Please get your negotiating done before you come up to turn in moves.

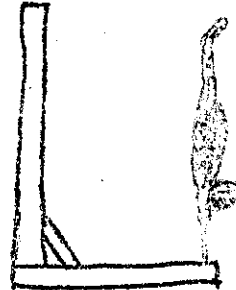

Winter adjustments will be due at the same time (and may be submitted with Fall moves on a conditional basis). LANKHMAR will be published each Friday, containing a full year. 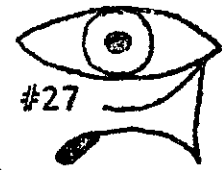
