





Now that the outcry over the shooting down of the Korean airliner has subsided, we can now reflect back on not only that one incident, but on all the senseless killings on both sides.

In South America: people are murdered randomly in both Argentina and Chile. Note, that the latter is an acknowledged ally of the USA. It's believed that the CIA was pivotal in toppling the socialist 'Allende' government and aiding in installing a military dictatorship where hundreds of people just dissapear. People are rioting in Brazil, mainly due to the fact that people are starving in, basically. a land of plenty.

The word 'revolution' appears to be synominous with Central America. I doubt if you could get accurate counts of the people murdered by the right-wing death squads in both El Salvador and Nicaragua (Before the latter government fell). If you totalled up the number of people murdered in both South and Central America it would probally fill up twenty KAL airliners. What were their crimes? In the majority of cases probably suspicion of being a communist or being a protester of their respective governments. What outcry do we hear for these people? None. Instead we continue to arm those governments.

In Eastern Europe the true face of communism was shown in Hungry in 1956, Czechoslovakia in 1968 and, most recently, in Poland. Here communism is maintained by force so much so that it's part of the people's life. In Afghanistan there are stories of towns being wiped out by helicopter gunships, as well as the accusation of the Russian forces using gas warfare. To the Russian heirarchy, a human life is meaningless. We are continually reminded of this by Russian actions in all areas of the world.

In Pakistan and India, whenever elections are held, there's always a high toll in human life. People are being murdered because they want to exercise their rights and vote. Unfortunately, the majority dominates the minority by terror and slayings. Not only here but in Sri Lanka, Northern Africa, Iran and just the opposite in South Africa, where the solution to any racial unrest is to shoot a few more blacks.

Where are the cries of outrage for all the above? There isn't just one guilty party that we can pile the blame on.

Overall it's apparent taht governments today on all sides of the political spectrum place little value on an individual life. Taking that one step further, I believe that man himself puts little value on his fellow man's life. Only when tragedy strikes close to ourselves do we become outraged. But by then it is and always will be much too late.

((By "we" I presume that you mean the Western Countries aka the US. The problem with many of the world's atrocities is that there is little that can be done by an outside country. Just how would we show the Soviet Union our outrage over their "accident' with the KAL airliner? As for South/Central America. I think that any country that tries to take sides down there is asking for trouble. My idea of outside interference would be to send down medical teams to tract any victims.))
