EDITORIAL:

Jackson upstages Reagan by opening a lot of doors in Latin America with his personal diplomacy. But Reagan is so petty, he sits in the White House pouting and won't speak to Jackson at all, much less Castro or the Micaraguan gov't. In the past, Reagan has said he won't improve relations with Cuba because they're holding American prisoners. Jackson got Castro to release them. Then Reagan said that's not enough, the political prisoners must be released first. Jackson got Castro to release 26 political prisoners. Now the Reagan administration says that won't work to improve relations, it's only a "propaganda" victory" (Schultz's words)

Well, they're right. It is a propaganda victory for the Handed to them on a silver platter by Reagan. Reagan Cubans is begging to talk to Russians for improved relations. But tyrannical Castro who is spreading revolution and trying to take over Latin America, Africa and Asia from his island base in Cuba (according to the U.S. gov't), cannot be a participant in talks for improved relations. In fact, Cuba must remain the object of an economic blockade and a history of CIA plots by the AUSTRIA: which is decades old now.

Reagan has also said Cuba must abandon armed support for revolutionary movements in Latin America. Castro has recently supported the Contadora Process for peace in Central America sponsored by Mexico, Colombia and Venezuela (among others), and to which the U.S. gov't also gives lip service while supporting the "Contra" mercenaries in anti-Nicaraguan operations from Honduran bases. I heard a news report yesterday that Honduras has demanded the Contras close their HO in Honduras. If this means the Hondurans will limit or stop the Contra operations, it is a blow to Reagan's "secret" war against Micaragua. I hope



PBEM DIPLOMACY:

I am moderating games of PREM Diplomacy for users of the ACE BBS. LIB subscribers will pay no more for a PBEM game than for a PBM game in the LIB, except for your long-distance phone charges. The BBS number is: (503) 343-4352.

Since I've taken the LIB BBS off-line, you may also leave messages for me on that BBS. The SYSOP wants all game messages to me to be left on the Diplomacy message file (that's file #6 on the "A" message file directory).

Also, I'm informed the ACEBBS uses 6-character passwords. So when you send me a password, make sure they are only 6 characters long.

LIBOURSE:

Players in the Libourse trade in the currencies of the Top Board Game, 1983 AG. You may join the game at any time by submitting the \$3 game fee together with your request for assignment and a name for your country (only Top Board players may use the name of their position in the Diplomacy game).

Your country will have characteristics in the following categories: population, treasury, agriculture, military, industry, mineral resources, communications, transportation and utilities. You will receive approximately \$7,000 in currency of the surviving Diplomacy positions in the Top Board game. You must improve your country in all categories to do well. And you may attack one other Libourse country each turn. Random events may help or binder your progress.

GORKY DIARY: The valiant young men of LATVIA had all gone off to fight the villains of Luxembrg. After an initial defeat, they won a glorious battle -- but found the war already lost. It's true there were many who had called for an end to all war. which would have resulted in a static situation. This was overruled by the bankers, who thought they could buy their way out of trouble. BUT NO! The subversion was already complete, before enough corrective action could be taken 50, now the bankers are counting their losses (between 7 to 11 hundred thousand end game dollars). Still, many are relieved that GM & ff were only a penny, so the liquidation netted 50,000 for a healthy start at yet another country -- GORKY. The punishment of Luxembrg will have to wait for 82 IP; the long lead of CAYMAN must be cut or victory will be his! (His shadow value, if 83 AG were to stop now is 1.2 million dollars).
