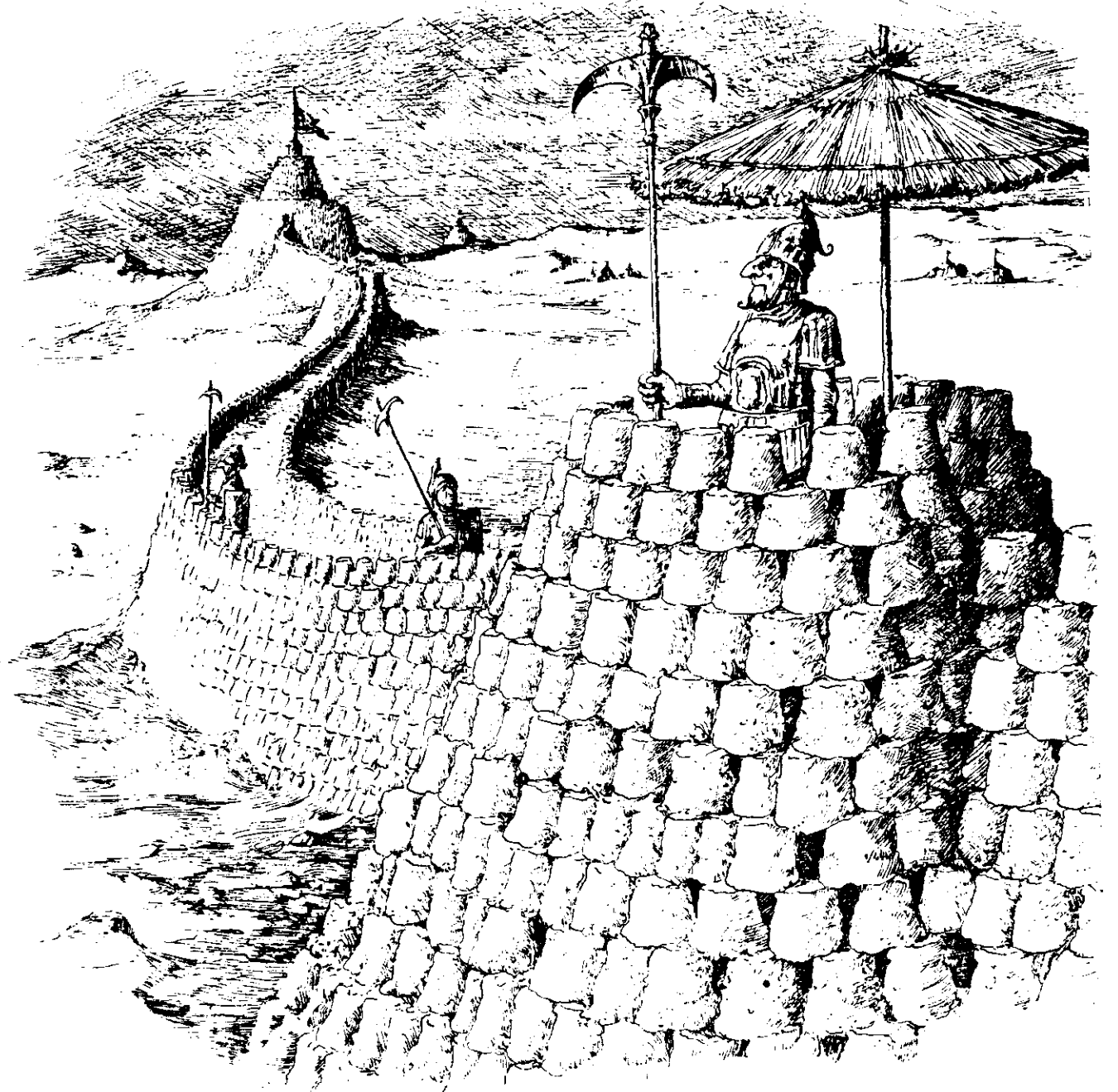

 LIBERTERREAN DEADLINE IS: FRIDAY, October 8, 1982.

