

Richard Orzechowski worked for an elevator company which had a pension plan. Benefits vested only after 10 years continuous amployment with that company. Richard didn't think he'd be with the company that long, so he asked to be excluded. In Nov., 1975 the company told ham he'd probably be laid off. So, before Dec. 31 of that year, he contributed \$1500 to an "IRA" (individual retirement account) and deducted the amount on his 1975 return. In Jan. 1975 heaws laid off. Only with the company for 7.5 years, all his benefits in the company retirement plan were forfeited.

Next, the IRS disallowed the \$1500 deduction for the reason Richard was still an active participant in a qualified retirement plan in 1975. The IRS considered the \$1500 an excess contribution and imposed a 6% excise tax of \$90.

Richard lost his case in the tax court because he couldn't prove his assertion that the company regularly laid off employees before they had been employed 10 years.

Now Richard is subject to the 6% excise tax every year until he withdraws the \$1500 from his IRA account. But if he takes the money out before he reaches age 59.5 years, the IRS will consider it a premature distribution, subject to a 10% penalty tax. He also had to pay income tax on the \$1500 in 1975, since he couldn't claim it as a deduction. And, finally, when he takes the money out of his account as a distribution, he will have to pay income taxes on the amount for a second time.

Sadly, this is not a unique case. Anyone out there want to defend the IRS? Of course, the company is at fault, too, for the robbery of employees pension benefits.


