilson did play out his role, he ensured Mulroney's momentum when he crossed the floor. However either Crosbie or Clarke may have won if one or the other had crossed the floor. The fact that these two wouldn't combine does show where some of the aucus trouble was.