Because of the delay and confusion with forwarding mail to the new address, I've given several extra days to this deadline. Actually, I needed the time, too. I've been very busy unpacking boxes and working on the house.

PACIFICON 1982

Pacificon this year was smaller than last year, but we still had over 70 participants in the Diplomacy Tournament. \$210.00 was awarded in cash to 7 winners.

I drew Germany in the first round. The first thing I thought was: "I won't have to play Germany again in this Tournament!" I thought I was cooked. But the other 6 players put me on a greased slide, and I slid into an 18 center win.

The 2d round I drew Austria! I always was lucky. I tied myself to a strong Turkey and rode his coattail into 2d place.

The first 2 rounds were good enough to place me in the Top Board game, where I promptly drew Italy. I joined Andrew Brannan (Germany), Greg Duncan (Austria), John Gregson (Russia), Michael Hasten (England), Kevin Heoner (Turkey), and Mike Maden (France) on the Top Board. I found no help on this board. Austria and Russia had what I learned was a firm alliance after I helped them eliminate Turkey. England joined their alliance after Germany was gone and proposed an A-E-R draw with Italy 4th.

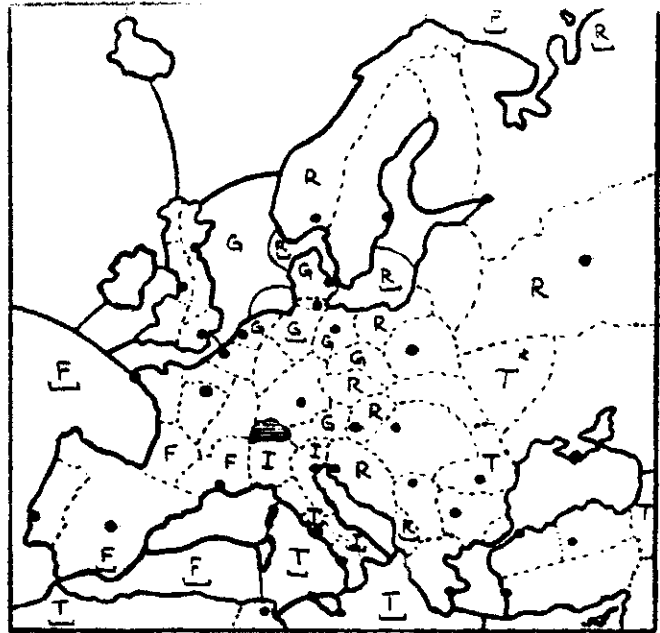
I refused to go along, hoping I could get one of them to go for the win (I hate draws!). My stubbornness cost me a little. England evacuated Portugal (a French center, France had no units and no place to build). They then proceeded to save France until they eliminated me.

The players scoring more than 10 Tournament Points are: Michael Hasten - 27.05; Greg Duncan - 24.41; John Gregson - 23.08; Mike Maden - 22.11; Jim Bumpas - 20.94; Kevin Heoner - 20.13; Dave Grabar - 18.23; Andrew Brannan - 18.13; Tim Haffey - 11.34; Richard Block - 11.05; Eill Radonich - 10.51; Dave Cowgill - 10.37; Ed Williger - 10.36.

Scoring the countries like players, the countries performed as follows: Turkey - 9.95; England - 7.58; Germany - 7.17; Austria - 6.10; Italy - 6.07; France - 5.34; Russia - 3.18.

This is the second year in a row Russia has come in last. Two years ago it came in 5th! England and Turkey have shared 1st and 2d place for 3 years now.

Ian McCaleb has joined a New Wave group, GG Allin. He sent me a demo tape of a new release, and two cuts from another group, Madness. The lyrics are more pointed and biting than most of the commercial New Wave stuff getting air play now. On the back side of the tape is a recording of the PBS show, "Hitch-hiker's Guide to the Galaxy".

