
General Madero to El Pres: "Yes the family likes money. Where do you want me to go? Bank? Chamber? or the Palace?"



Jim -- I object to the way you handled Cosmos withdrawing from the game. If Olson does not want to play, fine. However, to just give a scenario away like you did is not. I'm sure you could have found someone to play the minors for you (me for instance). I hate to think any time a nation I'm attacking can just take their dollies and toys and go home (i.e., be black holed) just because I'm winnins! I understand it's hard to change your rulings at this time, BUT I want a firm ruling for the future on this. Also, will you explain again exactly what ANNARES can and can't do?

I intended to set another player to play the minors, but Carl said he'd stay in the same long enough to disband the units before he quit. The rules permit, even encourage, disbanding units. Players have done it before. The only time I do not permit disbanding units is during any turn AFTER one's CP has been captured in a tactical scenario. I black holed Cosmos at Carl's request, and because there aren't enough players around it to justify leaving it in with no player in Pendrason. Frediani wants me to black hole Pendrason, too, but I hesitate to do so since Carthase has conquered Narnia.

ANNARES cannot attack any zone outside its minors, unless Annares, or one of the 6 surrounding minors is attacked. If attacked, Annares may then attack ANY possession of the player who launched the attack, especially since now Jim Frediani offers to moderate any combat in which Annares is engaged.]
