

Powered by four Rolls-Royce Olympus TM3B marine gas turbines. Invincible has a complement of 903, this includes the crew of the six Sea Harriers and the 10 Sea King helicopters. She was commissioned by HM the Queen on 11 July 1980.

The Ski-Jump deck was invented by a Royal Naval Engineering officer. Lieutenant-Commander D. R. Taylor, and is a vital factor in the design development of the smaller aircraft carriers. A 20 degree Ski-Jump enables the take-off run of the aircraft to be reduced by up to 50 per cent. It also offers many other operating advantages.




[I've just learned from a player that we don't charge unit maintenance in ABWW2. He also informed me I tried to charge it last year, too.
