DRAB: IV/6

NOTE:

I notice the DRAB rules do not reflect the way we have been executing air-to-air combat. Cut out or copy the following and paste it into your DRAB rules:

9.14 Fa/c of the 2 sides are arranged in stacks of 5 or less IDENTICAL a/c. Each stack must fight each enemy CAP stack, totalling air combat factors ((=20-P/TL) to = Ph. A D20 is rolled, taking a D20 in return for simultaneous effect, immediately applying losses before the next stack is fought.

9.15 The die roll within the Ph = damage. The die points are matched, point for point, to the combat strengths of DE a/c.

9.16 Any die points not matched to a/c chosen by the GM to DE, are lost. The GM will apportion damage so the largest number of a/c are lost. No partial damage.

9.17 An a/c is destroyed only if ALL its defense strength points are matched by hits. Any other result is no effect. If one rolls "9" and "3" (having 24 attack factors), one will DE only one a/c with 5 defense strength points, 2 a/c with 4 defense points, and 4 a/c with 3 defense points!

It is with deep regret that Toltec and Allied forces only lost one scout unit while running across the map. (Know what you've got to have some units somewhere!)



LIBOURSE

The \$3 game fee is good for the entire game. If you're eliminated, you must join again.

Only cash from land sales may be used in a current turn's budget. Cash from currency sales may be used to finance currency transactions in the same turn. But any balance of cash is added to the Treasury, which can be spent the following turn. Cash in the treasury may also be used to buy currency. No "Short" sales.

You will lose people to starvation if you do not spend at least \$1 per population point.

You may attack only one player per turn.

If you miss a turn, nothing happens unless you are attacked.

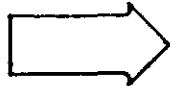
When the Diplomacy game ends to which the LIBOURSE is attached, the final standings shall be calculated by the value of total currency holdings where the price of each currency shall be \$0.25 per supply center held by the country at game's end.
