

Chip is a new player to AB rules. He is experienced in tactical armored play, as well as in the strategic and diplomatic aspacts of AB. He also playe "STREUSL", which is a game very similar to AB, except it's based upon Sound Leader for its tactical element.

We now need one new AB player for 1943. The UK position is open. It's in bad shape, and needs a good salvage effort. The Japanese player, Jim Fradiani, expresses on interest in trying to salvage the UK position, so a new player might get the very excellent position of Japan to play. Please express your praference when you request assignment. First come. First served first served.

It's still 3 or 4 months until 1943 will begin (unless the scenarios end early). Chip and the player who takes the vacant position will have time to diplomatically acquaint them with have time to diplomatically acquaint their selves with the other players (ployers are playing Germany, USA, Japan, Russia, Poland, Spain, Italy, and Turkey in addition to UK). 




