

You will receive less than market price on sales, and will receive fewer units (paying higher than market price) on purchases. Somewhere between 25.000-26,000 units (on buys), and \$25.000-\$26,000 (on sales) you will see your trading performance deteriorate when compared to lower levels. The bell curve peaks at that level.







ROMA: ITALIAN MEDICAL STUDENTS RESCUED!!!

In a daring rescue mission. Italian amphibious forces boarded ships in Maples and stormed the tiny island of Malta. Despite the absence of Maltese resistance, the battle raged for several hours during which time a Howard Johnson's was destroyed and a battalion of stout-hearted Italian forces was taken prisoner by patients of a mental hospital.