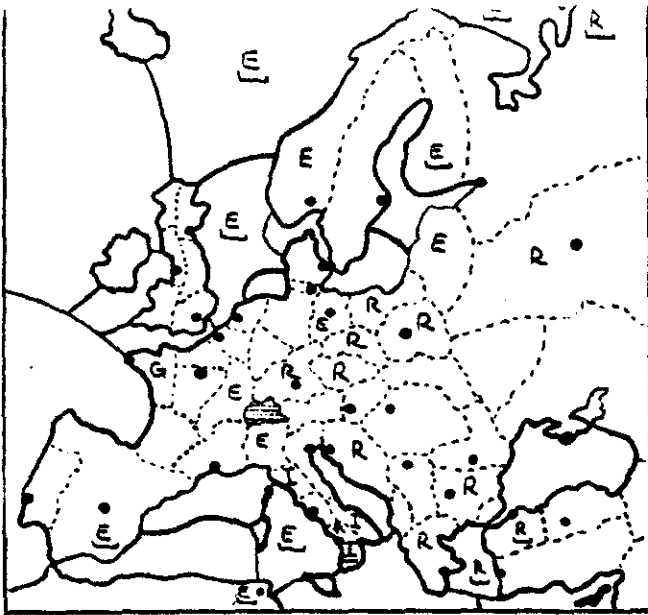
Soon after these words the ancient Presidente collapsed and died, leaving the family fortune to his firebrand nephew, Umberto Olsini.

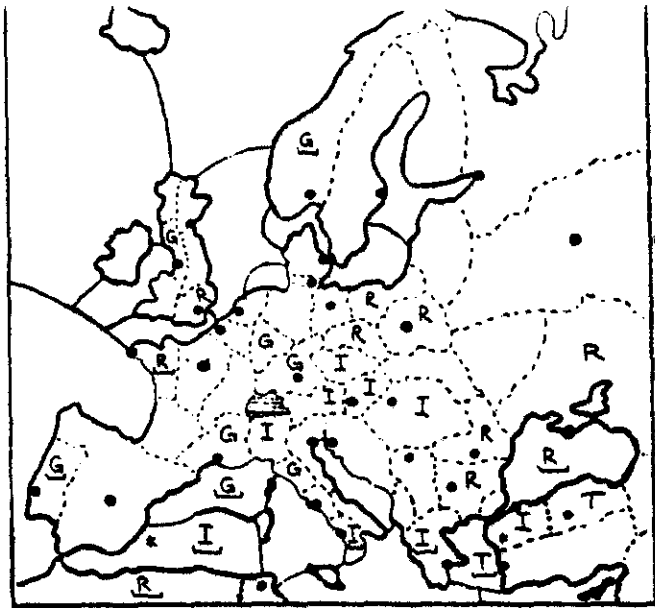

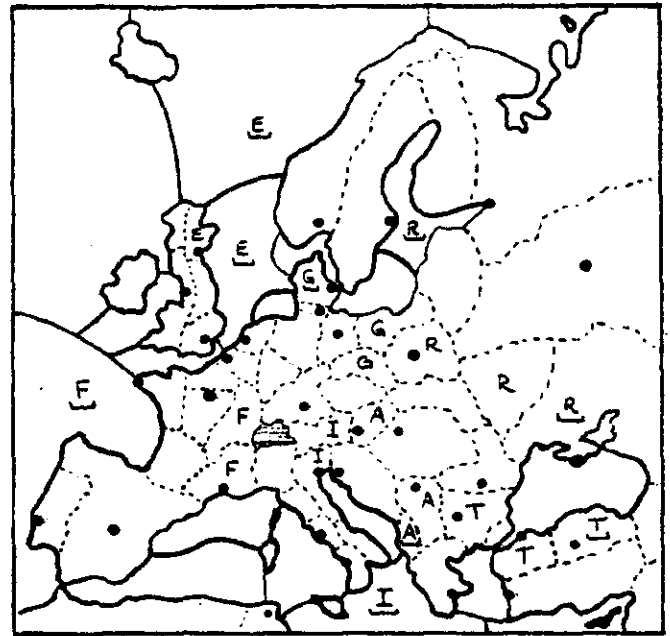
"Well," replied Robert T. Leadsides, "my Uncle lives there."
