EDITORIAL:

I'm surprised Congress is surprised about the Reagan administration's violation of international law in Central America. The mining of Micaraguan harbors isn't the first violation, nor the first undeclared act of war against our

neighbors to the south since 1980.

I've already ranted quite a bit about Grenada. Then there are the non-stop, back-to-back joint military exercises by US forces in Honduras which have gone on for about a year now. These exercises are providing aerial reconnaisance for both the Ecuadorian military dictators as well as the Contras fighting against Nicaragua. NBC newsfilm showed Honduran military spotting and correcting "Contra" mortar fire onto targets across the border in Nicaragua from safe, US-protected bases in Honduras. The evening news on PBS reports that the US "military exercises" in Honduras has built ports and airfields which are being used to ferry supplies to the Contras, and have even flown supplies to Contra base camps inside Nicaragua.

Honduras claims their concern is the revolutionary regime in Nicaragua and the spread of communism. But a little reading of Central American history shows a long history of border clashes and disputes between Honduras and Micaragua. There probably is more than just a little hypocrisy involved on the part of both Honduras and the US.

I very much approve of the offer by France to sweep the US mines from Nicaraguan waters. Those mines seem to have damaged 7 or 8 ships (by news count), including those of our allies.

1984 NUMEROLOGY

freedom requires a balance. A person who dares not leave his home for fear of muggers is as much a prisoner as a person locked in a concentration camp. A few people would seek freedom through the abolition of government. Host people, however, agree that government must be strong enough to protect the citizens from one another, yet not so strong as to threaten the citizens' liberty. Striking this balance has always been the most difficult problem facing a democracy.

There are no concentration camps in the United States. On the other hand, there are many cities where most people live in daily fear of criminal violence. These simple facts suggest that true freedom may, at the moment, require MORE

governmental power, not less.

Orwell chose the date 1984 arbitrarily -- by reversing the digits of the year that he wrote, 1948. Yet people have misconstrued his warnings into a mindless slogan: "It's 1984 -- Fear The Government." Today's problems will not be solved "It's 1984 by this kind of monomania. To disregard Orwell's warnings is folly. It is equal folly to accept them so literally that we are blinded to opposing considerations. The price of liberty remains what it has always been -- eternal vigilance and eternal balancing.




